ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: Five runs in the third inning and outs when they needed them most helped the Vancouver Canadians to a 9-8 win over the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Tuesday night at Funko Field

Trailing 2-1 to start the third, the C's eruption began with a one-out single from Rafael Lantigua. Up stepped Tanner Morris with a chance to extend his hitting streak to a season-high 19 games; the Crozet, VA native homered for the fifth time this season to put Vancouver in front 3-2. Spencer Horwitz followed with a single to extend his streak to 19 straight then scored on an RBI double off the bat of Orelvis Martinez. A wild pitch scored a run later in the inning before Trevor Schwecke – playing in his first earne of the season – singled home Vancouver's sixth run of the game.

After the AquaSox scored a run to make it 6-3, Martinez put the C's back in front by four with a solo shot – his seventh – in the top of the fifth. Clarke singled home the eighth run in the seventh and Schwecke plated another to make it 9-3.

Everett stormed back with a run in the seventh and four in the eighth but Will McAfffer managed to force a fly out from the potential tying run to end the inning. He worked around two walks and stranded the winning run on base in the ninth to secure the win.

Hayden Juenger (W, 1-0) earned his first win as a pro with two shutout innings that featured one hit, a walk and four strikeouts. Jol Concepcion followed with a one-run seventh. Paxton Schultz got the start and went four innings in which he allowed three runs (two earned) on four hits with four walks and four strikeouts. With the win, Vancouver has beaten Everett in three straight games for the first time this year. Clarke paced the offense with four hits to tie a career high. He last logged four knocks in his second game as a pro in 2019. Martinez – the #3 Blue Jays prospect – has a hit in six in a row.

FEELING FUNKO-Y: The C's dock in Everett for their third and final visit to Funko Field. They are 12-18 against the Frogs but beat them in a series for the first time when they last met August 10-15.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: September 1, 2017 - A single run in the top of the eighth was all the C's needed on this date at Pasco's Gesa Stadium in a 1-0 win over Tri-City. Logan Warmoth singled home Reggie Pruitt to break a scoreless tie for the decisive blow. On the mound, Brody Rodning, Dany Jimenez, Marcus Reyes and Will Duellette combined on a seven-hit shutout.

IDES OF AUGUST: After finishing June and July with sub-.500 records, Vancouver wrapped up August with 14 wins and 12 losses. They hit .279 as a unit (the second-best in the league) and outscored opponents 157-153, their largest run total in a single month this year (June, 151, is the second-most). The C's hit 36 home runs, the most they ve hit in any given month this season. Their previous high was 21 in June. Individually, Spencer Horwitz made himself a candidate to be the High-A West Player of the Month by slashing .364/.453/.606/1.059 with nine doubles, five home runs, 18 runs scored, 21 RBI and 17 BB while playing in 25 of 26 games. Sebastian Espino hit .325, Eric Rivera hit .308 and Rafael Lantieua had a .304 average.

POWER SURGE: Vancouver hit two bombs yesterday and have now gone deep in seven straight, their most consecutive games with at least one long ball.

COMEDY OF ERRORS: The C's made four errors for the third time this year last night. Coincidentally, they last made four errors in a game on June 15 in a 16-9 loss to Everett.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 19 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 32-for-77 (.431) with seven doubles, five homers, 16 runs scored, 21 RBI and 15 walks while Morris is 25-for-83 (.308) with six doubles, a triple, a homer, 11 runs scored, 13 RBI and eight walks. The league record is 26, established in 1962 by Gary Johnson of Tri-City.

ACE OF ON BASE: Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 28 consecutive games since July 25. He's 36-for-117 (.308) with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 13 runs scored, 17 RBI and 12 walks. In an even greater accomplishment, he's reach in 45 of his last 47 starts.

ON THE HILL: Alejandro Melean makes his High-A and Canadians debut tonight. Before his call up from Low-A, he appeared in 19 games (10 starts) and posted a 3-5 record with a 5.29 ERA over 63 innings pitched. The right-hander struck out 75 and walked 30. He's from Maracaibo, VX.

#14 Mariners prospect Juan Then gets the ball for Everett. He last worked on August 10 in Eugene and took the loss with 3.2 innings in which he allowed three runs on five hits with no walks and six K's. Then, 21, is 0-1 with a 6.11 ERA in four starts against the Canadians this year.
