### JOSH HATCHER HITS GO-AHEAD DOUBLE IN 8TH TO PROPEL RIDERS TO VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders mounted a 6-2 comeback victory over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Sunday afternoon from HODGETOWN, winning their fourth-straight game. Amarillo (21-30) scored first in the bottom of the first when LuJames Groover ripped an RBI single to take a 1-0 lead. Frisco (31-19) then tied the game in the top of the second when **Josh Hatcher** roped an RBI single but was caught out between first and second. The Sod Poodles regained the lead in the bottom of the seventh when Groover floated an RBI double to put Amarillo up 2-1. With two outs and the bases loaded in the top of the eighth, Hatcher lined a three-run double to pull the RoughRiders ahead 4-2. Frisco added on in the top of the ninth when **Sebastian Walcott** drilled a sacrifice fly deep enough to score **Tucker Mitchell** from second. **Abimelec Ortiz** rifled an RBI single to expand the lead to 6-2. Riders reliever **Larson Kindreich** (1-1) earned the win out of the bullpen, pitching a scoreless seventh inning. After starter **Trey Supak** allowed just two runs across five innings, Kindreich, **Skylar Hales**, **Travis MacGregor** and **Gavin Collyer** combined for 3.1 shutout frames in relief.

### WIN, WIN, WIN, WIN:

The Riders have been playing well as of late, winning four in a row and nine of their last 11 games. During that 11-game stretch, the Riders have a 4.04 ERA (seventh in the Texas League) and are averaging 4.6 runs per game (2nd in TL), but are tied for first with 14 home runs. Because of a couple big losses of nine and 12 runs, Frisco has just a +4 run differential in their last 11 games. In the four-game winning streak, the Riders are first in the Texas League in average (.301), home runs (6), runs scored (27) and OPS (.876). They are also second in ERA on the mound (2.25). **Luis Mieses** is leading the Texas League with a 1.123 OPS in the last 11 games with five doubles, four home runs and nine RBIs.

### SAVE TONIGHT:

On Thursday night, **Janser Lara** became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Gavin Collyer** are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and **Skylar Hales** has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball and tied for the third-most in franchise history through their first 50 games.

### OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 16 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .269/.333/.612/.945 with five doubles, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored. On Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). His eight home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the fifth-most since 2005 through 51 team games, trailing Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (11), Delmon Young (11), Oscar Taveras (10), and Tatis Jr. (9).

### ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 20 games, Ortiz is hitting .308 (24-for-78)/.407/.551/.958 with four doubles, five home runs and 17 RBIs. In that 20 game span, his .958 OPS is the fifth-best in the Texas League while his five home runs are tied for seventh.

### MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders both hit and gave up their fair share of long balls last month. They hit 28 this month, which was second in the league and allowed 31, which is the second-most. Frisco's 4.60 ERA was seventh in the league during the month while they went 16-10 in May despite a -6 run differential.

### DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

**Aaron Zavala** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .308 (33-for-107)/.436/.486/.922 over his last 31 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and is second in OBP (.436) while leading the league in walk rate (21.1 percent), a mark which also ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA). In May, he hit .305/.436/.463/.899, ranking 11th in average, second in OBP and 10th in OPS in the Texas League. It was his first career month finishing with a .300 or better batting average since August of 2022.

### BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

**Mitch Bratt** has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first nine starts, his 1.89 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through nine starts in recorded franchise history by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 7.9 K/BB and 91.1 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 55 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 47.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

2024 SEASON

- Returned to Corpus Christi on 8/11 for his Double-A debut in front of friends and family, allowing just one walk over a scoreless inning.

-Born in Fujinomiya, Japan, Missaki moved to Brazil with his family when he was two years old because his mother had family there. He was raised in Sao Paulo.

-Originally a catcher like his father, who played in the Japanese company leagues as an adult, he transitioned to an infielder and pitcher in high school. He was offered by the Braves as an infielder, but chose to sign with the Mariners as a pitcher in 2013.

-Missaki pitched in the World Baseball Classic for the Brazilian National Team in 2013, pitching 0.1 innings.

-Signed with Rangers after pitching in the Dominican Winter League

-Started in the bullpen for Frisco, making five appearances

2024 SEASON

-Signed by the Cubs out of Independent Mexican League.

-Pitched mostly with Double-A Tennessee, owning 3.60 ERA over 16 outings with the Smokies.

2016-2023 SEASONS

-Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers following the 2015 season alongside Brewers pitcher Freddy Peralta.

-Missed the 2016 and 2017 seasons after a second "Tommy John" surgery.

-Recieved Spring Training invite in 2018, but did not pitch with a Brewers affiliate and was released on September 18, 2018.

-Signed a developmental contract with the Yomiuri Giants in the Nippon Professional Baseball League. He pitched for the club in 2021 and 2022 in the NPB Minor Leagues.

-Pitched in the Columbian Winter League for Caimanes de Barranquilla n 2023-24 offseason before signing with Chicago Cubs.
