NOTES AND NUGGETS

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel makes his Omaha debut as today's starting pitcher for the Storm Chasers, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing Rich Hill (14 years, 141 days MLB service) ... he is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).

Keuchel is the 14th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... he is the 10th pitcher, the 6th to start a game for the Chasers ... by comparison, Omaha had 9 players in their 30's appear in a game both last year and in 2023.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 118 bases this year, and only been caught 20 times ... 118 steals rank 6th in the International League and tied 7th in Triple-A. 118-for-138 in steal attempts is a 85.5% success rate, the best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 2nd-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.0%, 81-for-91).

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the second half and while he's hitting .255 (13-for-51), he leads the club with 6 home runs and 17 runs batted in since arriving, tied for the team lead with 35 total bases, with 10 of 13 hits going for extra-bases ... he is tied 5th in the IL in the 2nd half in total bases.

Dairon Blanco is hitting .333 (16-for-48) since the 2nd half began on June 24 ... 9 of his 16 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 5 doubles and 4 home runs ... his 16 hits in the 2nd half are 2nd on the team and he is 3rd with 33 total bases.

MJ Melendez has swung the bat well lately, as he's hitting .302 (19-for-63) since June 24, with 5 doubles, 1 triple and 3 homers, paired with 10 RBI and 7 walks ... he leads the team with 19 hits in the 2nd half, while 10 RBI rank tied 2nd ... he has 7 multi-hit games of the 15 he's played in the 2nd half.

KICKSTART MY GAME

While Omaha's starting pitchers have combined for the 2nd-highest ERA in the league (6.19 ERA), there have been many good outings this year from Chaser starters, with 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings from starters entering today.

Thomas Hatch's 6.0 scoreless innings last night marked the 17th scoreless start for an Omaha pitcher this year ... it was the 11th time in 2025 a Storm Chasers starting pitcher has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings or more ... Hatch and John Gant threw back-to-back scoreless starts, Thursday and Friday.

When Omaha starters go at least 5.0 innings this year (42 times), the Storm Chasers are 21-21 ... the Chasers are 19-12 when the starter allows 3 runs or less ... in the 2nd half (16 games), Omaha has gotten 8 starts of at least 5.0 innings from their starting pitcher.

THE FUTURE IS HERE

Last week, it was announced that Storm Chasers catcher Carter Jensen will represent the Kansas City Royals on the American League roster at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game, played THIS AFTERNOON.

Jensen is one of two Royals prospects on the AL roster, joined by LHP Frank Mozzicato, who is currently with Double-A Northwest Arkansas.

He is the 14th active Omaha player to be selected for the All-Star Futures Game, joining Will Klein (2023), Nick Pratto (2022), Jorge Bonifacio (2016), Hunter Dozier (2016), Cheslor Cuthbert (2015), Balbino Fuenmayor (2015), Yordano Ventura (2013), Wil Myers (2012), Jake Odorizzi (2012), Alexis Gomez (2003), Angel Berroa (2002), Chris George (2001) and Jeff Austin (2000).

- Keuchel is making his **1st start with Omaha** this season ... he signed a Minor League contract with Kansas City on July 9, 2025 and was assigned to Omaha today, July 12.
- Playing his 17th professional season this year ... Royals are Keuchel's 9th MLB organization**, has previously spent time with the Astros, Braves, White Sox, Diamondbacks, Rangers, Twins, Mariners and Brewers, as well as time in Japan ... he has pitched in the big leagues for HOU, ATL, CWS, AZ, TEX, MIN and MIL.

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Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.
