LAST OUTING: Patrick picked up his 12 win with 6.0 scoreless innings and eight strikeouts against Jacksonville on august 25.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's third start against Charlotte. He got the win in both appearances with four earned runs in 10.0 innings total. In his start on May 23, he had a career-high 12 strikeouts.
