Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and the Louisville Bats play game two of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville won game one last night, 8-2, behind a strong performance from Bowden Francis. Tonight, left-hander Ethan Small starts for the Sounds against right-hander Michael Mariot for the Bats.

Ethan Small: 24-year-old Ethan Small gets the ball for Nashville tonight. The left-hander is making his second start with the Sounds after his Triple-A debut on June 24 vs. Charlotte. He went 2.2 innings and allowed 2 runs on 3 hits and 5 walks. He struck out 1 batter and threw 62 pitches/37 strikes. The south-paw was recently promoted from Double-A Biloxi where he went 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in 8 starts. In 41.1 innings with the Schuckers, Small allowed 10 runs on 26 hits and racked up 67 strikeouts. He held Double-A hitters to a .184 batting average. Small earned Double-A South Pitcher of the Week in early June. The Spring Hill, Tennessee resident was drafted by the Brewers in the 1st round (28th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University where he garnered multiple national accolades as a junior.

Michael Mariot: 32-year-old Michael Mariot starts for the Bats in game two of the series tonight. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 4.20 ERA in three starts with Louisville. In 15.0 innings, Mariot has yielded 7 runs on 15 hits and 5 walks to go along with 9 strikeouts. Mariot last pitched on June 24 vs. Indianapolis and was hit with his second loss of the season. He allowed 5 runs on 6 hits in 4.0 innings. He allowed a pair of home runs and recorded 3 strikeouts. The Reds signed Mariot to a minor league contract on June 9. In 44 career Major League games, he has a 2-0 record with a 5.98 ERA. Mariot pitched in 19 games for the Royals from 2014-15 and 25 games for the Phillies in 2016. He was drafted by Kansas City in the 8th round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Nebraska.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 15, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Back to the Winning Ways: Since dropping four straight games from June 12-16, the Sounds have returned to their winning ways. The team has won four of their last five, six of their last eight and seven out of their last 10. Nashville is 5-2 on the current 12-game homestand.

Everybody Hits: For only the third time this season, every Sounds hitter in the lineup (not including the pitcher spot) had at least one hit in last night's 8-2 win. The other occurrences were June 13 in a 7-4 loss vs. Indianapolis (13 total hits) and May 28 at Columbus in a 13-9 win (13 total hits).

Henry Does it All: Nashville catcher Payton Henry did a little bit of everything last night in the 8-2 win. Henry drove in a pair of runs, scored a run and collected his second Triple-A hit, and on the defensive end the backstop threw out a pair of would-be base stealers.

Turn Around from Jankins: Up until Thomas Jankins' start on June 22 vs. Charlotte, he was 0-3 with a 10.33 ERA (31 ER/27.0 IP) in eight appearances and six starts. Since June 22, the right-hander is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) and 12 strikeouts in two starts. On Sunday night, he tossed a season-high 5.2 IP and gave up two runs on two hits.

Home Sweet Home: The Sounds have won 14 of their last 19 games at First Horizon Park and have a 17-8 record at home on the season. The mark is the fourth-best in the Triple-A East behind only Omaha (19-5), Indianapolis (15-5) and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (15-6).

COOOOOP: Sounds outfielder Cooper Hummel collected another hit last night and has now reached safely in 10 consecutive games. Since the streak began on June 17, Hummel is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with 9 runs, 3 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 5 walks

Westbrook Finds A Way: Infielder/outfielder Jamie Westbrook has reached base safely in 17 consecutive games and has hit safely in 15 of the last 17. During the streak he has the highest average in the Triple-A East at .397 (27-for-68) with 12 runs, 7 doubles, 3 home runs, 18 RBI and 4 walks. His on-base percentage during the 17 games is .440.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,062-1,941. The 2,062 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Small made his first start with Nashville on June 24 vs. Charlotte. He pitched just 2.2 innings and gave up two runs on three hits and tied a season-high with five walks. He threw 62 pitches (37 strikes) and exited the game with Nashville down 2-0.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is making his first career appearance against Louisville.
