Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP Trenton Denholm to the mound tonight, looking to avoid consecutive losses for the first time since 7/25-7/26 (7-2 in last 9G). The Mets will counter with RHP Jonathan Santucci. Columbus is 47-32 (.595) versus right handers this year. Santucci has never pitched against Columbus in his career, as tonight will be his second career game in the International League.

vs. the Mets

The Clippers have won the season series in five of the last seven years they have played the Mets (lost in 2023, split in 2019) and have triumphed in 36 of 56G (.643) dating to 6/11/15. They were 2-4 in Syracuse in 2024 (5-1 in the home slate) and 2-3 at Syracuse in 2023. Individually, George Valera has hit .319 (15x47) with 7HR and 16RBI against Syracuse in 13G of his career (6HR in 7G at NBT).

Jump Start

Columbus has outscored the opposition 57-13 in the first four innings of the last 10G, taking multi-run leads into the 5th of each one. Opponents have then outscored Columbus 39-17 from the 5th-9th, but have managed to complete only two comebacks. Last night marked the fourth time this season that Columbus lost a game after leading by at least five runs (most in the IL; 26-4 with a 5+ lead).

Getting Offensive

Over the last 9G, the Clippers have plated a total of 74 runs (most in the IL, 8.2 per game), after coming out of the All-Star Break with 35 runs in the first 9G (16th in the IL, 3.9 per). Columbus had 2HR in 288AB of those first 9G, but have shaken off the rust to the tune of an IL-best 25HR in the last 294AB. Last night saw the Clippers hit six runs for the ninth straight game (longest streak in the IL this year).

Ingle is Back

In 21G since his option, Cooper Ingle is 35x89 (.393), drawing 12BB (.461OBP) with 15XBH (6HR, .697SLG). He is one of two in the IL (Max Anderson, Toledo), hitting .300/.400/.500, but his 11G hit streak was snapped Wednesday (.479, 23x48 with 4HR and 15RBI from 7/23-8/4, multi-hit in eight straight). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.338OPS (15HR) in 39G (.675OPS and 3HR in 32G between DH and LF).

Schneemann on the Schnide

Daniel Schneemann is 2x18 (.111) in 4G this month, registering 6K in 20PA to go with 2BB (3x8 with 4BB and 0K in last 3G of July). Still, dating to 4/25/24, he owns a 1.011OPS over his last 39G in Triple-A (33RBI, 32 runs). He has not played the outfield since getting optioned (24 starts with Cleveland), as Columbus has five outfielders on the roster (carried one over 5G from 6/18-6/21, Joe Lampe).

One from One Hundred

Kyle Manzardo singled last night for his 99th career hit as a Clipper, in his 105th career game. Though he is hitting just .265 in a Columbus uniform, he boasts a .555SLG as 56% of his hits have gone for extra bases (only 21XBH outside of Huntington Park, .462SLG; 34XBH and .647 at home). In addition, he has put together a walk rate of 16% (74BB in 460PA) against a strikeout rate of 18% (82K).

Rare Company

Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, Milan Tolentino is 28x98 (.286) in his last 32G, collecting 16XBH (.571SLG) and 20RBI (was 5x39, .128, in 13G prior). He is one of 11 in the IL with at least 13HR and 13SB, along with Kahlil Watson (Columbus and Omaha are only IL teams with two). Tolentino is tied for the 2nd most homers in the IL since the start of the 2025 season (34; OHR off LHP).

Rosario on the Rise

Alfonsin Rosario enters tonight having hit safely in each of his last 5G (6x17, .353), after starting his Triple-A career hitting .118 (4x34) in his first 10G. Rosario has scored a run in six straight and been successful in all three steal attempts with Columbus (one of six minor leaguers this year with at least 15SB and 0CS). When the Clippers are leading, Rosario is hitting .290 (9x31; 1x20 when trailing or tied).

Problems on the Back End

Since allowing 7ER in 4.1IP at Lehigh Valley on 7/12, the Clipper bullpen has registered an IL-worst 8.17ERA in 19G (76.0IP, 69ER). Clipper relievers have surrendered 18HR in that time (+4 on all other teams), allowing a line of .282/.401/.534. The bullpen has not put together a scoreless outing since back to back games vs. Louisville from 7/4-7/5 (83ER in 24G since; 46ER in 24G prior).

This Date in Clipper History

8/7/1994

Derek Jeter hit his first career HR as a Clipper in a 9-7 victory over Toledo. Jeter combined between 1994 and 1995, his Clipper of the Year season, to hit 5HR. In his 20 Major League seasons, Jeter hit 260HR and currently ranks 236th among Major Leaguers in HR. In addition, he hit 20HR in the postseason, including three in the World Series, and he went deep once in the All-Star Game (2001).

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,469 to 1,414).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 161-127 (.559) in pitch reviews, with batters going 83-78 (.516) and pitchers/catchers going 78-49 (.614). They have run out of challenges in 44G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 826, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 127 through 109G (on pace for 172SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 37CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (50; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 159 runs while crafting an .895OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 102 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +57 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 255-158 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,976RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.37 through the first 110G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 198HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 60G this season (36-24, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 4th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 7th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Memphis has 31). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 445-457 (.493), 415-411 with Columbus (.502).

500K:

On 8/1 vs. Toledo, Denholm racked up 8K for the third time this year, crossing 500 in his career in the process (8.3K/9IP). He has seen that rate bump slightly this season (9.0K/9IP), while his 3.88K/BB ratio ranks 3rd in the IL among 95 pitchers with at least 50.0IP (0BB to last 56BF, 1BB to last 71BF).

Great Start:

Denholm's season debut, 4/1 vs. Indianapolis, was his 100th career game and his second at the Triple-A level (367 days between Triple-A games). He needed only 69 pitches to record a quality start (6.0IP, 1ER), giving the Clippers their first of the season (5th game, did not have a quality start until 41st game last season). Columbus has 16QS on the season (16QS through this point last year, on the way to 23), with **Rorik Maltrud** (6), **Logan Allen** (4) and Denholm (3) accounting for 81%.

In Relief:

Denholm pitched exclusively in relief during May and June, but each appearance came on starter's rest, as he averaged 56.0 pitches per outing (ranged from 38-84, while recording 2.0-5.0IP). In total, he was 7-0 with a 1.95ERA over 9G (32.1IP, 30H, 9R, 7ER, 5BB, 35K). He led the IL in wins from May-June and, among 76 pitchers with at least 30.0IP, his ERA was 2nd best (also 2nd with 7.00K/BB and 6th with a 1.08WHIP). On 5/20 vs. Louisville, Denholm notched his first save in Triple-A (4.0IP, 1ER) and the fifth of his pro career.

Tough Ones:

On 4/12, Worcester hung 7ER on Denholm, tying a career high (third time), while also connecting for 2HR (eighth career game giving up 2HR, first time allowing both to same batter, Allan Castro). He followed up with a quality outing next time out, 4/18 vs. Iowa (6.0IP, 3ER), throwing a season high of 92 pitches. Denholm closed out April by giving up 7ER again (fourth time), this time to Toledo on 4/30, while giving up 3HR for the first time in his career.

Limiting the Longballs:

From 4/12-4/30, Denholm surrendered 7HR to 90BF (one per 12.9BF), accounting for 15 of 19ER (6HR with men on base, including a grand slam on 4/12 at Worcester). He allowed only 2HR to the next 188BF from 5/7-7/12 (94.0BF per) before surrendering a pair in the 3rd inning at Lehigh Valley on 7/12. Including those IronPig homers, Denholm surrendered bombs in each of 3GS from 7/12-7/26, giving up 5HR to 57BF (one per 11.4BF).
