### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Last night was Indianapolis' first postponement of the 2024 season after having five in 2024, three at Victory Field, and two cancellations. The Indians and Redbirds will make up the game on a date to be determined later this homestand.

ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT: Malcom Nuñez launched the first home run at Victory Field in 2024 and Nick Gonzales extended his hitting streak to four games as the Indianapolis Indians were defeated by the Memphis Redbirds in their home opener on Tuesday night, 7-2. Memphis got on the board in the top of the first inning and never trailed, besting Indianapolis as the home team put up two runs on four hits. The Indians' first hit came via a Nick Gonzales single in the third, extending his hitting streak to all four games of the 2024 season. In the bottom of the fifth inning, Nuñez launched a solo homer against Redbirds starter, his second in consecutive games after launching a solo shot on Sunday in Louisville. The Redbirds tacked on insurance runs with one in the eighth and four in the ninth, the latter coming courtesy of a three-run home run by Luken Baker. Baker led Memphis with three hits, two for extra-bases after roping a double in the first inning. Indianapolis plated its final run in the bottom of the ninth following an infield single and three consecutive walks.

SHOWING OUT #ATTHEVIC: The Indians ushered 9,439 fans through the gates for Tuesday's home opener at Victory Field, their largest Opening Night crowd since bringing in 12,210 in 2019 (4/11). Last season, in their 27th season at Victory Field, Indianapolis ranked fourth among all 120 Minor League Baseball teams with a total attendance of 556,775, trailing only Lehigh Valley, Columbus and Nashville. The average of 7,842 fans across 71 openings was also fourth in MiLB behind Lehigh Valley, Dayton and Columbus.

GONZO GETS ON BASE: Nick Gonzales has wasted no time getting hot at the plate in 2024, extending his hitting streak to all four games of the season so far. He began the season with three straight two-hit games over the weekend in Louisville before being held to a single on Tuesday. He joins Gilberto Celestino as the only two Indians to hit safely in all four team games to begin the season. The 24-year-old infielder appeared in 99 games with Indy in 2023 and hit .281 (106-for-377) with 75 runs, 27 doubles, eight triples and 49 RBI. He tied for the International League lead in triples while also leading the team in runs.

CELLY SINGLES: Gilberto Celestino, making his Pirates organization debut this weekend after being signed as a minor league free agent in the offseason, has hit safely in his first four games with a three-hit showing in Sunday's victory. On Sunday in Louisville, he doubled and singled in the sixth and seventh innings, respectfully, to drive in Nick Gonzales and help keep Indy ahead of Louisville. On Tuesday, he hit an infield single in the ninth inning to extend his hitting streak. The outfielder spent most of the 2023 season with Triple-A St. Paul and hit .243 (45-for-185) with 11 doubles, two triples, four home runs and 31 RBI in 55 games.

NUÑEZ HITS NUKES: Malcom Nuñez has homered in two consecutive games after going yard again in the fifth inning on Tuesday vs. Memphis. On Sunday, he launched a solo shot – also in the fifth inning – to put the Indians on the board for their eventual first win of 2024. Half of Nuñez's hits through four games to begin the season have left the yard, and he is now one of 10 batters in the International League to homer in consecutive games this season. The 23-year-old is known for his power, launching 23 home runs in 2022 between Double-A Springfield, Altoona and Indianapolis to finish the season ranked sixth among all Double-A leaders with 87 RBI.

TONIGHT: The Indians look for their first home win of 2024 as they continue the six-game series vs. Memphis at Victory Field tonight at 6:35 PM ET. In the short history of their rivalry, the Redbirds narrowly lead Indianapolis, 16-15, since Memphis joined the International League in 2021. At Victory Field, the Indians are winning the all-time series 11-8 (.579) after splitting the 2023 series at home, 3-3. In Memphis last season, the Indians went 1-5. Tonight's game features Indians Opening Day starter Michael Plassmeyer (0-0, 2.25) in his second start of the season and third career against the Redbirds. In 2023, he faced them twice with Lehigh Valley and went 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (4er/8.0ip) and nine strikeouts. Countering for Memphis is RHP Victor Santos (0-0, -, --) in his season debut. He has never faced Indianapolis after logging nine career Triple-A starts in 2022 with Worcester.

PLASSMEYER'S PUNCHIES: Southpaw Michael Plassmeyer, made his second consecutive Opening Day start in the International League on Friday in Louisville after kicking off the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley last season. He fanned six through 4.0 one-hit innings of work on Friday night to exit with a lead. Plassmeyer did not surrender a hit until the fourth inning when Hernán Pérez went yard to put the Bats on the board. The 27-year-old spent most of the '23 season with Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts).

WELCOME HOME: The Indians returned to Victory Field for the first time since 2023 on Tuesday and now look for their first win of the 2024 season on their home turf. Last year, they split even with a 37-37 record at Victory Field. It was the first time since 2010 (36-36) and the third since moving to the corner of West and Maryland in 1996 that the Indians finished with a .500 record at Victory Field. Including Tuesday night's result, the Indians are 1036-858 at Victory Field since 1996.

THIS DATE IN 2002: On Opening Day against Columbus at Victory Field, Indians first baseman Izzy Alcantara belted a two-out, three-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning to push Indy to a 4-1 triumph. Ryan Glynn yielded just one earned run on three hits with four strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched for Indianapolis.

### TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Michael Plassmeyer:** The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his first home appearance of the season for the Indians as their starter tonight vs. Memphis.

**Last Outing:** Plassmeyer made his second consecutive Opening Day start in the International League on Friday at Louisville and tossed 4.0 one-run innings with six strikeouts. He exited the game with a lead before the Indians lost to the Bats, 9-8.

**Against the Redbirds:** Plassmeyer has faced Memphis twice in his career, both coming in 2023 with Lehigh Valley. In those outings, he went 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (4er/8.0ip) and nine strikeouts.

**Walk It Off:** Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion — three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ... Reinstated from the IL on 8/27 and went 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4er/23.2ip) and 27 strikeouts in his next five games (four starts) with Lehigh Valley. ... Made his final start of the season with Philadelphia on 9/30 (2) at New York (NL) and surrendered a career-high nine earned runs in 3.2 innings.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Seattle (4th round, 118th overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. ... Had his contract first selected by PHI on 8/22/22 and made his MLB debut on 8/23/22 vs. Cincinnati. ... Signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on 12/29/23.
