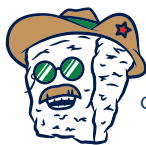

PAIR OF THREE-RUN HOMERS HOIST ROUGHRIDERS TO WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders mashed two three-run home runs en route to an 11-4 win over the Springfield Cardinals on Friday night at Riders Field. Frisco (28-25) scored in the first for the second straight night, tallying five runs against Springfield (25-29) starter Jurrangelo Cijntje (3-3). **Rafe Perich** rifled a slice-shot double into left-center field to drive in two runs, erasing a 1-0 deficit for a 2-1 lead. Then, **Ian Moller** bombed a three-run home run off the batter's eye in center that made it 5-1. **Dalton Pence** (2-1) dealt in his fourth RoughRiders start, allowing a solo home run to Jose Cordoba, but striking out seven Cardinals across five full innings with just the two earned runs surrendered. The RoughRiders did not have another hit after the Moller home run until the sixth inning, when **Marcus Lee Sang** hammered a three-run shot of his own to plant Frisco ahead 8-2. Frisco finished the night with three more runs in the bottom of the eighth, including a two-RBI single from **Dylan Dreiling**, who had earlier extended his Texas League-best on-base streak to 24 games.

RARE OFFENSIVE GAME:

The RoughRiders scored 11 runs on just 4 hits on Friday against the Cardinals, becoming just the second team to score at least 11 runs on 4 or fewer hits in the minors since 2005, joining Triple-A Tacoma on April 4th, 2023, when they scored 12 runs on 4 hits. All 4 hits for the Riders knocked in at least 2 runs with a 2-run double from **Rafe Perich**, 3-run homers from **Ian Moller** and **Marcus Lee Sang** and a 2-run single from **Dylan Dreiling**.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had a pretty solid introduction to his new team, homering 2 times in his first 6 games with the RoughRiders. On Sunday in Arkansas, he crushed a solo shot and added an RBI single in a 2-1 win before he blasted a walk-off home run on Wednesday at home. His 13 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization. For High-A Hub City, he won South Atlantic League Player of the Month for May, hitting .345/.448/.747/1.195 with 10 home runs and 29 RBIs.

STARTING PITCHING STARTING WINS:

RoughRiders starting pitching has been key to their success in the win column over the last few weeks. Since May 13th, Riders starting pitching in wins owns a 4.13 ERA, but a 7.39 ERA in losses. The Riders are 4-0 when they get a quality start this season and 14-7 when a starting pitcher goes at least 5.0 innings.

ONE-RUN MADNESS LATE:

The RoughRiders are just 8-11 in one-run games this year. Out of the 11 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 5 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 2 of the 11 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen. The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (118 runs) and the 2nd-best team in Double-A in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.34).

THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:

Arturo Disla, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders. He has hit safely in 14 of his 19 games, he is hitting .320 (24-for-75)/.407/.507/.914 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 15 RBIs. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs. Between both levels, he has dominated lefties, hitting .429 (18-for-42)/.528/.762/1.290 against southpaws. Among those with at least 35 AB vs. LHP, he is T-3rd in the minors in batting average and 3rd in OPS against lefties.

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been hitting well recently. The No. 10 prospect is 5th in the Texas League in batting average (.305). On a 24-game on-base streak (longest active streak in TL), he is hitting .323 (30-for-93)/.434/.559/.993 with 4 doubles, 6 home runs, 21 RBIs, 19 walks and 18 strikeouts. If he reaches in one more game, it will tie him for the 11th-longest streak in franchise history at 25 games. In the last 4 games, Dreiling is hitting .438 (7-for-16)/.550/.688/1.238.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 35 games, going 20-15. During the stretch, they have scored 216 runs, second in the league (6.4 R/G), slashing .262/.367/.433/.800 with 44 home runs. Frisco's 50 runs in the first inning this year are 4th in the minors, hitting .304 (65-for-214) in the first with 11 home runs. **Dylan Dreiling** is tied for the league lead with 14 hits in the 1st inning (.389 avg) and has now hit 3 home runs in the 1st. They have scored in the first inning in 22 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 13 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 10-24 (including a combined 3-10 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 18-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 11-15 in 1 or 2-run games. The Riders have been shut out just twice this year, both in 7-inning doubleheader games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 53 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in the Texas League with 479 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.267) and 2nd in runs (334, 6.3 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 45 percent of their games (24-of-53). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (69) while they are 2nd in SLG (.441) and 2nd in OPS (.805). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

ABOUT DYLAN

- Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.
- Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.
- Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.
- At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.
- Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

2026 SEASON

- Opened the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders
- Opened season with 5.89 ERA in April.
- Threw first career quality start on May 24th vs. San Antonio: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 K.
- After a 5.89 ERA (12ER/18.1IP) over 4 GS, he owned May in 5 GS, going 2-0 with a 2.88 ERA (8ER/25.0IP) while holding opponents to a .228 batting average.

2025 SEASON

- Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)
- After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.
- Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

2024 SEASON

- Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

2023 SEASON

- Lead the team with 7 wins on the season
- As a starter, went 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA over 7 games. As a reliever, went 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA.

2022 SEASON

- In move to the bullpen, made 21 appearances for Low-A Down East
- Was part of the first Wood Ducks triple play in franchise history on 7/3 vs. Kannapolis (1-4-3-2)
- Was on the Injured List from 7/10-8/4 and 9/6-end of the season

2021 SEASON

- Made professional debut with ACL Rangers, striking out 17 over 17.0 IP to 19 walks

-West Orange HS (teammates there with former RoughRider Chris Seise), then transferred to Windermere Prep in 2015 before JR year ... Went 6-1 with 0.40 ERA . Sports Illustrated named him No. 3 HS pitcher in the country.

-Attended the University of North Carolina (father played and coached volleyball at Duke).

-Drafted thrice – 38th round of 2016 draft by BOS out of Windermere Pre- paratory (Fla.), 32nd round of 2018 draft by ARI from University of North Carolina, and 9th round of 2019 draft by DET from UNC – eventually signing with the Tigers in 2019.

-2015 18U Team USA alongside former RoughRiders Kevin Gowdy, Cooper Johnson and future big leaguers Hunter Greene, Mickey Moniak, Blake Futherford, Nick Pratto, Forrest Whitley

2026 SEASON

-In January of 2026, he signed with Olmecas de Tabasco of the Mexican League, but on February 3rd, the Rangers offered him a contract.

-Played for Team Columbia in the 2026 World Baseball Classic.

-Began the season with Triple-A Round Rock, pitching both out of the rotation and bullpen.

-Entering into his time with Frisco, Bergner's 2.96 ERA in Double-A was first in all of Double-A pitchers since 2005 (min. 250 IP).

2025 SEASON

-Pitched better in Double-A (3.07 ERA in 25 G/14 GS) than in brief Triple-A stint (9.00 ERA in 2 G/1 GS)

-Threw for Santurce of the Puerto Rican Winter League following the season, going 2-2 with a 3.13 ERA (8 ER/23.0 IP) and 29 SO/9 BB in 6 G/5 GS

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

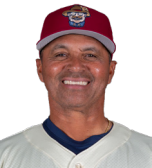

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.
