YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox secured their fourth shutout win of the season with a 3-0 rain-shortened victory over Harrisburg in six innings. Nestor German dealt six shutout innings and allowed just one hit and one walk with six strikeouts to earn the win. Adam Retzbach and Silas Ardoin both homered. Four of the five Baysox hits went for extra bases. After a 40 minute rain delay, the game was eventually called.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. has reached base in 20 of 25 games played to start the season after missing 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has stolen a base in three straight starts. The 17th overall pick in the 2023 Draft stole 74 bases last year, which was second-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems has been one of the best performers in the Orioles system this year. Amongst O's minor leaguers, the Orioles No. 11 prospect is third in doubles (12), tied for fourth in extra base hits (20), tied for fifth in home runs (7) and sixth in total bases (80). Willems leads the team with 23 RBI.

RETZ CAN RAKE

C Adam Retzbach has homered in back-to-back games and has reached base in 16 of his last 19 games. Retzbach was one of the Eastern League's best offensive players in the month of May. The 24-year-old posted the third-best on-base percentage (.457) and the sixth-best batting average in the league (.327).

TRIMBLE ON A TEAR

OF Reed Trimble homered in three straight home games on June 1 and June 10-11. The last time a Baysox player hit a homer in three straight home games was former Baysox UTL Billy Cook from Sept. 5-7, 2023 vs New Hampshire. All four of Trimble's hits since being activated from the IL on May 27 have gone for extra bases.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF Doug Hodo is eighth in the Eastern League in walks (31) and leads the team in OBP (.354). After a slow start to the season, Hodo's bat heated up in the month of May, posting a slash line of .294/.380/.426 with three doubles, two homers and eight

ONE RUN WONDERS

Chesapeake has won 14 one-run games this season - which is tied for second-most in the Eastern League along with New Hampshire. The Baysox have played 25 onerun games this season, which is also second-most in the Eastern League.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.85 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 311 hitters, which is fourthmost in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

The Harrisburg Senators enter this week with a 28-29 record, good for third in the Southwest. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals won four of six vs Reading and have won seven of their last 10. Chesapeake won five of six in Harrisburg in the most recent series meeting May 20 - 25. The Senators roster features four members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Seaver King (No. 4), IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 14) and IF Kevin Made (No. 25).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Riley Cornelio makes his sixth start of the season for the Senators. The 25-yearold faced Chesapeake on May 23 at FNB Field and struck out a Double-A-high seven batters in six innings in a no decision. Cornelio began the year in High-A Wilmington and earned promotion to Double-A Harrisburg after recording a 3.03 ERA in 32.2 innings with the Blue Rocks. Cornelio was drafted by the Nats in 2022 out of TCU.

No. 14 Orioles prospect (MLB.com)

Recorded 13 strikeouts in final High-A start before earning promotion to Double-A

2025: Leads Orioles system and is 13th in MiLB in K (75). 15.11 K/9 is 2nd-best in MiLB (min. 40+ IP). Struck out eight in 6.0 innings of one-run ball on 6/7 @ AKR to earn win in Double-A debut. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 6/3. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made nine appearances (eight starts) and posted a 5.12 ERA with 67 K over 38.2 IP and 14 BB. At time of promotion, led South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 13 batters over a career-high 6.0 innings on 6/1 @ BRK, his final start at High-A. Struck out 10 or more batters in three of his nine outings. Recorded a 3.13 ERA with 45 K over 23 IP in his final five starts with Aberdeen.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
