Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retiring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed (4 earned) on 6/22 vs. Bowie... Made his first appearance post-All Star break in a one-inning relief outing on July 18 vs. Reading...

2022: Spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro... Made 20 appearances with 15 starts, going 2-5 with a 4.68 ERA in 75.0 innings...Made his professional debut on 4/13 at Winston-Salem, allowing one unearned run on three hits in 3.0 innings... PIZZA MIA!



The Curve will re-brand as the Altoona Pizzas during the week of August 8-13. The Altoona-Style Pizza connects its origins to the Altoona Hotel, a small-town establishment that first opened its doors as a 30-room hotel in the 1900s. In its later years, the Hotel operated only as a small restaurant. The Altoona Pizza is crafted on a Sicilian-style pizza dough and topped with tomato sauce, green bell peppers, salami, and a single slice of yellow American cheese. The square-style cut isbelieved to have been first served sometime in the 1960s or 70s. For decades, it was exclusively offered by the Altoona Hotel, until in 2013, when the building iwas destroyed by a fire and never rebuilt. Other establishments around the community have since added the recipe to their menus to carry on the tradition. The jerseys will be auctioned off via the Live-Source App, with proceeds benefitting the Blair County Suicide Prevention Task Force, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Blair County System of Care.
