TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing up a seven-game set with Erie.

LAST TIME OUT: **Tsung-Che Cheng** hammered a three-run homer, but the Curve dropped their series opener with Erie 7-3.

OUR OWN HOWLER: In his team debut, left-hander **Jackson Wolf**, just acquired from the San Diego Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, tossed 4.2 innings of two-run ball on Sunday, August 6 against Richmond. Wolf picked up 5 strikeouts giving him 110 this season between Double-A San Antonio and Altoona, the 10th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the Double-A level.

IT'S OFFICIALLY GEN Z: Infielder **Tsung-Che Cheng** owns the Eastern League's longest active hit streak at 15 games, including 6 multi-hit games during the streak. Since July 19 he has a hit in 16-of-18 games, totaling a .368/.389/.529/.918 OPS line with 5 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI. Cheng's 10 triples this season are the most in minor league baseball.

WINNERS: Altoona secured just their second series victory in the second half of the season by taking four games in the series with Richmond to begin their 12-game homestand in early-August. Altoona last won a series in early-July when they took 3-of-5 games played against Erie running into the All-Star break.

SHUT 'EM DOWN: Altoona won consecutive games via a shutout on August 3 and 4 for the first time since August of 2019. The Curve have shutout the Flying Squirrels in all three wins during their series this week.

PLAY THE SONG! With **Connor Scott's** walk-off walk on August 1 against Richmond, he earned his third career walk-off RBI for Altoona in two seasons with the Curve. **Brock Holt** holds the franchise record for most walk-off RBIs with four across 2011 and 2012. Scott is the first Curve player with two walk-off RBIs in the same season since **Elvis Escobar** in 2017.

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty **Anthony Solometo** is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. **Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history** between C **Ryan Doumit**, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP **Sean Burnett**, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003.

Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.73 ERA and ranks 2nd with 104 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the other players in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

SMASHYCRAFT: Limited to shorter outings in his return from Tommy John surgery, RHP **Braxton Ashcraft** turned in his best start with Altoona on Sunday, July 23 against Reading when he retired all nine batters faced on a tidy 29 pitches, 25 strikes. Ashcraft has a 1.59 ERA (3 ER / 17.0 IP) in seven starts with the Curve and features a 2.54 ERA (14 ER / 49.2 IP) this season with Bradenton, Greensboro and Altoona.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Wednesday, August 9, Altoona has struck out 810 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 4th-fewest in minor league baseball. **Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.18 times per game.**

THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA: Managed by Gabe Alvarez, the SeaWolves host several top prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 2 INF Jace Jung, No. 4 RHP Wilmer Flores, No. 5 RHP Ty Madden, No. 14 C Dillon Dingler, No. 21 LHP Brant Hurter, No. 25 RHP Tyler Mattison, No. 26 RHP Austin Bergner, No. 27 INF Danny Serretti.

THE FIRST TO HOWL: Bryce Tassin starts in game one for Erie. Tassin has shuttled between West Michigan and Erie this season, recording a 4.65 ERA in 27 relief outings. Tassin has allowed 21 runs (14 earned) in 16.1 innings with the SeaWolves this season. Tassin was Detroit's 31st round selection in 2019 out of Southeastern Louisiana.

Erie's game two starter is to be determined.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2005 - Jose Bautista lifts his 20th homer of the season, joining Josh Bonifay in the 20-homer department. Last pair of Curve teammates to hit 20 homers in the same season and third overall.

2009 - Yoslan Herrera improves to 9-0 with 6.1 two-run innings at New Hampshire, setting a team record for most wins to start a season and the most consecutive winning decisions. 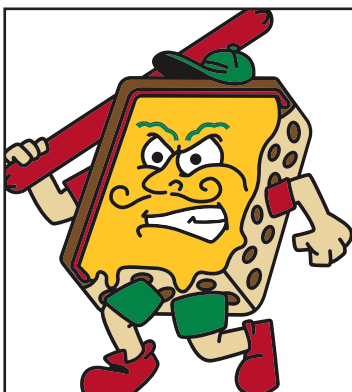

PIZZA MIA!



The Curve will re-brand as the Altoona Pizzas during the week of August 8-13. The Altoona-Style Pizza connects its origins to the Altoona Hotel, a small-town establishment that first opened its doors as a 30-room hotel in the 1900s. In its later years, the Hotel operated only as a small restaurant. The Altoona Pizza is crafted on a Sicilian-style pizza dough and topped with tomato sauce, green bell peppers, salami, and a single slice of yellow American cheese. The square-style cut is believed to have been first served sometime in the 1960s or 70s. For decades, it was exclusively offered by the Altoona Hotel, until in 2013, when the building was destroyed by a fire and never rebuilt. Other establishments around the community have since added the recipe to their menus to carry on the tradition. The jerseys will be auctioned off via the Live-Source App, with proceeds benefitting the Blair County Suicide Prevention Task Force, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Blair County System of Care.
