**FOUR HOME RUNS FUEL FRISCO IN 12-8 WIN OVER AMARILLO:**

Behind four home runs, the Frisco RoughRiders beat the Amarillo Sod Poodles 12-8 on Thursday night in HODGETOWN. Frisco (2-1, 41-30) scored in the first with an **Orlando Martinez** RBI single off Amarillo (1-1, 37-33) starter Ashton Izzi (3-3). Anderson Rojas hit a solo home run off of **Josh Trentadue** to tie the game at one in the bottom of the first. Immediately in the top of the second, Arturo Disla hammered his first career HODGETOWN homer, planting the Riders back ahead 2-1. Then in the fourth, Frisco piled on four more runs with RBIs from **Keith Jones II**, **Corey Joyce**, **Frainyer Chavez** and **Rafe Perich**. After Amarillo hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the fourth and drew the deficit to 7-5 going into the sixth, **Dylan Dreiling** launched a two-run home run in the inning and later, he and Chavez homered again in the eighth inning to take a 12-5 lead. After two scoreless innings from **Cole Stasio** (1-0) helped Frisco's bullpen effort, Amarillo scored three in the ninth but fell in the end.

**RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:**

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567), their 8th-best winning percentage in franchise history and their best since 2024 (.647).

**CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:**

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire. In his last 31 games, he is slashing .373 (44-for-118)/.479/.610/1.089 with 13 doubles, 5 home runs, 20 RBIs, 23 walks, 18 strikeouts and 28 runs scored. During that span, since May 20th, he is 1st in the Texas League in average (.373), 2nd in hits (44), 4th in OPS (1.089), T-1st in doubles (13) and 2nd in extra-base hits (18). He hit his third leadoff home run of the season in game two of the doubleheader on June 17th. He now has his new career high with 10 home runs and did so in 31 fewer games than he hit 8 in 2025. Chavez is 5th in the Texas League in batting average (.299), 5th in OBP (.407), 5th in OPS (.888), 2nd in hits (80), 3rd in doubles (19), T-4th in walks (46), T-6th in extra-base hits (29) and T-1st in runs scored (59). Riding a 7-game hitting streak, Chavez is batting .552 (16-for-29)/.629/.966/1.595 with 3 doubles, 3 home runs and 10 RBIs.

**THOSE OTHER PRAIRIE DOGS:**

The Riders are back in HODGETOWN for their second and final trip of season after going 3-3 in Amarillo in April. In their first 9 games, the Riders are hitting .342 (117-for-342)/.425/.611/1.036 with 22 home runs while averaging 8.8 runs per game. Since 2019 when Amarillo entered the league, the Riders have played more games than another other visiting team. In their 92 contests at Amarillo, the Riders are averaging 6.6 runs per game and 1.8 home runs per game. On the mound, Frisco also has the best ERA of any team (5.45 ERA).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:**

Frisco's bullpen has been great lately and is now 3rd in Double-A with a 3.82 ERA and 1st in the Texas League. Over the last 25 games, the Riders have the best bullpen ERA in the Texas League (3.25). Two weeks ago in San Antonio, Frisco threw 24.2 innings from the arm barn, allowing just eight runs (2.92ERA). In the last 16 games, the starters have also dominated, going 4-2 with a 3.72 ERA, the second-best ERA in the Texas League.

**RAFE AT HOME:**

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had an incredibly clutch introduction to his new team, homering 6 times in his first 24 games with the RoughRiders. All of but one of his 6 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including a game-tying home run in the 9th and a walk-off home run in the 9th. His 17 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization. Between High-A Hub City and Frisco, he won May Texas Rangers Player of the Month, hitting .327/.427/.714/1.141 with 11 home runs and 32 RBIs.

**ONE-RUN MADNESS LATE:**

The RoughRiders are just 9-13 in one-run games this year. Out of the 13 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 6 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 4 of the 13 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen. The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (158 runs) and the 2nd-best team in Double-A in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.48).

**GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:**

Frisco's 57 runs in the first inning this year are tied for 7th in the minors, hitting .285 (80-for-279) in the first with 13 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 28 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 14 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 18-29 (including a combined 8-11 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 23-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 16-17 in 1 or 2-run games.

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through 71 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 654 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.272) and 2nd in runs (451, 6.4 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 44 percent of their games (31-of-71). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (91), 1st in doubles (132), 2nd in SLG (.448) and 1st in OPS (.814).

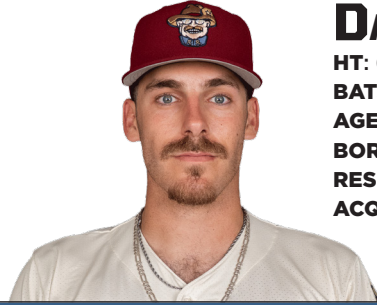

### ABOUT DALTON

-Went to Cherryville High School, where he played first base in addition to pitching for the Ironmen.

-While pitching in 2021 summer baseball, he tore his UCL and had to undergo "Tommy John" surgery, missing the entire 2022 season.

-After recovering from surgery, he pitched in his first of two seasons at the University of North Carolina in 2023. In 27 games, including 5 starts, he went 4-3 with a 3.33 ERA. In 2024, as a redshirt sophomore, he broke out as the closer for the Tar Heels, owning a 2.45 ERA with 8 saves, while striking out 74 in 58.2 innings.

-The lefty earned the win over LSU in the 2024 Chapel Hill Regional championship game and the save in Game Two of the Super Regional vs. West Virginia. He earned 2nd Team All-American honors from *Baseball America*, D1 Baseball and Perfect Game.

-He was drafted by the Rangers in the 11th round of the 2024 draft.

### 2026 SEASON

-Enters the 2026 season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system, per MLB.com.

-Became close with Nathan Eovaldi during Spring Training, who took a liking to Pence's splitter and Eovaldi showed him how he has thrown his splitter, working for an hour with him on his grip. Eovaldi texted him after he struck out a lefty in Spring Training, pleased with how the splitter was working.

-Spring Breakout: Pence started and struck out five in 2.1 scoreless innings while walking three against the Royals.

-With High-A Hub City before his promotion: 3rd in South Atlantic League with 5.1 BB%, 5th in WHIP (0.95).

-Tied career high with 6.0 IP, 0 R at Arkansas in game two of a doubleheader on May 29th.

### 2025 SEASON

-As a starting pitcher between Low-A Hickory and High-A Hub City, owned a 2.66 ERA while he had a 2.95 ERA as a reliever.

-Earned Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month in May, going 3-0 with a 0.60 ERA, striking out 24 batters in 15.0 innings (48.3 percent) to just four walks.

-Reverse splits over the course of the season:  
vs. RHB: .179/.255/.286/.541, 3 HR in 99 AB  
vs. LHB: .222/.274/.293/.567, 2 HR in 196 AB

-Among 539 Minor League pitchers with at least 80.0 innings and 18 games started, he finished 16th with a 1.02 WHIP. He was 11th in WHIP among MiLB players 22 years old or younger.

-After his longest outing being 3.2 innings through July, each of his last five starts were 4.0+ innings, with three being 5.0+ innings.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.
