The Chupacabras de Round Rock and Micheladas de Reno are scheduled for game three of their six-game series tonight at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Johnny Cueto is scheduled to take the mound against Aces LHP Tommy Henry. First pitch is set for 7:15 p.m. CT.

OFFENSE TURNS IT ON LATE

Round Rock earned an 8-2 win over Reno on Wednesday. Express CF Derek Hill jumped on the first pitch that he saw in the bottom of the first inning, driving it over the left field fence to give his team an early 1-0 lead. The Aces got on the board in the third inning, thanks to a bloop single from 3B Andrés Chaparro that scored CF Albert Almora Jr. to even the game at one apiece. Round Rock took the lead right back in the bottom of the third on a solo shot by C Andrew Knapp, making it 2-1. An RBI single from Reno C Jose Herrera tied the game at two in the top of the eighth. The bottom of the eighth saw Round Rock put up a six spot to make it an 8-2 game. LF Dustin Harris hit a bases-loaded triple, which scored three. Knapp then knocked in Harris with a single and scored thanks to a 443-foot two-run shot from 1B Blaine Crim that rounded out the scoring. Round Rock reliever RHP Dainel Robert (1-0, 5.19) went home with a blown-save win after allowing one run on two hits and one walk with three strikeouts over 1.1 innings. Reno reliever RHP Scott McGough (0-1, 4.91) took the loss with 1.2 innings of work in which he gave up two runs on three hits with two strikeouts.

READY TO SHIMMY

Express RHP Johnny Cueto is scheduled to make his first start as a member of the E-Train on Thursday night. The 38-year-old has 16 years of experience in the big leagues and signed a minor league deal with the Texas Rangers on April 23. He spent last season with the Miami Marlins and appeared in 13 games with 10 starts but missed most of the first half with a biceps injury. He is a two-time All-Star and won the 2015 World Series as a member of the Kansas City Royals.

MAY IS OUR MONTH

Round Rock improved to 9-4 in the month of May with their win last night. The Express have posted a .292 batting average (131-449) and they are averaging 6.5 runs per game. On the mound, the E-Train own a 3.49 ERA (45 ER/116.1 IP). On this 12-game homestand, they are 5-3.

PUTTING THE OPPONENT TO BED

Express C Andrew Knapp went 4-for-5 with a double, a home run, two RBI and two runs scored yesterday. Through his first 31 games this year, he is slashing .375/.465/.587 with seven doubles, five home runs, 21 RBI, 21 runs scored, 19 walks and only 30 strikeouts. He leads the Pacific Coast League in batting average and on-base percentage and is third in OPS.

JUMP ON THEM EARLY

Round Rock OF Derek Hill blasted his seventh home run of the season and it's the third time he has hit a home run on the first pitch of the game. Hill's career-high in homers is 14 which came in 2019 with Double-A Erie. He has only reached double-digit homers twice in his career.

SAMPSON SENSATIONAL

Express RHP Adrian Sampson tossed 6.0 innings of one-run baseball yesterday with eight hits, one walk and four strikeouts this year. In his last five starts, Sampson is 4-0 with a 2.17 ERA (7 ER/29.0 IP) with seven walks and 20 strikeouts.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
