**LUNDQUIST GRAND SLAM LIFTS NEW HAMPSHIRE TO SECOND STRAIGHT WIN:** Brock Lundquist blasted a sixth inning grand slam and drove in five runs as the Fisher Cats beat the Somerset Patriots 6-2 on Wednesday night at Delta Dental Stadium. The Fisher Cats loaded the bases on singles by Jordan Groshans and Gabriel Moreno and a walk to Demi Orimoloye. Lundquist then cleared the video board in right center field to break what had been a 2-2 tie. He also drove in a run with a single in the fifth inning, to match his career-best with five RBI. It was the second career grand slam for Brock, who hit one in the first inning against Dayton on April 23, 2018.

**EARLY STREAKS:** Gabriel Moreno went 3-for-3 with an HBP, improving to .500 on the season with 12 hits in 24 at bats. Moreno has hits in all six games he has played. Otto Lopez has also hit in six straight games after delivering an RBI double in the bottom of the eighth inning last night.

**PITCHING STAFF COMING AROUND:** After a tough start to the season in Portland, the Fisher Cats have opened the home portion of the schedule with a pair of wins over Somerset (New York Yankees Double-A affiliate). Starter Elvis Luciano allowed just one run on three hits in his five innings last night. New Hampshire has struck out 23 Patriots over the first two games of the series. Somerset is just 10-66 (.152) to start this six-game series.

**COMING UP:** Somerset is making its only appearance at Delta Dental Stadium in 2021. The fourth game of the series is at 6:35 p.m. tomorrow night. Manchester Firing Line presents First Responders Night at the ballpark. New Hampshire will also be home next week, playing six games with the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox Double-A affiliate).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Announced May 12: Catcher Rodrigo Vigil (pronounced vee-HEEL) has been activated on the New Hampshire roster. The 28-year old is a veteran of 473 minor league games, all in the Marlins organization.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** May 13, 2004 – In Trenton, the Fisher Cats completed a five-game series sweep of the Trenton Thunder with an 8-3 win. Cam Reimers (RY-mers) improved to 5-0. New Hampshire and Trenton played five games over three days after an opening series was washed out. The '04 champs improved to 20-12 with the series sweep.

**FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays made it two straight in Atlanta with a 4-1 win. Bo Bichette had a pair of singles. The series was to conclude this afternoon with Toronto looking to sweep the season series from the Braves after winning the first five meetings....At Triple-A...Alec Manoah allowed one hit over six innings in Buffalo's 12-0 win over Rochester (in Trenton, N.J.). Logan Warmouth had three hits, including his third homer....Vancouver (A+) over Spokane 2-0...Dunedin (A) over Bradenton 4-3.

**ON THE HILL:** RHP Kyle Johnston makes his second start. Last Friday in Portland, left after three innings in which he allowed three runs on eight hits. 24-year old was selected by the Nationals in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft (Texas). Johnston was traded from the Washington Nationals to the Blue Jays for RHP Daniel Hudson on July 31, 2019.

Somerset counters with 25-year old RHP Jason Junk, a Yankees 22<sup>nd</sup> round pick in 2017 from Seattle University. This will be his 3<sup>rd</sup> Double-A start, and second this season. Allowed one run on three hits in 3.2 IP against Harrisburg last Friday. Threw 58 pitches, 36 strikes. Spent most of 2019 at Adv. Tampa Tarpons, but made a start July 25 that season as part of a doubleheader in Erie. Told pinstripesalley.com that Patriot pitching coach Daniel Moskos has been instrumental in helping him during his time away from the Yankees' facilities.
