On this date in 2019, Ronald Guzman went 4-for-4 with 3 runs, 2 doubles and a homer to lead the Sounds in a 7-2 triumph over Oklahoma City at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Tim Dillard picked up ĥis penultimate win for the Sounds in a quality start (7.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 K).

Double Dip: Not including the resumption of suspended games, the Sounds took both games of a double-header for the first time in 2022 on Friday. Their last pair of wins in a twin bill was on May 7, 2021 at Toledo.

Frelick is Feeling It: Outfielder Sal Frelick continued his dominant stretch with the bat on Friday night,

going 4-for-7 in the doubleheader. He has nine multi-hit games in his first 15 games at the Triple-A level. Overall, Frelick is hitting .456 (26-for-57) with 10 runs, 3 doubles, a triple and 5 RBI with the Sounds.

Nashville can clinch a series win with a victory in one of today's two games. Two Hits, Five RBI: Brice Turang accomplished a couple of firsts in Friday's doubleheader. In game two, Turang made his first professional appearance at third base.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 2nd in runs (71), tied for 2nd in hits (122), tied for 7th in stolen bases (25) and 10th in total bases (174). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (91) and tied for 11th in home runs (19).

LAST OUTING: Houser made his third rehab appearance for Nashville on August 21 in game one of the series at Jacksonville. He allowed five runs (3 ER)on five hits and three walks in 3.1 innings. Houser struck out four and threw 68 pitches, 43 for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Houser faced Jacksonville twice during the 2016 season and once in 2018 when he was a member of Double-A Biloxi. His first Triple-A outing against Jacksonville came on Tuesday in game one of the series.
