The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the San Antonio Missions 6-2 on Tuesday evening from Riders Field. San Antonio (22-23, 53-60) erupted for four runs in the opening frame against Frisco (24-22, 68-47) starter **Ben Anderson** (5-7). Romeo Sanabria started the scoring with an RBI single before an RBI single by Cole Cummings and a two-run homer from Marcos Castanon made it a 4-0 game. The Riders cut into the deficit in the home half of the third inning as Cooper Johnson scored from third on a 4-6-3 double play. Trailing 4-1 in the bottom of the fifth, Johnson belted his 10th home run of the season to make it a 4-2 advantage for San Antonio. Anderson, after allowing 4 runs in his first frame of work, settled in to finish after 5.2 innings of five-run baseball in which he surrendered nine hits and two walks with three strikeouts. **Seth Clark** entered with the bases loaded and picked up an inning-ending strikeout, but not before a wild pitch allowed Cummings to score to extend the Missions lead to 5-2. San Antonio added to their lead in the top of the seventh when Sanabria doubled home Connor Hollis, making it 6-2 Missions. Clark finished after allowing one unearned run across 1.1 innings as he struck out all four batters that recorded outs against him. Larson Kindreich worked a scoreless eighth, allowing two walks and fanning two before handing the ball to Andy Rodriguez, who worked a hitless ninth inning. Offensively, the Riders notched eight hits with half of them coming from Johnson and Aaron Zavala, who each went 2-for-4. Johnson scored both runs and logged the lone RBI for Frisco in the loss.

PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strength this season, but they have struggled over their last seven games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .342 with 19 doubles, five home runs and averaging 7.1 runs per game on the offensive side, taking six of seven games. Frisco's bullpen had a 8.79 ERA (28ER/28.2 IP) and has allowed 48 hits over 28.2 innings while blowing leads in four of their six losses. The Riders have lost back-to-back series for the first time all season now and are 3-10 in their last 13 games.

HOMER HAPPY:

On Friday, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit six home runs in the last four games, with those six home runs being tied for the most in the Texas League this week (Amarillo, 6). Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 82 across their 115 games (on pace for 98, which would be tied for the fourth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 25 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .722 OPS, third with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.2 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .194 (44-for-227) with runners in scoring position over their last 25

READY TO ROCK(ER).

RoughRiders starting pitcher Kumar Rocker has been fantastic in his four starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the four starts, he has pitched 15.0 innings, allowing just one run on six hits and two walks with 21 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 12.2 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 36-21 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +59 run differential, a 4.09 ERA and is averaging 5.5 runs per game with a .757 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has nine of his 13 home runs at home while Abimelec Ortiz has hit eight of his nine homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .312/.403/.520/.923 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

-Pronounced "KA-mar", not "KOO-mar".

-Son of Tracy and Lalitha Rocker. Tracy played defensive tackle for Auburn in the 1980s. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2004 and is the current defensive line coach for the Tennessee Titans. Uncle, David, was a DT for the Rams in the early 1990s as well.

-His name "Kumar" translates to "prince" or "young child" in Hindi as a nod to his mother's Indian heritage. Mother's parents emigrated from India to Maryland in 1965.

-Drafted origionally by the Colorado Rockies in the 38th round of the 2018 draft after being named the Gatorade Georgia Baseball Player of the Year at North Oconee High School in Bogart, Georgia, but did not sign. Parents valued education and he chose to go to college.

-Played football for two years at North Oconee as well, but chose baseball.

-Broke out at Vanderbilt University as a freshman in 2019, winning College World Series Most Outstanding Player for the Commodores' championship team, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA in the College World Series. Additionally named D1Baseball.com and Baseball America Freshman of the Year and The Tennessean 2019 Sportsperson of the Year after a 12-5 season with a 3.25 ERA over 22 games with 16 starts. In 99.2 innings, he struck out 114 with 21 walks.

-His freshman season was highlighted by a no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regional round. He walked just two while striking out 19 batters in the 131-pitch no-no.

-After a COVID-shortened 2020 season, he teammed up with former RoughRider and Ranger pitcher **Jack Leiter** once again to create one of the best 1-2 punches in college baseball history. In 2021, Rocker was a unanimous First Team All-American, leading the nation with 14 wins and 179 strikeouts over his 20 starts (122.0 innings) with a 2.73 ERA.

-Drafted by the Rangers in 2022 after year in Indy Ball. *see 2022 season below*

2024 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com. Ranked as the No. 3 prospect when he joined the RoughRiders on July 26th.

-Made Double-A debut on July 26th in front of 9,151 fans at Riders Field, striking out four in his first two innings and finishing with four strikeouts over his three innings, allowing just a two-out single in the first inning to Dodgers No. 1 prospect Dalton Rushing.

-Struck out eight over four innings on August 9th at Midland, allowing just three hits and not walking a batter. He threw just 51 pitches.

-Allowed first run of the season on August 15th vs. Springfield on an RBI ground out following 14.0-straight scoreless innings to begin his Double-A career.

2023 SEASON

-Made Rangers MiLB debut with High-A Hickory, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA, striking out 42 over 28.0 innings to just seven walks. His 37.8 percent strikeout rate was tied for eighth among all MiLB players with at least six starts.

-Was removed from start on 5/17 with elbow discomfort and underwent "Tommy John" surgery (performed by Rangers team physician Dr. Keith Meister) on 5/22. He missed the remainder of the season.

2022 SEASON

-Drafted by the New York Mets in the 1st round of the 2021 draft (10th overall), but did not sign.

-Prior to being drafted by Rangers, played for Independent Tri-City Valley Cats, making five starts, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA with 35 strikeouts to four walks over 20 innings. Valley Cats (in Troy, NY) was managed by former Ranger Pete Incaviglia.

-Did not see action in Rangers system after 2022 draft.
