All About the Curve: The Somerset Patriots welcome the Altoona Curve to TD Bank Ballpark for the first time ever. The Curve are 36-28 this season, 1.5 games behind Akron for first place in the Southwest Division. Altoona features eight of *Baseball America's* top 30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects.

Late Woes: Somerset has dropped each of its last four games -- tying its longest losing streak of the season (6/6-6/10) -- and five of its last six. The Patriots have held at least a two-run lead in each of those five losses, including leads of three runs or more in four of those games and in each of their last three contests. Somerset carried a 6-3 loss to the bottom of the eighth Wednesday night in Richmond and lost 7-6, held a 3-0 lead in the second inning Saturday night and lost 7-3, led 5-1 entering the sixth inning Sunday and lost 8-7, and led 6-1 through the sixth inning last night and lost 9-7. Last night marked the largest blown lead for the Patriots in a loss this season. Teams are outscoring Somerset 27-14 from the sixth inning on over this six-game stretch. The Patriots have only lost three games this year when leading after the end of the seventh inning; two of those three losses have come in the last two games. The team's bullpen owns an 8.69 ERA (19 ER over 19.2 IP) over the last six games. The bullpen ERA has increased from 2.58 to 3.06 on the year across this stretch.

Junk Day: RHP Janson Junk allowed one run over six innings pitched last night with five strikeouts. He only faced two over the minimum across his first five innings. The Washington native now leads all qualified MiLB pitchers with a 1.46 ERA. Additionally, Junk owns the fourth-lowest WHIP (0.91) and fourth-lowest BAA (.174) across all MiLB levels.

Ozzy Ozzy Ozzy!: Infielder Oswald Peraza is currently riding a team-best seven-game hit streak since July 11th. Over this stretch, Peraza is hitting .394 (13-for-33) with two home runs, five RBI, seven runs, three doubles, three stolen bases and a .429 OBP. He's also recorded multiple hits in six of the seven games in this streak. Peraza has thrived in July, batting .343 (24-for-70) with three home runs, eight RBI, 15 runs, five stolen bases and a .378 OBP.

Gill-I-Am: Outfielder Isiah Gilliam went 1-for-2 last night with a home run, two sac flies and a career-high five RBI. Gilliam has now reached base safely in 23 of his last 25 games dating back to June 15th. Over that stretch, the switch-hitter is batting .353 (24-for-68) with three home runs, 11 runs scored, 16 RBI, nine doubles, 16 walks and a .466 OBP. His batting average now stands at a season-high .253 entering Wednesday night.

Locked In: Outfielder Brandon Lockridge recorded his second three-hit game with the Patriots last night. The Yankees 2018 5th round pick is now batting .345 (10-for-29) with two home runs and three RBI over his first seven games with the club. Lockridge was rated the No. 20 prospect in the Yankees organization by MLB Pipeline prior to the 2021 season.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has the lowest ERA (3.23) among all of Minor League Baseball (full season). The staff also owns the second-lowest BAA (.208) and fourth-lowest WHIP (1.16) in the minors.
