CARDS CLUTCH UP ON MOUND, TAKE GAME ONE: The Cardinals pitched out of three bases loaded jams and got solo homers from Chase Davis and Matt Lloyd as Springfield defeated the Arkansas Travelers 4-1 in Game 1 of the Texas League North Division Championship Series on Tuesday night at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. Brandon Komar picked up the win for the Cardinals with 6.0 innings of one-run ball, and Ryan Shreve worked out of a bases loaded, nobody out jam to preserve a one-run lead. Matt Svanson worked a 1-2-3 9th to pick up the save.



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander Brandyn Garcia gets the ball for the Travs in Game 2...Made 13 starts with Arkansas in the regular season and went 0-2 with a 2.83 ERA...Struck out 49 with 21 BB and allowed 38 H in 47.2 IP...Opponents batted .221 against him...Last pitched on Saturday, June 14 at NW Arkansas and surrendered 5 R (3 ER) on 7 H with a walk and a strikeout over 3.0 IP...Pitched to a 9.00 ERA in his final two regular season starts...Promoted to Arkansas June 28 after being named Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for June...Named Texas League Pitcher of the Week after firing 5.0 hitless innings on July 1 against Frisco in his Double-A debut...Began the season at High-A Everett where he went 6-0 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 appearances (12 starts), striking out 85 in 68.1 IP...Made 9 total apperances between the ACL and Low-A Modesto after being drafted and went 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA in 10.0 IP...Selected by the Mariners in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of Texas A&M...Spent his senior season in the Aggies bullpen going 3-3 with a 5.56 ERA and a save...Spent his first 3 collegiate seasons at Quinnipiac where he pitched mostly as a starter...24 years old

**CARDS SET FOR DIVISION SERIES REMATCH AGAINST TRAVS:** For the 2nd straight season, the Springfield Cardinals take on the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) in the best-of-3 Texas League Division Series. The Cards fell to the Travelers in the TLDS in 2023 in three games, falling in game 3 at Dickey-Stephens Park 14-1 after splitting the first two games.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**DIVISION SERIES REMATCH:** The Cardinals have reached the postseason for the 7th time in franchise history, and the 2nd straight year for just the 2nd time in franchise history (2009-10), and meet the Travelers in the Texas League Division Series for the 2nd straight season. In 2023 the Cards fell in 3 games to the Travs. Springfield has reached the championship series twice, dropping 3 of 4 to San Antonio in 2007 and winning its only Texas League Title with a 3-1 series win over Frisco in 2012.

**CARDS TAKE SERIES EDGE:** With a 4-1 win in the series opener in North Little Rock on Tuesday, the Cardinals snapped a two-game losing streak in Game 1. Springfield lost the opener last season to the Travs by the final of 3-1 at Hammons Field, and dropped the opener of their 2016 series vs NW Arkansas 9-6 in Springfield. The last time the Cards won the series opener was in their Texas League title season of 2012, an 8-6 win at Tulsa.

HISTORIC CARDS: In a historic campaign, the 2024 Springfield Cardinals have set several franchise records:

- » The Cardinals won 79 games during the regular season, surpassing the previous record of 77 (2017 & 2017).
- » Springfield won 42 road games this season to set a new franchise record, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The Cards began the season with a club record 9-game winning streak.
- The Cardinals' pitching staff set a new franchise record with 1,279 strikeouts on the season, surpassing the mark of 1,263 set in 2019.
- » In finishing the season hitting .331, Bryan Torres set a new franchise record for highest batting average held by Tyler Minges (.324 in 2005.)
- » Matt Svanson tied Mark Worrell (2006) and Chris Perez (2007) with his 27th save of the season on Saturday night at San Antonio.
- » Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 5-0 win in game one of a doubleheader on June 20 at Corpus Christi.
- » Chandler Redmond set the new franchise record with his 60th home run in a Springfield uniform, passing Xavier Scruggs.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Several Cardinals finished the 2024 campaign atop the Texas League in indivdual categories. A star (\*) indicates leading all of Double-A:

**GRINDIN':** All season long, the Cardinals have been one of the toughtest teams to strike out in Minor League Baseball. The Birds whiffed 1,011 times in the 138-game regular season and finish the campaign with a strikeout rate of 19.10%, which is the 2nd-lowest number in Minor League Baseball behind only the Reno Aces (Triple-A, ARI) of the Pacific Coast League (19.03%).

HOLDIN' 'EM DOWN: While the 2024 campaign has been a roller coaster ride of sorts for the Cardinal pitching staff, the Birds' arms ended on the upswing. Since the beginning of August Springfield compiled a 3.48 ERA over their last 40 games, a mark that is 4th-best in the Texas League. Through the end of July the Cardinals sported a 4.64 ERA, 9th in the circuit.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** has been swinging a hot bat down the stretch in the 2024 regular season. Including the postseason, **Church** has hit safely in 11 straight games and has multiple hits in 2 of his last 4. For the month, the UC Irvine product is batting .341 (15-for-44). **Church** was named the Caridnals Minor League Player of the Month in April when he hit .349 with 3 HR, 18 RBIs and a .914 OPS.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 27-for-27 and his 53 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 27 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 3-0 with a 1.50 and is 16-for-16 in save opportunities. No other reliever in the minor leauges with 11 or more save opportunities has gone without a blown save in 2024. The Cardinals are 60-1 when leading after 8 innings this season, including the postseason.
