ABOUT LAST NIGHT... Luis De Los Santos drove in four runs and scored a fifth to finish a triple shy of the cycle in the Vancouver Canadians' 8-6 win over the Spokane Indians (Rockies) on Tuesday at Avista Stadium.

De Los Santos started his night at the dish in a big way. With the C's leading 1-0 after a Tanner Kirwer infield single, a two-base throwing error and a Phil Clarke RBI groundout, De Los Santos arrived at the plate with two men on and one out. The Bajos de Haina, DR native took advantage of the short porch in right for an opposite field blast that made it 4-0 Vancouver.

Spokane would score an unearned run in the third and plate another in the fourth after consecutive hits and a sacrifice fly, but the Canadians answered with three in the top of the fifth. In that inning, the first three hitters reached on two walks and a hit by pitch before Spencer Horwitz singled home the fifth run of the night. After a double play brought in another run, a wild pitch plated the third run of the stanza to put Vancouver up 7-2.

Starter Sean Wymer (W, 1-2) turned in five strong innings before he was tagged for three runs in the sixth after a lead-off single, a walk and the league-best ninth home run from Spokane's Michael Toglia to bounce him from the game. On came Marcus Reyes, who retired the next three hitters to keep it 7-5 C's and went on to work two scoreless innings.

The Canadians plated an insurance run in the seventh on a pair of hit batters and De Los Santos' RBI single to put them up 8-5 before the Indians scratched across a run in the bottom of the eighth.

Will McAffier (S, 3) - who was activated prior to today's game after a stint with Team Canada in the Olympic qualifiers - returned to action with a perfect ninth to secure the 8-6 win.

HASTA AVISTA: Vancouver arrives in Spokane this week for the first of two visits to Avista Stadium and the second of four meetings with the Indians. These two teams last met May 11-16 at Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro, when the C's took the last five games of the series after dropping the home-away-from-home opener. The Canadians outscored the Rockies affiliate 27-16 in that series.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: June 9, 1999 - After being ejected in the 12th inning by plate umpire Randy Marsh for arguing a catcher's interference call, Bobby Valentine returns to the dugout with a fake mustache and glasses. The National League will suspend the Mets' manager for two games and fine him for using the disguise.

WHERE ARE WE?: For the first time since the first week of the season, Vancouver is playing somewhere else other than Ron Tonkin Field. The C's started the year on the road in Pasco, WA before playing four consecutive series (three home, one road) in Oregon's Tualatin Valley. Tonight is just their eighth game away from their home-away-from-home.

TEAM RANKINGS: The C's are ranked 2nd in the circuit in team batting average (.232) and team ERA (3.72) and have the third-best fielding percentage (.975).

KIR-WOW: Tanner Kirwer is the bona-fide "straw that stirs the drink" for the Canadians. The Sherwood Park, Alberta native leads the team in average (.316), home runs (4), on-base percentage (.463), slugging (.516), OPS (.979), hits (30), runs (25), total bases (49) and stolen bases (19).

DID YOU KNOW?: C's skipper Donnie Murphy made his pro debut for Spokane in 2002 after he was drafted by the Royals in the 5th round that year. 19-year-old Murph hit .303 with 10 doubles, two triples, 12 runs scored and 15 RBI in 28 games before he was promoted to Low-A Burlington. He made his MLB debut with Kansas City in 2004 and went on to play in parts of nine seasons with five different teams.

ON THE HILL: #10 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) CJ Van Eyk gets the ball tonight for his second look at Spokane. He faced the Indians on May 13 for his second career start; that night, the right-hander went 4.2 innings and gave up one run on three hits (including a solo homer from Brenton Doyle) and recorded his first seven strikeouts as a pro. Van Eyk, 22, last worked on June 2 against Eugene when he lasted five innings and allowed three runs on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts.

MLB.com's #8 Rockies prospect Chris McMahon gets the nod for Spokane. In his last turn on June 3 against Tri-City, the right-hander took the loss after giving up three runs on six hits in five innings pitched. McMahon, 22, is set for his third look at Vancouver; the C's mustered a solo home run as part of four hits and one run in five innings on May 11 before touching him up for five runs on ten hits in six innings on May 16. He played collegiately at Miami (FL) before the Rockies took him 46th overall in '20.
