LEHIGH VALLEY, PA (April 4, 2023) - The Scranton Wilkes/Barre RailRiders dropped their first road contest of the season 5-3 against the Lehigh Valley Iron Pigs. Jake Bauers highlighted with his team leading third home run of the season.

The IronPigs struck first in the second after Dalton Guthrie knocked a single up the middle and Jordan Qsar walked to reach. A double off the bat of

Jake Bauers was there again for the RailRiders in the fourth. Andres Chaparro reached on an error and the next batter up, Bauers, crushed a moonshot into centerfield to tie the contest at two a piece.

Lehigh Valley countered once again in the sixth. After a lead off single from Dalton Guthrie. Osar launched a homer to deep right field making it 4-2.

The home team added to their lead in the eighth. Osar walked to start the frame and quickly stole second. An RBI single from Esteban Quiroz drove

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre went down swinging in the top of the ninth. Elijah Dunham doubled down the left field line to start off the frame. He shifted to third on a fly out and trotted home on a ground ball to the right side. The RailRiders threatened by couldn't come up with any more runs, falling 5-3.

Sean Boyle got the start tossing three and a third on 74 pitches. He allowed two runs on three hits and three walks. Boyle struck out five. D.J. Snelten finished off the fourth stranding the inherited runner. He pitched a clean fifth as well. Michael Gomez (L, 0-1) threw an inning allowing the go-ahead two runs, one earned, in his frame. Deivi Garcia took two, letting up a run in the eighth.

Noah Skirrow pitched five innings of work for the Iron Pigs. He allowed two runs, one earned, on four hits. Jake Jewell (W, 1-0) in his season debut put up a zero in the sixth. Jesus Cruz and Jeff Hoffman each had a clean frame. Lehigh Valley called on Luis Ortiz (S, 1) for a save in the bottom of the ninth.

NEWS & NOTES

SNELTEN STRONG - Prior to this season, D.J. Snelten had not taken the mound in a professional regular season game since 2018. He was originally drafted in the 9th round in 2013 by the San Francisco Giants. Snelten made his Major League debut on April 28, 2018 and went on to pitch just 4.1 innings in four appearances in the bigs. He was signed by the Yankees in August of 2022 after playing in multiple organizations including independent ball. Snelten is one of just four southpaws on Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's pitching staff. Last night, he inherited a runner for the second time this season and stranded him on base. Snelten has had two appearances this summer allowing no runs on no hits. He has walked just one and struck out two for a clean ERA.

BOOSTED BY BAUERS - Jake Bauers showed off his power on through the first four games with three homers and two doubles. He leads the team with a .545 average and five runs batted in. Bauers has totalled six hits and four walks. He has only struck out twice. His three homers puts him tied for second in the league. And, his OBP of .667 and OPS of 2.212 has him leading the International League East. The lefty has played in all four games either in the outfield, at first, or as the designated hitter.

BEHIND THE PLATE - Rodolfo Duran, Mickey Gasper, and Jose Godoy open the season as new manager Shelley Duncan's options behind the plate. Godoy has big league time with both Minnesota and Pittsburgh. Duran and Gasper are set to make their Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debuts. Gasper is one of just five players on the roster drafted by the New York Yankees. So far they have split time as catcher with all three getting featured in one game on Opening Weekend.

ERROR'S UP - Last night the RailRiders made three errors in the contest, the most of any game this season. Both Andres Chaparro and Oswald Peraza recorded throwing errors. It was Chaparro's second error of the season. Sean Boyle had a problematic pickoff attempt that caused him his first miscue of the season. The team defensive percentage is .974 with four total errors.

LEFT ON BASE - The RailRiders have had no shortage of baserunners they just haven't been able to bring them home. On Sunday's contest Scranton/Wilkes-Barre left eight on base, last night the team left ten runners. They went one for eleven with runners in scoring position. The team has left a total of 28 runners on in their four opening games.

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE - The team's pitching is fourth in the league with a 3.00 earned run average. SWB has given up just 12 earned runs, while LHV has given up only nine but in one less contest. The Iron Pigs are also just ahead of them with a 2.89 ERA. However, out of 30 teams in the league, the RailRiders are tied for second to last in batting average with the Bees for a .194 team average. They are ticks above the Red Wings who are on the bottom floor with a .186 average. The Iron Pigs have a team average of .257 at the plate.

ELECTRIC ELIJAH- Elijah Dunham had the first three-hit game of the season for the RailRiders last night. Dunham recorded a single and two doubles. It was his second multi-hit game of the 2023. He also scored a run. It was his extra base hit this summer. Manager Shelley Duncan has placed him in the leadoff spot for two out of his four starts. The other pair have come in the three hole. Dunham has also played in all three outfield positions. In eight total chaces he has made no errors.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18). Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza madé his big league début at the end of last séason and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.
