YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels had their seven-game win streak snapped with a 3-0 loss to the Akron RubberDucks. **Matt Frisbee** issued three walks and hit a batter in the first inning as the RubberDucks plated three runs in the frame with a wild pitch, an RBI HBP to Julian Escobedo and an RBI single by Daniel Schneeman. Relievers **Travis Perry**, **Solomon Bates** and **John Russell** combined for six scoreless innings of work. The Richmond offense was held to four hits in the shutout.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first meeting between the two clubs this year and the RubberDucks' only trip to The Diamond in 2022. The Flying Squirrels visit Akron twice, a six-game series from May 31-June 5 and another six-game set from August 23-28.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS had won seven straight prior to Friday's 3-0 loss. They have won eight of their last 10 games, all in the current homestand. Last week, they took five games in the six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond after dropping four of six on the road in Erie the previous week, their only series loss so far this year. They opened the season taking two in a three-game series at Bowie from April 8-10 before winning four games in a six-game set against Altoona in their first homestand from April 12-17.

THE RUBBERDUCKS snapped a three-game slide with Friday's 3-0 win. Prior to dropping the first three games of the current series, Akron had won its previous four games. They won four of six in last week's home series against the Curve. On the year, the RubberDucks have won their two home series and lost their two road series. Akron's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects, including No. 1 George Valera, No. 2 Daniel Espino, No. 4 Brayan Rocchio, No. 8 Logan Allen, No. 9 Jose Tena, No. 11 Tanner Burns, No. 16 Bo Naylor and No. 23 Xzavion Curry. Last season, the RubberDucks finished the season with a 73-46 record before sweeping the Baysox, 3-0, in the Double-A Northeast Championship Series.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his sixth start of the season. Entering play today, he has pitched 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings. Last week, he made two starts at The Diamond against the Bowie Baysox, pitching six scoreless innings in each outing. He is currently ranked sixth in the Eastern League with a 1.71 ERA and tied for fifth with 26.1 innings pitched this season. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Hunter Gaddis makes his fourth start of the year and his fifth overall appearance this season. Last time out, Gaddis worked five innings against Altoona on Sunday and allowed one unearned run with no walks and seven strikeouts. Five of the six earned runs he has allowed on the year game during his second outing of the season on April 19 at Bowie when he recorded two outs and left before the end of the first inning. He followed with five relief innings on April 26 against the Curve with one run allowed and seven strikeouts. Gaddis was selected in the fifth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Georgia State.

WINNING EARLY: The Flying Squirrels are sitting in first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, 1.5 games over second-place Harrisburg. Richmond's 16-9 record is the best start in franchise history through 25 games, ahead of 15-10 starts in 2010, 2014 and 2021. The best record through 26 games in team history is 15-11, which was set in 2010, 2014 and 2021.

COMEBACK KIDS: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in eight of their 16 wins. Richmond trailed before coming back to win in five straight victories from April 13-21. On April 13, the fell behind, 5-1, to the Curve before scoring nine runs in a 10-6 win. On April 14, Altoona pulled ahead 3-0 in the first before Richmond rallied and took the lead with a two-run homer by **Sean Roby** in the seventh. On April 16, the Curve pulled ahead, 4-0, before Richmond scored the next eight runs to win, 8-4. On April 17, Altoona led, 2-1, before the Flying Squirrels tied the game in the eighth and later won on a walk-off grand slam by **Will Wilson** in the bottom of the 10th. In the second game of a double-header on April 21 at Erie, the SeaWolves scored two in the first inning and the game was tied, 3-3, in the last frame before the Flying Squirrels plated five runs in the top of the seventh. On April 30, the Baysox took an early 1-0 lead before the Flying Squirrels scored the next three runs to win 3-1. On Tuesday, the RubberDucks opened a 3-0 lead in the fourth and pulled ahead in the top of the ninth, 4-3, before **Frankie Tostado** tied the game in the bottom of the ninth and **Shane Matheny** hit a walk-off single in the 10th. On Wednesday, Akron pulled ahead, 2-1, until a six-run seventh pushed the Flying Squirrels to a 7-3 win.

PACKING THE HOUSE: On the year, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (99,087) and average attendance (6,193). Richmond is third of the 120 MiLB teams in total attendance and 10th in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 33 home runs this season, which is tied for second in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is tied for the league lead with eight homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 182 home runs.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last eight games since April 28, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a league-best 2.10 ERA (17 ER/73.0 IP) with 79 strikeouts. The Richmond pitching staff has held the Baysox and RubberDucks to a .191 batting average the last eight games. In that span, Bowie and Akron have hit 7-for-74 (.095) with runners in scoring position and left 66 runners on base.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** is tied for the lead in the Eastern League with eight home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He hit five home runs in the first home series of the season against Altoona from April 12-17 and he homered twice in last week's set against Bowie. He has hit more homers at home than the team's leaders in 2010 (3), 2012 (6), 2015 (6), 2017 (6) and 2019 (4).

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .383 (18-for-47) with three homers, three doubles and nine RBIs over his last 12 games since April 22. He went 0-for-4 on Thursday, snapping his league-leading 10-game hitting streak. Tostado has picked up multiple hits in five of his last nine games since last Wednesday. Tostado is ranked third in the Eastern League in batting average (.329) and third in hits (28).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the league in home runs (8), tied for sixth in RBIs (17), fifth in SLG (.573), ninth in OPS (.924) and third in total bases (47). **Frankie Tostado** is third in batting average (.329), third in hits (28) and tied for seventh in total bases (43). **Shane Matheny** is 10th in OBP (.409) and 10th in OPS (.890). **Will Wilson** is tied for sixth in runs scored (16). **Jake Dahlberg** is sixth in ERA (1.71) and tied for fifth in innings pitched (26.1). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for third (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (30). **Chris Wrigth** is tied for fifth in saves (3).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Right-handed pitcher **Sean Hjelle**, who pitched for the Flying Squirrels in the 2019 and 2021 seasons, made his Major League debut for the San Francisco Giants on Friday night against the St. Louis Cardinals. He worked the seventh inning out of the bullpen and did not allow a base runner, picking up his first strikeout by getting Corey Dickerson swinging. With his debut, Hjelle tied former pitcher Jon Rauch as the tallest player on record in MLB history at 6-foot-11. With the Flying Squirrels, Hjelle made 19 starts over two seasons and went 4-4 with a 3.96 ERA.

It was the fourth 10-strikeout start of the year. Surkamp finished the season with eight outings with 10-or-more strikeouts. No one else in franchise history has more than three in their career.
