A LOOK BACK AT LAST SEASON

The Baysox finished the 2023 season with a 67-70 overall record. Bowie surged in the second half of the campaign, going 36-32, but ultimately missed out on the second-half title in the South-west division by 4.5 games to the Richmond Flying Squirrels. The Baysox finished fourth in the Eastern League in team average (.242) and home runs (148). Last season was the third-consecutive campaign that the No. 1 prospect in baseball (per MLB Pipeline) took the field for the Baysox, as IF Jackson Holliday made his Double-A debut with Bowie in July. IF Coby Mayo also took home Eastern League MVP honors, as the Baysox slugger mashed an Eastern League-best 30 doubles in just 78 games, in addition to 49 extra-base hits - third-most in the league.

WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE FIGHTINS

The Reading Fightin Phils enter 2024 off the back of a 59-77 season in 2023 - ultimately missing the Eastern League postseason. The Double-A Affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, Reading is once again managed by Al Pedrique, who returns for his second season at the helm. The R-Phils' roster currently includes four of the Phillies' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Gabriel Rincones Jr. (No. 10 PHI), OF/1B Carlos De La Cruz (No. 13 PHI), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 21 PHI), IF Robert Moore (No. 26 PHI).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Robinson Pina gets the ball today for Reading. This will be the first start for Pina as a member of the Phillies' organization, as the Dominican Republic-native was signed by the Phillies as a minor league free agent, following six seasons in the Angels organization. Pina pitched across three levels in 2023 with High-A Tri-City, Double-A Rocket City and Triple-A Salt Lake, posting a 4.07 ERA across 97.1 innings with 90 strikeouts. His arsenal includes a fastball, slider and splitter.

MEET THE SQUAD

The 2024 Baysox roster is headlined by a healthy returning cast. OFs Jud Fabian, John Rhodes, Donta' Williams; IF Billy Cook, Anthony Servideo and pitchers Carlos Tavera, Alex Pham, Houston Roth, Keagan Gillies, Brandon Young and Kade Strowd have all spent at least half a season in Bowie, while OF Dylan Beavers, IF TT Bowens and Collin Burns, C Connor Pavolony and Silas Ardoin and pitchers Trace Bright, Kyle Brnovich, Dylan Heid, Zach Peek and Ryan Long have all seen significant time with the Baysox. Newcomers to the squad include C Samuel Basallo, RHP Kyle Virbitsky, and IF Frederick Bencosme. Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24), Bencosme (No. 27), and Cook (No. 30) rank in the Orioles' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline.

FEEL THE BURNS

Collin Burns enjoyed a career-night on Saturday, driving in a career-high seven RBI and was a double away from the cycle. He hit the first Baysox homer of 2024 with a three-run homer in the second inning, tripled in a run in the fourth and singled in a pair in the sixth. His home run was also his first at Double-A. The 6th round pick in the 2021 Draft by the Orioles is back healthy after playing just 9 games with Bowie last year.

20/20 VISION

Last season saw IF/OF Billy Cook (24 HR, 30 SB) become just the second player to achieve a 20 home run/20 stolen base season exclusively with the Baysox in the franchise's history (DJ Stewart - 2017). OF Jud Fabian (24 HR, 31 SB) also completed a 20/20 campaign in 2023 with his numbers between Bowie and High-A Aberdeen. Cook and Fabian notched just the second and third 20/20 seasons in the Orioles' minor league system since Stewart's feat in 2017, with the only other such season in that window coming from former Baysox OF Zach Watson in 2019.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers ended last season on a tear with the Baysox. After hitting .337 with a .443 OBP in August, winning Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month for his debut month at the Double-A level, Beavers finished strong. His .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way. The 2022 first round pick out of Cal enters 2024 as the No. 7 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26. Struck out five over four scoreless innings against Erie on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
