EL PASO CHIHUAHUAS (28-36) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (18-46)

RHP SEAN REYNOLDS (2-0, 7.62) VS. RHP PEYTON BATTENFIELD (2-3, 9.26)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque dropped game one last night, 10-3, to El Paso and has lost 12 of its last 14 contests ... The lsotopes are 1-3 against the Chihuahuas at Isotopes Park in 2024 ... Peyton Battenfield is set to take the hill for the Isotopes while Sean Reynolds is scheduled to start for El Paso.

JONESY: In his 11th rehab game with the Isotopes last night, Nolan Jones went 0-for-2 with a walk and hit by pitch. Over 11 games, Jones is 7-for-37 with six RBI, five walks, 11 punchouts and one home run. Has reached by in 10 of 11 contests.

SERIES OPENERS: With the loss last night, the Isotopes fall to 1-11 in series openers and 0-7 at home. They have been outscored by 54 runs in such contests (116-62)

LAST 16: Over the Isotopes last 16 contests, they have scored 51 runs—the fewest in Triple-A and third-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball (fewest: Tri-City, 45).

RISP: Albuquerque went 1-for-9 with RISP yesterday ... Over the club's last 16 games, they are 20-for-117 (.170).

TWO HOMER GAME: El Paso's Cal Mitchell belted two homers last night, the 12th two-homer game by an opposing player and third-straight game at Isotopes Park by the opposition (also: Trey Sweeney June 2 and Ryan Ward June 1).

XBH: The Isotopes allowed 10 extra-base hits yesterday (four homers, one triple and five doubles), tied for the second-most extra-base hits relented in a game, three times (most: 13, May 17 vs. Sugar Land).

NOW THAT'S QUALITY: The Chihuahuas' Miguel Cienfuegos tossed 6.0 innings of two-run ball last night, the 11th quality start by an opposing starter and fifth in nine June games.

NINTH FRAME: The Isotopes yielded four runs in the ninth frame yesterday, bringing the season total to 51—second-most in Minor League Baseball (most: Indianapolis, 52). It's the fifth time relenting four-plus runs in the ninth, all coming in Albuquerque (most: eight, March 31 vs. El Paso).

OUTFIELD ASSISTS: Trevor Boone and Jones each tallied outfield assists last night, giving Albuquerque five for the year and the first game in 2024 with multiple in a game. Boone nabbed a runner at third while Jones' assist threw out a runner at second, the first outfield assist at second base for Albuquerque this year.

DOUBLE-DIGITS: Albuquerque permitted 10 runs last night, the 19th time allowing double-digit runs in 64 games.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk tallied three hits last night including a double, his 18th multi-hit game, fifth three-hit contest of 2024 and first since May 28 vs. Oklahoma City. Recorded doubles in back-to-back games for the first time this year ... His 21 doubles is T-3rd-most in all of Triple-A.

BOONIE: Trevor Boone registered two doubles last night, his first Triple-A game with multiple two-baggers. His second multi-hit game of 2024. Has reached base in 15 of his last 16 games.

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes has gone hitless in two-straight games for the third time in 2024 (last: April 20-21 vs. El Paso). Has four hitless games over his last six contests. During the stretch, he is hitting .100 (2x20) with three walks.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard tallied a double yesterday. Has three hits over 33 June at-bats, all doubles ... Since May 26, he is hitting .111 (6x54), with his average dropping from .315 to .275 during

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo went 0-for-4 last night, his sixth hitless contest in his last nine games.

COOLIN' OFF: From April 21-May 18, Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Last 13 games, hitting .163 (8x49) with a double, triple, two homers.

JC: Julio Carreras swiped his team-leading 18th stolen base of the year last Thursday. Is one shy of tying his career high for a season (high: 19, 2022 with Spokane, 17, and Hartford, two).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 3rd in average (.316) ... Aaron Schunk is T-2nd in doubles (21) and 9th in XBH (27) ... Coco Montes is 2nd in average (.327), 3rd in hits (72), T-4th in walks (35), T-6th in triples (4), 7th in OPS (.928), 8th in OBP (.414), and 9th in total bases (113) ... Sam Hilliard is 5th in XBH (29), 7th in runs (45) and total bases (118), T-9th in homers (11) and T-10th in walks (33) and in triples (3). and T-10th in walks (33), and in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is T-5th in stolen bases (18).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 2nd in triples (28), 3rd in hits (614), total bases (1,043), slugging (.465), and average (.274) 4th in doubles (136), 6th in OPS (.819) and 10th in runs (358).

200 RBI: Coco Montes became the fifth Isotope to tally 200 RBI with the club May 25, six days after Sam Hilliard.

ATTENDANCE: Over 34 home openings, the Isotopes have tallied the fifth-highest total attendance in all of MiLB (221,026).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
