THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2011, Nashville Sounds radio broadcaster Stu Paul fell down the stairs at Iowa's Principal Park following the Sounds' 4-3 victory.

Tonight's Game: The Sounds look to halt a four game skid tonight against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. Caleb Boushley makes his minor leagues-leading 19th start of the campaign for Nashville, while Jacksonville sends Ronald Bolaños to the hill.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley gets the ball today for the Sounds. The right-hander is 5-4 with a 4.61 ERA (84.0 IP/43 ER) in 2023. He worked through a tough start last time out, allowing six runs (5 ER) in 5.0 innings against Columbus, but earning no decision. Boushley ranks among league leaders in starts (T-1st), WHIP (8th, 1.38), opponent average (8th, .264), ERA (9th) and innings (9th). The Hortonville, Wisconsin native was named the 2022 Sounds Pitcher of the Year after going 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The Brewers acquired Boushley in the Triple-A phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021. He was originally drafted in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of UW-La Crosse.

Ronald Bolaños: 26-year-old Ronald Bolaños makes his 14th appearance (13th start) of the campaign for Jacksonville. The right-hander is 3-8 with a 7.44 ERA (55.2 IP/46 ER) this season. He turned in his best start of 2023 his last time out, holding Charlotte scoreless over six innings on July 6 and earning a win. Despite the effort, Bolaños ranks 60th in ERA out of 62 International League pitchers with 50 innings. The Cuba native was signed as a free agent by Miami on March 24. He has combined to go 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA in 18 appearances (5 starts) in the Majors with San Diego (2019) and Kansas City (2020-22). Bolaños was originally signed as a free agent by San Diego on August 4, 2016.

Welcome Back, Tyler: Outfielder Tyler Naquin made his first appearance for Nashville since June 24 last night, looping a two-run single in his first at-bat. He finished the contest with three hits, extending his on-base streak to 10 games and hitting streak to six games. During his on-base streak dating back to June 11, Naquin is batting .405 (15-for-37) with seven runs, three homers, eight RBI and 1.085 OPS.

The Bull on Parade: Infielder Abraham Toro lined two hits last night, extending his hitting streak to a modest five games. He is batting .421 (8-for-19) with four runs, two extra-base hits, an RBI and 1.132 OPS. Toro was named the Nashville Sounds Player of the Week last week for his strong series against the Louisville Bats.

Frelick's Dazzling Display: Outfielder Sal Frelick was a human highlight reel last night, beating out two infield singles and stealing a base. In the field, Frelick made a diving play to steal a base hit in the third inning, then doubled off Jacksonville's Jacob Amaya at first on a routine fly ball in the fifth inning. He is tied with Tyrone Taylor and Keston Hiura for second on the team with three outfield assists.

Bolt Is Back: Outfielder Skye Bolt returns to the lineup tonight for the first time since July 9. In his last 10 contests, Bolt is batting .342 (13-for-38) with seven runs, five doubles, two triples, a home run, 10 RBI and a 1.077 OPS. He has tallied an RBI in five of his last six contests.

Jarvis Bounces Back: Making his second career Triple-A start last night, Justin Jarvis recovered from a tough debut by striking out six Jumbo Shrimp over 6.0 innings. He fanned three of his first four hitters, then struck out his final hitter with the go-ahead run on base. At the time of his promotion from Double-A Biloxi on June 30, Jarvis ranked among Southern League leaders in innings (1st, 75.2), starts (T-1st, 14), strikeouts (2nd, 91), wins (T-2nd, 6), ERA (4th, 3.33), winning percentage (5th, .600) and WHIP (7th, 1.26).

Pitchers Pace the Pack: Despite posting the league's highest ERA in July (7.64), Nashville pitching still leads the International League in ERA (4.43) ahead of the Norfolk Tides (4.45). They also lead the circuit in fewest walks allowed (336) and WHIP (1.41) and rank second in runs allowed (437) and home runs allowed (tied, 91).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect (No. 17 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect and right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 648-560 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley worked 5.0 innings last time out vs. Columbus on July 9, allowing six runs (five earned) on eight hits. The right-hander walked more (4) than he struck out (1) for the fourth time this season. Boushley did not earn a decision in the rain-shortened 7-6 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This will be Boushley's fifth career start against Jacksonville. He is 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA (21.1 IP/6 ER) and 21 strikeouts.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made first Opening Day start for Nashville, pitching in Game 1 of the season-opening doubleheader against Louisville
- Allowed just one earned run over first two starts (1.42 ERA), both coming in doubleheaders
- Earned the win in back-to-back starts on April 26 vs. Omaha and May 2 at St. Paul...posted 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP/3 ER) over span
