ADD IT TO THE MANTLE: On Monday, DaShawn Keirsey Jr. was named the International League Player of the Week for August 20-25. Keirsey Jr. hit for a league-best. 500 average (minimum 10 plate appearances), going 9-for-18, tying the league-high with two triples, hitting two home runs and drove in eight, tied for the second-most in the IL. His 19 total bases were the third-most in the league. Among hitters with at least 10 plate appearances, he ranked second with a 1.056 slugging percentage and a 1.601 OPS, finishing third with a .545 on-base percentage.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DUB CLUB: Caleb Boushley will look to become the Saints' second 10-game winner in franchise history tonight, joining Randy Dobnak who did so on Friday night. Boushley previously won double-digit games in 2022, going 12-2 with Nashville. No IL pitcher has had multiple 10+ win seasons since 2021. Only 16 IL pitchers have posted multiple 10+ win seasons in the Statcast Era (2015). A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: DaShawn Keirsey Jr. has put together an impressive 2024 campaign, recording 108 hits, 14 home runs and 31 stolen bases. He is the only Triple-A player this season to record at least 100 hits, 10 home runs and 30 steals. He is one of six minor leaguers to amass those totals this season. The Saints are one of three IL teams since 2021 to have multiple players record 100-10-30 seasons, as Andrew Stevenson (132-16-44) did so last year. The Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre RailRidders (Estevan Florial and Oswald Peraza, 2022) and the Omaha Storm Chasers (Brewer Hicklen and Dairon Blanco, 2022) are the others.

S Keirsey Jr. is fifth on the single-season hit totals at 108, trailing Jermaine Palacios (111, 2022), Jose Miranda (117, 2021), Tomás Telís (125, 2021) and the franchise record set by Andrew Stevenson at 132 hits last season.
