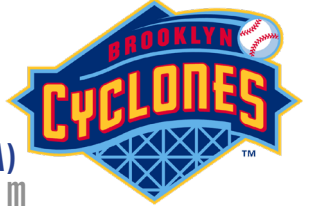

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn swept Saturday's doubleheader against Asheville... The Cyclones captured the opener, 6-2, and won the finale, 3-1...LF **Stanley Consuegra** reached base three times in Game 1, adding a three-run home run in the first...C **José Hernández** collected two hits and drove in two on a single in the third...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** tossed 4.1 innings of three-hit shutout ball in a no-decision...C **Drake Osborn** provided all the offense for the Cyclones in Game 2 with a three-run blast in the fourth...CF **Jackson Loftin's** solo shot in the seventh was Asheville's only run in the nightcap...RHP **Jordan Geber** tied a career-high with seven strikeouts in 4.0 spotless frames, taking a no-decision for Brooklyn.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: The Cyclones swept Saturday's doubleheader from Asheville, winning Game 1, 6-2, and taking Game 2, 3-1...The twinbill sweep marked the first for Brooklyn since June 18, 2022 at Wilmington...The Cyclones won the opener that day in eight innings, 1-0, and then, playing as the home team, won the finale, 4-1...The sweep was the first at home for Brooklyn since May 22, 2022...The Cyclones beat Hudson Valley, 5-4, in Game 1 and, 3-1, in Game 2...Brooklyn was 0-4-2 in doubleheaders last season, including a 2-10 overall record.

ROSTER MOVES: Brooklyn made a series of roster moves prior to Sunday's series finale...INF **Wilfredo Lara** was reinstated from the Cyclones' 7-day injured list (hamate) and RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** was added on a Major League rehab assignment...In a corresponding move, RHP **Alan Perdomo** was transferred to Single-A St. Lucie...Lara is New York's No. 23 prospect per MLB Pipeline and ranked fourth in the Florida State League in slugging percentage (.452) and fifth in home runs (14) in 2023...Reid-Foley joins after being placed on the Mets' 15-day IL on March 28 with right shoulder impingement...The 28-year-old struck out 16 hitters in 7.2 Major League innings in 2023...He also made three minor league rehab appearances for Brooklyn last season, allowing one run in 2.2 innings...Perdomo earned the win in Game 2 on Saturday after tossing 1.2 frames of shutout relief.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** has tossed 8.1 shutout innings to start the 2024 season for the Cyclones...The 8.1 frames are the most by a New York Mets farmhand this year without allowing a run...The 22-year-old has permitted just four hits and two walks, while striking out six...Since making his South Atlantic League debut last August, De La Cruz is 2-1 with a 1.78 ERA (5 ER in 25.1 IP) with seven walks and 23 punch outs...Since his Brooklyn debut, the southpaw leads in the circuit in WHIP (0.87) and is second in ERA (1.78), batting average against (.170), and innings pitched (25.1).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** stole two more bases in Saturday's nightcap and is 7-for-7 to start the season...The seven swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for third among non-Triple-A players...Entering Sunday, De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (44)...He is four steals shy of matching UTL **Jaylen Palmer's** (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for seventh across the Minors for swipes (114)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

ZEIG ZAG: After being limited to just 1.0 inning of work in 2023 due to injuries, RHP **Calvin Ziegler** flourished in his High-A and Cyclones' debut...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with nine strikeouts and punched out eight straight hitters from one out in the 1st until the last batter of the 3rd...Ziegler became just the fifth Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 9 or more hitters in 4.0 or fewer innings since 2005...RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat last June 11 vs. Greenville, whiffing 10 in 4.0 frames...LHP **Andrew Edwards** (8/30/19), LHP **Martin Anderson** (7/7/17), and RHP **Dawrin Frías** (7/31/13) are the others.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 93 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Álvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HOME OPENER: The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule on Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years...The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs.

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn opens the 2024 home schedule against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The series marks the Tourists first ever visit to Coney Island and Maimonides Park...Asheville possess six of Houston's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Luis Báez** (2), SS **Brice Matthews** (4), RHP **Jake Bloss** (11), RHP **Andrew Taylor** (17), LHP **Trey Dombroski** (22), OF **Cam Fisher** (24)...In 16 all-time meetings, 11 of which have been played at McCormick Field, the Cyclones lead the series, 9-7...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 last August in Asheville.

Aberdeen...RHP **John Gant** (5.0 IP), RHP **Tim Peterson** (2.2), and LHP **John Mincone** (1.1) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Cornielli** combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in Sunday's loss...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching marked the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (1) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

2023 IN REVIEW: Brooklyn claimed a share of the North Division Second Half crown in the South Atlantic League, but ceded the final playoff spot to the Jersey Shore BlueClaws on a head-to-head tiebreaker...Needing a win on the final day of the regular season to clinch a playoff spot, the 'Clones dropped a 6-2 contest to Wilmington...Jersey Shore would outlast the Hudson Valley Renegades, 10-9, in 11 innings to secure the seat...After a 28-37 first-half record, the Cyclones composed a 38-28 mark in the second half to finish the season over .500 at 66-65.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gómez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

FAMILIAR FACES: Out of the 30 players on the Cyclones' preliminary roster, 16 of them have previous experience playing on Coney Island...**Jeffrey Colón**, **Joshua Cornielli**, **Felipe De La Cruz**, **Jordan Geber**, **Josh Hejka**, **Joey Lancellotti**, and **Jordany Ventura** return to the bump, while **Drake Osborn** and **Christian Prgent** are holdovers behind the dish...**Ryan Clifford**, **Mateo Gil**, **William Lugo**, **D'Andre Smith**, and **Junior Tilién** are back in the infield, as **Stanley Consuegra** and **Omar De Los Santos** are set to roam the outfield.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Seven members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class will open the 2024 season with the Cyclones...Prgent returns to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, will also start the season in Brooklyn.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision his Cyclones debut last Sunday at Wilmington...Tossed 4.0 perfect innings, striking out a career-high-tying nine...Struck out eight-consecutive hitters from one out in the first until the end of the third inning...Relieved by RHP **Josh Hejka** to start the bottom of the fifth with the game still scoreless...Contest remained without a run until extra innings...Blue Rocks earned their second-straight walk-off win, 1-0, on a LF **Jared McKenzie** sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 10th.

PROSPECT RADAR: Ziegler enters the 2024 season ranked as the New York Mets' No. 29 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...The 21-year-old ranked as high as the Mets' 10th-best farmhand by BA entering 2022 and 2023.

ZIEG ZAG: Ziegler became just the fifth Brooklyn pitcher to strike out nine or more hitters in 4.0 or fewer innings since 2005...RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat last June 11 vs. Greenville, whiffing 10 in 4.0 frames...LHP **Andrew Edwards** (8/30/19), LHP **Martin Anderson** (7/7/17), and RHP **Dawrin Frías** (7/31/13) are the others.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Heidelberg, Ont. native was selected to participate in the inaugural Spring Breakout on March 15...In the seven-inning game against the Washington Nationals prospects, Ziegler entered in the seventh and retired the side in order to earn the save...He struck out a pair in an 18-pitch frame.

ON THE MEND: Ziegler was limited to only one regular-season inning in 2023 due to injury...After his range of motion was limited in spring training, the 21-year-old underwent surgery to remove bone spurs in his elbow...While rehabbing from elbow surgery, Ziegler tore his right quad...The right-hander was placed on the 60-day injured list on April 6 and reinstated on September 8...During the 2022 campaign, he also dealt with biceps tendinitis that limited him to 46.1 innings of work.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Canadian-born righty's path to the 2021 MLB Draft was an arduous one...Due to strict COVID-19 travel protocols in his province, Ziegler enrolled at TNXL Academy in Ocoee, Fla in order to be seen by professional scouts...Additionally, the fourth-year pro played for the Ohio Warhawks travel baseball team based out of Dayton, Ohio...He was ultimately the 46th overall selection by New York in 2021 and signed for \$910,000 to relinquish his commitment to Auburn University.
