TEERING OFF

- **LET'S GET IT STARTED:** The Jackets went hitless after the 2nd inning last night, and hope the offense has a strong showing in store this evening in the year's penultimate game.
- **I FALL APART:** The Jackets have lost 12 of their last 17 games, despite having a lead in 8 of 12 losses. Holding an advantage late has been an uphill battle for this remodeled bullpen late in the year.
- **RANK 'EM:** Seven players from MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Braves Prospects are currently on Augusta's roster, as of the midseason update. The highest regarded is #1 prospect LHP Cam Caminiti, along with INF Tate Southisene (#3), INF John Gil (#14), OF Luis Guanipa (#21), LHP Landon Beidelschies (#23), RHP Ethan Bagwell (#28), and RHP Rayven Antonio (#29).
- **GO JOHNNY GO:** Infielder John Gil lit up the box score in August, hitting .344 with a 1.016 OPS, including four home runs over 22 games. Gil was named Carolina Lg Player of the Month for his efforts, the first Jacket to win the award in over 5 years.
- **G.I. JOE:** Joe Olsavsky was 23-62 (.371) last month, and is currently riding a career-high 17-game on-base streak. Olsavsky's on-base percentage is up to .486 since August 1, and he hit his first home run of the year in last Friday's win.
- **ALL NATURAL GAINS, BOYS:** After a league-worst 49-80 record last year where Augusta set organizational lows in a number of offensive categories, Wynston Sawyer's squad has improved dramatically this year. The Jackets eclipsed last year's win total on July 31st, and numbers are up across the board.
- **BRING EM HOME:** Augusta has seen its team average with runners in scoring position rise over the last few weeks, up to .243 after falling below .225 at the middle of July. The Jackets were slow in those spots early last week, and are 8-40 this series.
- **STRONG START:** The Jackets' starting pitchers have been rock solid as of late, especially at home. Augusta's starters have allowed more than two earned runs just four times in the last 26 home games, continuously keeping the team in the game early.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** The season wraps up with one last matinee as Fabian Ysalla makes his first Single-A start, serving as an opener for the Ballers opposite Jacob Shafer.
