

#### **FORTUGAS SPOTLIGHT: ANDREW**

Few college baseball programs have had more success than the University of Virginia over the last few decades.

Since **Brian O'Connor** took over as the Hoos head coach, the program has reached the College World Series five times since he took over in 2004. The Cavaliers reached the CWS Finals for the first time in program history in 2014 and won their first national championship in 2015.

Outside of wins, another thing Virginia baseball has churned out over the last several years is outstanding left-handed pitchers.

From former Cincinnati Red Sean Doolittle to former No. 2 overall pick Danny Hultzen to Royals gifted rookie **Daniel Lynch**, few have had more success in the orange and navy than new Tortugas southpaw Andrew Abbott.

The Reds' second-round selection this past July graduated as just the second pitcher in program history to reach 300 career strikeouts.

His senior campaign was one for the record books as well. Abbott collected 162 strikeouts, the second-most in a single-season in program history and the third-most in the NCAA in 2021.

With Abbott's superb pitching leading the way, the Cavaliers reached the College World Series for the first time since they won it all six years prior.

It wasn't always easy for the Nathalie, Va. native, though. Spring of 2021 was Abbott's first in Virginia's starting rotation after serving as a vital part of the bullpen. This coming after he was not selected in the five-round pandemic-shortened MLB Draft in 2020.

"It was unfortunate for me and disappointing for me to not get drafted, but I took it like a chip on my shoulder," said Abbott last week in Port St. Lucie. "I just said 'Well, now you're going to regret not drafting me'".


Abbott is grateful for the belief his coaching staff at Virginia not only for what he could do on the diamond, but who he was away from the field, too.

"The coaching staff, coach Brian O'Connor, coach Drew Dickinson, our associate head coach and hitting coach Kevin McMullen, and coach Kirby, those guys were all behind us 100 percent," said the 53rd-overall pick. "They want us to be the best version of ourselves not only as a ballplayer, but as a person.

The highly-respected tutelage for Abbott didn't just start during his college career. He had one of the best left-handed pitchers of his generation - seven-time All-Star Billy Wagner teaching him in his high school days.

"I was like 15 or 16 when he was my coach," said Abbott. "He helped me start to develop that warrior, bulldog mentality...I still use his advice, he even texted me saying good luck when I shipped out to Arizona."


