LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones set a season-high with six doubles and seven extra-base hits in an 8-5 win at Wilmington on Thursday...Brooklyn erased 1-0 and 2-1 deficits before breaking a two-all tie with a six-run top of the sixth...CF **Omar De Los Santos** provided the game-tying single in the fourth and the go-ahead three-run home run in the sixth, as part of a four RBI night...3B **William Lugo**, 1B **Chris Suero**, and DH **Jacob Reimer** all tallied multi-hit games...RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** collected a pair of runs batted in with a double in the sixth...RHP **Luis G. Moreno** tossed a season-high 4.0 innings, earning his third win in relief...DH **T.J. White** provided Wilmington's first two runs, including a solo home run in the third.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 16, 2005, 3B **Matthew Anderson** delivered a game-tying solo home run with one out in the ninth before RF **Jesús Gamero** provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in a 3-2 win vs. New Jersey...In 2007, 1B **Lucas Duda** started his franchise-record 17-game hit streak with a 1-for-4 performance, adding two runs scored and a RBI in a 7-1 win vs. Hudson Valley...In 2018, the Cyclones and Vermont Lake Monsters played a scoreless game into extra innings...Down a run entering the bottom of the 10th, Brooklyn walked off with a 2-1 win thanks to a bunt single and throwing error off the bat of 3B **Chandler Avant**.

EXTRA! EXTRA! The Cyclones' offense picked up 7 extra-base hits in Thursday's 8-5 win at Wilmington...The 7 extra-base knocks (6 doubles and a home run) were the most for Brooklyn in a single game since tallying 8 (6 doubles and 2 home runs) in an 8-5 win at Jersey Shore on August 25, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' record for extra-base hits in a game is 10, accomplished on June 24 and July 10, 2010 vs. Hudson Valley and State College, respectively...The 6 doubles in Thursday's game were a season-high for the club and the most since that 6-double performance on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The franchise mark since 2005 is 7, accomplished three times, most recently on August 3, 2016, at Lowell.

NO TROESS-PASSING: RHP **Austin Troesser** was added to the Cyclones' roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Thursday...In 12 appearances (6 starts) with the Mets, the 22-year-old posted a 1-4 record with a 4.25 ERA (17 ER in 36.0 IP), 16 walks, and 52 strikeouts...Troesser spent over a month on the injured list from May 26 until July 19...In 3 appearances (1 start) since returning, the University of Missouri alum has not allowed a run on two hits in 5.0 innings, walking one and striking out seven...Among Florida State League pitchers (min. 30.0 IP), Troesser was tied for seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (23.8%) and eighth in strikeout rate (34.4%).

NONE SHALL PASS: The Cyclones' bullpen had a 17.2-inning streak without allowing an earned run snapped with DH **T.J. White**'s solo home run in the third inning on Thursday...The stretch began in the fourth inning on Saturday vs. Hudson Valley...The 'Clones bullpen did not allow a hit in 11.0 consecutive innings with 19 strikeouts from SS **George Lombard Jr.**'s two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night until 1B **Roismar Quintana**'s single in the sixth inning on Wednesday...RHP **Eduardo Herrera**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** also combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the ninth inning on Saturday until one out in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of August 4's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson did not allow an earned run over 13.1 innings from July 21 vs. Jersey Shore until Thursday night in Wilmington...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.98 ERA (3 ER in 27.2 IP), earning two saves in 13 outings (1 start)...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 25.0 frames on the bump, the right-hander is fourth in the league in ERA (0.98) in that time.

TO SMITH-EREENS: UT **D'Andre Smith** has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old picked up his third multi-hit game during a six-contest hitting streak dating back to the opening game of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...In that span, Smith is 9-for-22 at the plate (.409) with two doubles, two runs batted in, and two stolen bases...The 23-year-old is hitting .278/.291/.370 in 15 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In 9 games this month, Smith is batting .387/.406/.548 with a .954 OPS, two runs scored, two doubles, a home run, four runs batted in, and two steals...The former fifth-round pick is third in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.387) during August (min. 30 PA).

A DOZEN DONUTS: Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington on Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones had blanked Wilmington in consecutive matchups and had thrown 21.1 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back from the fifth inning on July 13 until the first inning on Wednesday...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome and Hudson Valley (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

vs. WILMINGTON: The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have two of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (4) and OF **Robert Hassell III** (13)...Hassell is with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 7-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 3-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 50-48 all-time against Wilmington (.510).

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win on Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and one hold in his last 5 appearances (4 starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and 9 walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is fourth in the South Atlantic League (min. 30.0 IP) in ERA (1.31), eighth in batting average against (.192), and tied for eighth in strikeouts (27) in that time.

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (87), is second in stolen bases (38), tied for third in games played (76), and sixth in runs scored (50) and batting average (.285)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38) and seventh in batting average (.285) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.308), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.399), and hits (118)...He is also tied for second in runs scored (64), third in total bases (148), tied for third in triples (4), and fourth in OPS (.785).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also tied for 10th in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.12), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), and 10th in strikeouts (129) and strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 25-year-old clubbed a go-ahead three-run home run in the sixth inning on Thursday in Wilmington and powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28...6 of his 7 home runs since returning from Double-A Binghamton tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for second in the league in triples (2) and home runs (6), third in slugging (.542), tied for fourth in RBI (16), tied for sixth in total bases (39) and extra-base hits (9), and tied for eighth in runs scored (14)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 35 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (72) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is second in the South Atlantic League (72) and is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (144).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and OF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero**'s game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.63% of all defeats, including 26.09% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 242 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.40%)...The Cyclones have also earned 24 wins in their last at-bat.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF **Nick Morabito** (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss at the High-A level last Saturday night vs. Hudson Valley...Permitted only one run on two hits over 3.1 innings...Walked one and struck out two...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 50 pitches and 31 strikes (62.00%)...Relieved by RHP **Henry Henry** with a runner at second and one out in the top of the fourth and the game scoreless...Bequeathed runner scored...Longest outing by innings and pitches since being reinstated from the injured list...The Cyclones were ultimately shut out by the Renegades on Seinfeld Night, 3-0.

THE COMEBACK REPORT: Thornton spent a little over a month on Single-A St. Lucie's 7-day injured list...The 22-year-old was placed on the IL on June 4 and was reinstated on July 14...In 5 appearances (2 starts) since returning between the two A-ball levels, Thornton is 1-1 with an 5.91 ERA (7 ER in 10.2 IP), 2 walks, and 12 strikeouts.

WHAT'S IN A ROLE: The Lawrence, Kan. native has seen varied results between his appearances as a starter and a reliever in 2024...In 7 starts between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn, Thornton holds a 2-1 record with a 3.33 ERA (10 ER in 27.0 IP), 8 walks, and 22 strikeouts...Over 8 outings in relief between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 5.75 ERA (13 ER in 20.1 IP), one save, nine walks, and 16 strikeouts.

DOMINANT IN THE DESERT: Thornton enjoyed plenty of success during his lone season in the desert at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Ariz...The fifth-round selection earned All-WAC Second Team honors in 2023 after accumulating a 9-2 record with a 3.87 ERA (38 ER in 88.1 IP), 18 walks, and 91 strikeouts in 15 starts for the Antelopes...Thornton finished the 2023 season at GCU as the team's leader in ERA (3.87), wins (9), innings pitched (88.1), and strikeouts (91)...The left-hander started his collegiate career with two years (2021-22) at Barton Community College (Great Bend, Kan.).

FAMILY BUSINESS: Zach is far from the only athlete in the Thornton family...His father, **Paul**, ran track at St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.) from 1989-93 and was a conference champion in the 1000m in 1993 and is currently an assistant Track and Field coach at the Kansas University...However, the best athlete in the family may be his mother, **Dr. Julie**...From 1988-92, she participated in track and field, cross country, and soccer at Lewis & Clark College (Portland, Ore.) and St. Olaf College...Julie was a two-time All-American in the heptathlon (1991-92) and was later inducted into the St. Olaf College athletics Hall of Fame.
