FROM THE CROWS NEST

TWIN-BILL SPLIT: The Bradenton Marauders split their doubleheader with the Dunedin Blue Jays, losing 3-2 in game one and winning 5-0 in game two Friday night at TD Ballpark. After game two of yesterday's twin bill was suspended in the first inning, the two returned to Dunedin today to play 14 innings. In their game two win, **Yordany De Los Santos** opened scoring with a first-inning solo shot. Starter **Victor Cabreja** was dominant for Bradenton, tossing five shutout frames while limiting the Blue Jays to four hits. In the process, he earned his team-leading sixth save of the season. The left hander has now completed five innings in five of his last six outings. He has also limited opponents to just two runs over 15 frames in the month of June. The victory earned the Marauders their third shutout win of the year. They've now taken six of their last eight contests.

AGER DAY: Right hander **Matt Ager** gets the ball for the fifth game of the series. Over 12 starts, the southpaw has posted a 5.30 ERA. After a difficult May where he allowed 14 runs over 12.1 innings, Ager has bounced back in june, posting a 3.77 ERA over four starts. Last Sunday versus Tampa, he tossed three hitless innings while allowing one unearned run. In his previous two outings, he matched a career high with four innings of work. The right hander has cut down on his walks after averaging a free pass an inning in May. He mixes in a four seamer (90 mph), slider (82.4 mph, 37.3% Whiff), changeup (83.9 mph) and curveball (74 mph).

CASTILLO'S CAREER DAY: Yesterday, Carlos Castillo resumed Wednesday's game after its suspension and provided his best outing of the season. The right hander tossed a career-high six innings while only allowing one run en route to his first win of the season. The performance also marked the most innings of any Maruaders hurler in a single game this season. Adolfo Oviedo recorded the final three outs to earn his professional save as well.

WORM BURNERS: The Marauders have been one of the best team's in all of affiliated baseball in turning double plays this season. Entering Friday, they lead the entire Single-A level with 74 twin killers - averaging roughly one per game. Only four teams in all of MiLB have turned more. Moreover, entering Thuesday, Bradenton has induced the third-most grounders in the FSL (741) behind just Lakeland and Clearwater, and have limited opponents to a .222 average on those batted balls - the second lowest in the league.

SETTING THE TONE: Tuesday night, the Marauders earned a tight 3-2 win in their series opener with the Dunedin Blue Jays. Bradenton scored all three of its runs in the first inning on an **Edward Florentino** sacrifice fly and **Jhonny Severino** two-run single. Marauders pitching held the lead for the remainder of the game as starter **Greiber Mendez** tossed three innings of one-run ball on short notice, and **Dariel Francia** provided three shutout frames to earn his first Single-A win in his Marauders debut. **Noah Takacs** recorded the final four outs en route to his team-leading sixth save. Bradenton has now won four of its last five, and three of four to begin the second half. They've had a knack for close games as each of their last 6 victories have been decided by two runs or less, incuding four via one run. They're 8-8 this year in one-run contests.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Pirates No. 23 prospect **Edward Florentino** notched his first Single-A knock yesterday with a fourth-inning single. He was promoted to Bradenton on Saturday and made his full-season affiliate debut that night. The 18-year-old outfielder put up explosive numbers at the FCL level. In 29 games, he slashed .347/.442/.642 with six home runs and 23 RBI. Before his promotion, he ranked first in the FCL (qualified players) in slugging and OPS (1.084), as well as second in homers and average. Florentino was signed by Pittsburgh as an International MiLB Free Agent in January of 2024 and has been highly touted for his power from the left side. He is one of nine Marauders on the Pirates Top 30 Prospect List (MLB Pipeline).
