Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp continue their series with game five tonight. Nashville took the lead in the sixth inning, and the bullpen did not allow a run in a 4-3 victory. The Sounds have clinched a series win and look to grow their already longest winning streak of the season to five games. Left-hander Aaron Ashby will get the ball for the Sounds tonight. He'll go up against MLB veteran Yonny Chirinos.

Aaron Ashby: The 25-year-old makes his eighth appearance and seventh start of the season with Nashville. He's 0-2 with an 8.23 ERA (27.1 IP/25 ER). It looked like Ashby was going to walk away with a win after following opener Taylor Clarke last Sunday at Durham. The southpaw worked 5.1 innings and gave up three runs (all earned) on seven hits with a season-high nine strikeouts. However, Durham rallied in the eighth to take the win and give Ashby another no decision. Ashby had his lowest walks per innings pitched on May 12 at Durham - he's walked 28 over 27.1 innings with Nashville. Ashby made one start with Milwaukee back on April 8 at Cincinnati (3.2 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 2 K). He is 5-7 with a 5.95 ERA across 30 outings and 20 starts with Nashville in his career. Ashby was taken in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder Junior College in Missouri.

Yonny Chirinos: The 30-year-old makes his ninth start of the season for Jacksonville tonight. The former Tampa Bay and Atlanta hurler is 3-4 with a 3.07 ERA (44.0 IP/15 ER). Chirinos has taken the loss in both of his last two starts for the Jumbo Shrimp. He had a quality start on May 11 at Gwinnett, scattering five hits with six strikeouts. However, he did not get any run support in the 1-0 defeat. Chirinos enters the day ranked among International League leaders in ERA (5th), innings (8th) and WHIP (T-9th, 1.25). Chirinos faced Nashville once, on August 25, 2022 while with Durham. He allowed two runs over 3.0 innings. The Marlins signed the Venezuelan to a minor league contract on February 12, 2024. Prior to that, he spent almost all of his professional career with Tampa Bay - he was claimed off waivers by Atlanta on July 23, 2023 and elected free agency after the season. Chirinos was signed by the Rays as a free agent on June 29, 2012.

Four's A Streak: With the victory last night, the Sounds have their longest winning streak of the season - the longest since taking six in-a-row from September 9-15 last year. Nashville is also above .500 for the first time since being 11-10 after a win vs. Omaha on April 21 (it's just the third time the Sounds are over .500 this season). The Sounds are one of seven teams with a winning record on the road in the league. They are tied for the third most road wins in the IL - only Scranton/WB (19-6) and Norfolk (15-9) have more. Nashville has clinched a winning road trip going into the final two games of the 12-games away from First Horizon Park. It's the longest road trip of the season.

C-Rod Cruising: Last night's starter and Brewers No. 6 prospect Carlos Rodriguez picked up his fourth-straight win and third-straight quality start. After starting the season 0-4 with an 8.34 ERA (22.2 IP/21 ER), The Miami resident has turned his season around, going 4-0 with a 3.68 ERA (22.0 IP/9 ER) and 22 strikeouts. Rodriguez ranks among league leaders this month in wins (T-1st, 3), WHIP (3rd, 0.94), opponent batting average (4th, .190) strikeouts (T-4th, 21) and ERA (9th, 2.65).

Pitcher Perfect: Through the first four games this week, Sounds pitchers are 4-0 with a 2.19 ERA (37.0 IP/9 ER), 1.27 WHIP and .231 opponent batting average. The ERA and WHIP marks are the lowest among IL pitching staffs this week...only Omaha has a lower opponent batting average at .226. Sounds relievers still boast the best ERA (3.36) and WHIP (1.29) in the International League this season.

He Dunn Did It: Leadoff hitter Oliver Dunn put the Sounds ahead after early after the left handed hitter sent the very first pitch from Max Meyer over the wall. It's the second leadoff home run hit by the Sounds on the season and first since Tyler Black's on April 28 at Louisville. Dunn is 2-for-8 with two runs and a stolen base since being optioned from Milwaukee on May 15.

Rehab Update: Joey Wiemer went 0-for-3 with a walk and run scored as the designated hitter last night. He was placed on Milwaukee's 10-day injured list with left knee discomfort on May 4 and was sent on rehab assignment on May 16. Including when he was on Nashville's roster to begin the season, Wiemer is batting .214 (12-for-56) with six RBI and nine runs scored in Triple-A.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 705-604 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,297-2,124 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Ashby pitched at Durham on May 12. Following a rehab appearance from Taylor Clarke, Ashby worked 5.1 innings in relief allowing seven hits, three earned runs and had nine strikeouts. He was in line for the win until a late bullpen collapse.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's fifth career appearance against Jacksonville. He had two rehab starts in 2023. He went a combined 1.2 innings, allowing five earned runs. In 2021, Ashby had two outings (one start) with 5.2 combined innings and one earned run allowed. In his start on July 25, 2021 he struck out nine batters in 3.2 innings of work.
