On The Road Again

The Reading Fightin Phils hit the road to play the Harrisburg Senators (Nationals, Double-A) for a six-game set after a three-game series at home against the Altoona Curve. Reading took two of three games from the Curve, marking their third series win over four tries in the second half. The Fightins have series wins over Altoona (4-2, 2-1) and Somerset (4-2), while they have a series split against New Hampshire (3-3). Ever since Al Pedrique's group started the second half off at 0-2, they've won 14 of their last 23 games.

Harrisburg Shuts Out Reading 3-0

The Reading Fightin Phils (14-11, 44-50) fell to the Harrisburg Senators by a score of 3-0 last night. Left-handed starting pitcher Adam Seminaris took the loss, but he fired a quality start in the process. The former Los Angeles Angels farmhand dealt six innings of two-run ball, striking out seven hitters. Seminaris threw 100 pitches, a season-high and one pitch short of a career-high. The Fightins logged just one hit on the evening while drawing five walks and going 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

Wood You Look At This Guy?

Right-handed pitcher Gage Wood will toe the rubber for this Saturday showdown with the Senators. Wood tossed a career-best nine strikeouts over four innings of two-run ball against the Altoona Curve last week. In the post-draft shuffle, MLB Pipeline promoted Wood to the no. 1 spot in its Phillies' top prospects list, as the Arkansas alum leap-frogged Aidan Miller in the process. Wood has a 70-grade fastball that lives in the mid-90s. He notably represented the National League in the 2026 Futures Game, as he was tabbed the starter at Citizens Bank Park. Wood has 93 career strikeouts in just 61 innings pitched so far. He skipped from Low-A Clearwater to Double-A Reading earlier this season.

Heredia Keeps Hitting

Raylin Heredia added two more hits on Saturday night and became the first Fightin Phil to eclipse the 100-hit mark in 2026. He joins Hartford Andy Perez as the only two Eastern League hitters to have over 100 hits so far this season. Heredia is currently on pace for 153 hits this season, which would surpass Reading's team leader in 2025 of Felix Reyes, who had 123. If he reached 150 hits, Heredia would be the first R-Phil to surpass that mark since Darin Ruf had 155 base knocks during his historic 2012 season.

Hettiger Is Heating Up

Kehden Hettiger is getting into a groove in the month of July, as the Phillies' up-and-coming backstop is slashing .262/.385/.405 in the month of July. The Los Angeles, California native has a pair of multi-hit performances this month as well. On July 10th, the Fightins backstop logged a 3-for-4 performance with a double, notching four total bases in one of his better games this season. Hettiger has worked plenty of counts this season, drawing 36 walks in just north of 200 plate appearances.

Leon Has Liftoff

Pedro Leon, who typically follows Bryan Rincon in the Fightin Phils starting lineup, just saw his 18-game hit streak and 24-game on-base streak end on July 24. He went 1-for-4 on Thursday. Over the hit streak, which dated back to June 28, Leon is slashing .315/.386/.603 (.989 OPS), along with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and is five-for-seven in stolen bases. Leon's hit streak is currently the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League this season, trailing Erie's Justice Bigbie, who is at 22.

Hammering Homers

The Fightin Phils have hit 120 home runs this season, which is two clear of their total for all of 2025 (118). Reading is third in the Eastern League in home runs, trailing only Somerset (134) and Portland (121). The Fightin Phils are currently on pace for 176 home runs this season, which would be their most since slugging 185 in 2016. Alex Binelas leads Reading with 20 home runs, and Raylin Heredia is shortly behind him with 17. Four different Fightins hitters have slugged at least 10 homers, with Bryson Ware (13) and Bryan Rincon (13) being the other two. Before Binelas, the last time a Fightin Phils slugged 20 home runs in a season was Carlos De La Cruz (24) and Oliver Dunn (21) in 2023.

McFarlane Heads To The Bank!

Alex McFarlane, who ranks as the Phillies No. 17 prospect and is on their 40-man roster, got the call on Monday and made his debut at Citizens Bank Park on Wednesday. The former Fightin Phils reliever worked a scoreless ninth inning, retiring Shohei Ohtani for his first big league out.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 25, 2024: At New Hampshire, two runs in the bottom of the second snaps Reading's scoreless-inning streak at 23. It was their longest streak of such since 22-straight scoreless in 2022 and their second longest scoreless-inning streak dating back to the 2005 season.

Introducing The Senators

Harrisburg enters play today with a 48-44 overall record, living above .500 with a 14-9 record in the second half. The Senators just took two games out of three from New Hampshire, holding the Fisher Cats to just nine runs all weekend including a game where they shut out the Blue Jays' Double-A affiliate 2-0. Harrisburg has the following top 30 Nationals prospects on the roster: Devin Fitz-Gerald (5), Alex Clemmey (12), Ethan Petry (13), Sam Petersen (23) and Caleb Lomavita (27).

The Sens' Starter

Righty Josh Randall will get the ball for the Senators in this Saturday square-off. Randall holds a 3-3 record with a 4.41 earned run average and 49 strikeouts. The 2024 third round pick (by the Detroit Tigers) has a 6.60 earned run average in July, but he cleaned up his act in his last outing against New Hampshire. The 23-year-old fired four scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and striking out six in a no-decision on July 19.
