Today is the opener of a six-game series at historic Modern Woodmen Park and the first of 12 meetings this year between the Lugnuts and River Bandits, who split a six-game season series last year in Davenport. The Nuts won five of their first seven games, but have lost the last seven.

Last Game, Sunday: Whitecaps 12, Lugnuts 4. Cristian Santana slugged a second-inning grand slam, Andrew Sojka smacked a three-run homer in the fifth, and the Whitecaps completed a six-game sweep with a Kids Day rout in front of 1,578 fans at Jackson Field.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits play a morning game tomorrow, and then wrap up the series with four in a row through Sunday. On April 27, the Lugnuts welcome the Dayton Dragons back to Jackson Field for a second time already, including a morning doubleheader on Wednesday, April 28 – the Nuts' second doubleheader of the young season.

LUG-NOTES

Top the League: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in batting average (.268) and base hits (128); committing the fewest errors in the league (5 in 501 total chances, .990 pct.) while turning the most double plays (18); and posting the lowest road ERA in the league (2.05).

Individual Excellence: Davis Diaz tops the MWL in doubles (7) and is 2nd in batting average (.385), 3rd in OBP (.510), 5th in OPS (1.074) and tied for 5th in runs (12). Bobby Boser is tied for 3rd in runs (13) and tied for 2nd in base hits (17). Casey Yamauchi is tied for 4th in RBIs (12).

Who's Hot: Outfielder Devin Taylor is slashing .433/.500/.733 in his last eight games (13-for-30, 3 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBIs, five walks, one stolen base), raising his batting average from .130 to .302 and his OPS from .450 to .891.

All Aboard: Shortstop Bobby Boser has reached base in 13 straight games. Boser has reached base 29 times (17 hits, nine walks and three HBPs) already this year. Catcher/third baseman Davis Diaz has also been impressive: 25 times on base in 11 games (15 hits, nine walks, one HBP).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster now has No. 8 (Devin Taylor), No. 15 (Gavin Turley) No. 16 (Steven Echavarria), No. 19 (Zane Taylor), No. 26 (Nate Nankil) and No. 30 (Bobby Boser) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

Milestone Watch: Lansing is 12 wins away from the 2,000th win in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán was in the very first Lugnuts starting lineup on April 5, 1996. Over the course of his ensuing 20-year career, he was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series. This summer, on July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, becoming the first Lugnut to be enshrined.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller, not to be confused with Quad Cities southpaw Mason Miller. In 11 appearances / 11 1/3 scoreless innings this season, batters are 2-for-36 with two singles, two walk and 27 strikeouts. Miller has tossed 33 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings, bringing him within one inning of matching San Diego's franchise record.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher Daniel Susac, has opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles and a triple through 11 games with the Giants. Debuting on April 1, Susac hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

Player of the Week, April 7-12: The first Midwest League Player of the Week was 23-year-old Lansing C/3B Davis Diaz, who batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne last week. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing. He is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (11, with teammate Bobby Boser), tied for 1st in doubles (5), 2nd in batting average (.480), 2nd in OBP (.606), 3rd in OPS (1.286), and tied for 3rd in base hits (12).

APRIL 21ST IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2003: Justin Jones, Westin O'Brien and Mark Carter combine to throw the Lugnugs' first no-hitter, blanking Dayton 15-0, and Donny Hood hits for the cycle in the same game, the first time in pro baseball history that a cycle and no-hitter were achieved in the same game.

2024: Danny Bautista, Jr. went 5-for-5 and Will Simpson swatted a two-run homer, helping the Lugnugs break a 4-4 tie with six unanswered runs for a 10-4 rout at Lake County, giving the Nuts the series victory over the eventual league champions.
