LUG-NOTES

There's No Place Like Home: The Lugnuts were 1-7 in home games on April 27. Since then, the Nuts are a sizzling 16-6 in Michigan's state capital: winning four of seven against Dayton, five of six vs. Quad Cities, four of six vs. West Michigan, and prevailing in the first three games of this series.

Tough Sledding for Kernels Pitching: The Nuts have scored 14 runs (13 earned) in 11 1/3 innings against Cedar Rapids starters in this series, a 10.32 ERA. (The relievers have allowed seven runs, four earned, in 13 2/3 innings, a 2.63 ERA, but Brian Zeldin blew a two-run lead in the bottom of the 9th and gave up a walk-off RBI single to **C.J. Pittaro** on Wednesday, and Xavier Kohlhossler allowed **Carlos Franco's** go-ahead grand slam in the 8th yesterday.)

It Was Time: Yesterday marked the Lugnuts' third grand slam of the season, with Franco joining **Gunner Gouldsmith** and **Ali Camarillo** as Nuts who went deep with a teammate at every bag. But the Lugs are still batting just .225 with the bases loaded this year, ranking 9th in the 12-team league. (Cedar Rapids is 11th with a .210 avg. Fort Wayne is 12th, batting just .102 with the bases loaded.)

Speaking of Gunner Gouldsmith: The Sacramento State Hornet had zero professional home runs entering this season and only one in 38 games entering Thursday... and then promptly homered in back-to-back games, with a three-run shot on Thursday and a solo HR off top prospect Riley Quick last night.

The Innings Race: Lugnuts starters rank 1-2-3 in the Midwest League in most innings pitched: **Zane Taylor** (57 1/3 innings), **Samuel Dutton** (54 1/3 innings) and **Steven Echavarria** (54 innings). Echavarria ranks 1st in lowest opponent average (.213). Taylor is 3rd in ERA (2.98) and Dutton is 4th (4.14).

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 72 double plays in 60 games, ranking 1st in all of Minor League Baseball.

Big League Nuts: 2024 Lugnut **Kade Morris** made his MLB debut on June 6 vs. Houston, becoming the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**). There are eight current Lugnuts on the Athletics: **Bolte**, **Jump**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Joey Estes**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 18 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 23 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

2011: Jake Marisnick went 4-for-5 with a two-run HR and 4 RBIs, Matt Nuzzo was 3-for-5 w/ 3 R and 3 RBIs, Markus Brisker was 3-for-6 and Balbino Fuenmayor was 3-for-5 in a 20-hit 12-6 victory at Cedar Rapids. The Kernels committed four errors; Lugnuts SS Gustavo Pierre committed three errors himself, giving him 36 errors for the year.

2012: The TinCaps defeated the Lugnuts, 1-0, in one hour and 54 minutes at Parkview Field. It was a heartbreaker for Nuts starter Jesse Hernandez (8 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 8 K), who allowed a run on a sacrifice fly in the first inning but didn't allow his first hit until Travis Whitmore's infield single off Hernandez's glove leading off the bottom of the 8th.

In a Nutshell: Made his Lugnuts debut on July 30, 2025, becoming the 973rd all-time Lansing Lugnuts player... joined the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton, where he ranked 7th in the California League in strikeouts (77)... opened up the 2026 season in the Lugnuts' bullpen before receiving a spot start May 15 when Kyle Robinson was traded to Pittsburgh for Alika Williams.

2026 Dive: Made 10 relief appearances (4.05 ERA, 13 1/3 IP, 6 R, 2 BB, 13 K) before joining rotation for four starts (3.38 ERA, 16 IP, 7 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 18 K)... limiting lefties to .235 avg. and only 2 XBH (both doubles), but righties are hitting .280 with 10 XBH (2 HR)... runners have attempted five steals, nabbed twice... remarkable strike-thrower: 72% of pitches are strikes (289 of 400)... last year, worked at 70% strikes (1048 of 1489)... in comparison: Zane Taylor: 64% strikes; Nathan Dettmer: 63% strikes; Samuel Dutton: 62% strikes; Steven Echavarría: 61% strikes; Tzu-Chen Sha: 64% strikes.

College Days: Two-way standout... played at Cisco College 2020-21, transferred to Cochise College, sat out 2022 and spent 2023 slugging at Division II Florida Southern (CSC Academic All-District), graduating with a degree in accounting... transferred to Mizzou as a grad student and converted to full-time pitching, posting 1-3 record with 4.63 ERA, 14 G, 4 GS, 35 IP, 11 BB, 37 K... notable Missouri Tigers include Max Scherzer, Ian Kinsler, Kameron Misner, and former Lugnut Luke Mann... signed for \$35,000 as the first pick in the 14th round of the 2024 draft.
