TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Las Vegas Aviators (Athletics affiliate) are set for game three of their six-game series on Thursday night at Las Vegas Ballpark. Las night, Las Vegas took an early 2-0 lead in the first after a double by 1B Brett Harris. The Express struck for four runs in the second courtesy of four walks to start the inning by the Aviators. C Cooper Johnson drew the fourth walk to force in a run and an RBI groundout by CF Jarred Kelenic scored a second run before an RBI single from SS Cam Cauley gave Round Rock a 4-2 advantage. Las Vegas answered with two runs in the third on a two-RBI single by DH Joey Meneses, then added two more in the fourth when C Brian Serven belted a two-run homer. A solo blast by Meneses in the fifth extended the lead to 7-4. Round Rock managed just two hits over the final five innings and the 7-4 score stood as the final.

WHERE WE STAND

With the loss, Round Rock ended their 6-game winning streak at Las Vegas Ballpark dating back to the 2024 season...were unable to collect their 1st 3-game win streak since 4/19-23...are 2-4 in their last 6 games and 5-6 in their last 11.

LIGHTS, CAMERON, ACTION!

INF/OF Cam Cauley went 2-for-5 with 2 RBI, SO and 2 SB on Wednesday night...marks his 18th multi-hit game...has a hit in 10 of 11 games this month while slashing .318 (14-44)/.415/.432/.847 with a 2B, 2 3B, 5 RBI, 6 R, 8 BB, 10 SO...has reached base in 18 of his last 19 games...is the 3rd time this year he has stolen 2 or more bases.

FITTING RIGHT IN

OF Jarred Kelenic (1-for-4, 2B, RBI, BB) has now recorded a base hit in all 11 games with a plate appearance with Round Rock...has also tallied an RBI in 9 of those 11...slashing .370 (17-46)/.463/.674/1.137 with 3 2B, 3B, 3 HR, 10 RBI, 12 R, 8 BB and 8 SO since joining the Express on June 2.

UP AND DOWN

After posting season-highs in hits (17), extra-base hits (7) and home runs (4) in the series opener, Round Rock was held to 5 hits and 4 runs without a long ball on Wednesday night...least amount of hits since 5/26 vs SL when they had 3 hits and a run at Dell Diamond...are 0-10 this season with 5 hits or fewer...had recorded at least 7 hits in each of their last 18 games (5/27-6/16), going 10-8 in that span.

CRIM DE LA CRIM

On his 29th birthday, INF Blaine Crim recorded his 89th career double with the E-Train...is now 9 doubles away from tying Express Hall of Famer Brooks Conrad (2005-2007) for 2nd in Round Rock's Triple-A era (2005-current)...is also 1 HR from tying Express Hall of Famer Mark Saccomanno (2007-2009) for third in the club's Triple-A era...with his walk at OKC on 6/5, passed Joey Butler (191) for Round Rock's most walks in the Triple-A era...now sits at 194.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - TUESDAY, JUNE 18, 1974

27-year-old Nolan Ryan shut down the New York Yankees for 6.0 innings as the Angels earned a 3-0 victory at Anaheim Stadium. Coming off Ryan's 13-inning performance with Luis Tiant and the Red Sox, the Angels lifted him early because of a blister. Ryan walked three and struck out seven while allowing only three hits in the victory.

"The blister actually developed in the last game," Ryan said postgame. "It was just a convenient excuse to get me out of there early because I was ahead. (Manager Bobby) Winkles didn't want me to throw a lot of pitches." Angels pitching coach Tom Morgan and general manager Harry Dalton were concerned with Ryan pitching at all in this start after he tossed 233 pitches in his previous outing. He threw only 88 on this night. Skip Lockwood tossed three scoreless frames out of the bullpen for the save.

Yankees starter Dick Tidrow earned the loss despite throwing 8.0 innings and allowing three unearned runs on seven hits, one walk and five strikeouts. All three runs came in the first inning. With two outs, Frank Robinson and Joe Lahoud each drove in a run with a single. Mickey Rivers doubled to cap the scoring for the game. In 1974, Ryan went on to win a career-high 22 games while throwing 332.0 innings. June of 1974 featured a 4-1 record in seven starts for Ryan as he tossed 60.0 innings and posted a 2.25 ERA.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE
The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.
A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI
Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.
His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN
Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.
Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ
Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.
The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON
Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.
He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI
Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.
A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.
