BACK TO BING: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies play their first game in Binghamton since September 2, 2019...a 4-3 win over Hartford. This is the Rumble Ponies 29th season of play. They continue as the New York Mets Double-A Affiliate, a distinction they've held since 1992.

LAST TIME OUT: The Rumble Ponies opened their season in Akron, dropping all five games. Sunday's game was rained out. In their last game Saturday, a 5-1 loss at Canal Park, The Ponies scored first on a Sebastian Elizalde RBI double, but were done in by a 4-run fourth inning by the Rubber Ducks.

VIENTOS GOES DEEP: The Rumble Ponies hit one home run over the 5-game series. It came courtesy of third basemen Mark Vientos Thursday night. The solo home run came in the fourth inning of a 9-2 loss. Vientos is the Mets 8th-ranked prospect on mlb.com

HIGHLY TOUTED GROUP : The Rumble Ponies Opening Day Roster features 4 out of the Mets top 30 prospects. In addition to Vientos, the club features RHP Ryley Gilliam (18), RHP Tylor Megill (23), and RHP Marcell Renteria (25).

SCOUTING THE CURVE: The Curve come in at 2-3, following a 5-game series at home against Bowie. They dropped the first three games, before winning the final two.

MEGILL STARTS THINGS OFF: Tylor Megill has the distinction of being the opening day starter and getting the nod for the home opener. In his first start of the year (5/4), he allowed only 2 hits over 5, striking out 10 in a no-decision against Akron.

FROM RUMBLETOWN TO QUEENS: 2019 Rumble Ponies C/1B Patrick Mazeika had 2 RBI in the Mets sweep over the Diamondbacks at Citi Field this past weekend, including the walk-off fielder's choice in the Mets 5-4 win Friday night. It was only Mazeika's second career plate appearance in the majors! He also drew a bases loaded walk to force home a run in Sunday's 4-2 win.

MORE RUMBLE PONIES ALUMNI: LHP David Peterson, who spent 2019 with Binghamton, is in the Mets starting rotation after making his Major League debut last year. In 2020 he was 6-2 with a 3.44 ERA in 6 games.

PONIES VS. ALTOONA IN 2019: The two teams played 10 times in 2019, five at each ballpark. The Rumble Ponies were 4-6 overall, going 2-3 at both NYSEG Stadium and in Altoona.

COMING UP: All series this year in Minor League Baseball this year are scheduled for six consecutive games. The Ponies opening homestand continues Wednesday night at Rumbletown Stadium, with first pitch at 6:35. You can listen to all games on our website milb.com/Binghamton

LAST START: Megill started the Rumble Ponies season opener Tuesday night matching a career-high with 10 strikeouts over 5, allowing just two runs in the Ponies 5-4 loss to the Rubber Ducks. The only other time Megill had 10 strikeouts was on August 5th with St. Lucie against Fort Myers, in which he also only allowed two hits.
