I THOUGHT WE WERE JUST HERE: After earning the team's first series win since April last week at home against Delmarva, the FredNats hit the road for a season-long 13-game road trip, beginning with six games at SEGRA Stadium against the Houston Astro-affiliated Fayetteville Woodpeckers. These Spring Training facility mates split a six-game series in Fayetteville in mid-April. Yoel Tejeda Jr. gets the opening start for Fredericksburg opposite Woodpecker righty Alonzo Tredwell. Tejeda's recent succes is noted below.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: The FredNats took four out of six games from Delmarva last week, winning the two weekend games by a combined three runs to win its first series since late-April. Fredericksburg picked up a walk-off win on Saturday night, and the bullpen dominated the Shorebird offense the entire series, which is noted below.

ROAD BLUES: Fredericksburg has struggled in road games this year, winning just seven out of 26 games away from VACU Stadium thus far. Away from home, the FredNat offense has just a .208 team batting average and a .608 team OPS, and the pitching staff's ERA is almost a full run higher on the road compared to home. Three of FXBG's seven total road wins came in the team's first trip to Fayetteville in April.

BULLPEN RESURGENCE: In last week's series with the Shorebirds, the FredNat bullpen returned to its early season dominant form. In 23 innings, the group allowed just two earned runs on five total hits with 27 strikeouts, which is an ERA of 0.78, the best mark in all of Minor League Baseball last week. In the month of June, the group's ERA is 0.96, which is also number one out of all 120 full-season MiLB teams.

HE'S BEEN UNHITTABLE: FredNat closer Robert Cranz took the Carolina League lead with his fifth save in Sunday's game, and he became the first reliever in the league this year to earn three saves in one series. Cranz currently has a 16.1 inning scoreless streak, which is the second longest active streak in the Carolina League behind Jack Young from Kannapolis. Cranz has not allowed a run since April 26, which is 13 appearances, and in that time frame, he has 26 strikeouts and only five walks.

THAT'S QUALITY: Tonight's FredNat starter Yoel Tejeda Jr. turned in the longest and potentially best start of the season for the FredNats last week, pitching seven innings of one-run ball with no walks and five strikeouts. Tejeda Jr. only needed 77 pitches to get through seven innings. Tejeda is in the top-10 in the Carolina League among qualified pitchers in several categories, including ERA (7th, 3.21), average against (6th, .228), and WHIP (6th, 1.17). A 14th-round selection out of Florida State last summer, Tejeda has proven to be a reliable starter for the FredNats in his first professional season.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers. Bazzell is throwing out 38.4% of base runners this year, which is one of the best rates in MiLB among qualified catchers and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 25 caught stealings. Rombach has 19 caught stealings, a top-10 mark in Single-A, and is throwing out 34% of potential base stealers this year.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014.

NEW OWNERSHIP: On Monday, June 9, it was announced that the Silber family sold the majority stake in the Fredericksburg Nationals to Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH), becoming the 44th MiLB team DBH has purchased since its founding in 2021. The FredNats will remain the Nationals' Single-A affiliate in the Carolina League. Seth Silber has kept a minority ownership stake and will take on the President/CEO role overseeing day-to-day operations moving forward, and DBH has retained the entire front office staff.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Yoel Tejeda Jr (Pronounced: Yo-ell Tay-hay-duh) made maybe the best start by any FredNat pitcher this season last week against Delmarva. He tossed a FredNat season-high 7.0 IP, allowing just one run. He didn't walk anyone and had five strikeouts, getting the win on just 77 pitches.

TIP TOP TEJEDA: Tejeda currently ranks seventh in the Carolina League in ERA (3.21) and sixth in WHIP (1.17).

MAY 1?: Tejeda was just named the FredNats Pitcher of the Month for May by Nationals Player Development after posting a 3.28 ERA across his five starts in the month. He struck out 24 hitters in 24.2 IP.

EXECUTIVE DECISION: Tejeda has recently been working on his mental game with a sports psychologist, developing the mindset to be an "executioner" on the mound, attacking hitters without any fear.

ON FLORIDA TIME: Tejeda pitched for two different Florida schools at the collegiate level. The righthander had a 5.56 ERA in 22.2 IP as a primary starter for Florida in 2023 and a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 IP as a reliever for Florida State in 2024 after transferring.

TOP SHELF: At 6-foot-8, Tejeda is tied with Jackson Rutledge ('21,'22) as the tallest player to ever play for the FredNats.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
