#### LAST GAME OUT

**(MOOSIC, PA - June 19)** - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Buffalo Bisons 8-2 Wednesday night at PNC Field. The RailRiders' seven-run second and Will Warren's quality start helped SWB win the second game of their homestand against the Blue Jays affiliate.

Warren, the #7 Yankees' Prospect, worked out of a jam in the top of the first. After a walk and a single that put runners on the corners, Warren ended the threat by striking out Max McDowell. In the bottom half of the frame, #20 prospect Agustín Ramírez knocked a base hit in his Triple-A debut. Warren continued to set the tone in the top of the second. Will Robertson singled but the bases were successfully cleared when Phil Clarke hit into a 4-6-3 double play. With two outs, Cam Eden singled but Michael Turconi struck out, giving Warren consecutive innings with a punch out. The RailRiders plated seven runs against Bison starting pitcher Aaron Sanchez in the second. Carlos Narvaez walked to lead off the inning and Jose Rojas followed with a 108.9 mph single to left. Narvaez scored as Oscar González reached safely on an error for the first run of the game. After Taylor Trammell walked to load the bases, Rojas crossed the plate on a Jeter Downs sacrifice fly. Oswald Peraza continued the scoring with an RBI hit of his own. With runners on the corners, Jorbit Vivas doubled to give SWB a 5-0 advantage. T.J. Ruffield chased Sanchez from the game with his sixth homer of the year, a 400-foot two-run blast to add two more to the tally. Robertson put the Bisons on the board to end the shutout bid with a solo home run in the top of the fourth, making it 7-1. Downs countered in the bottom of the fifth and extended the lead to 8-1 with his ninth homer of the season, a 382-foot shot to left. In the top of the sixth, Riley Tirota sent a ball over the wall to make it 8-2. After Robertson walked, Warren again ended a frame with a strikeout by fanning Buffalo's Clarke.

Warren (W, 5-4) pitched 6.0 innings giving two runs on seven hits and striking out six. Jesus Liranzo worked 2.0 innings of relief allowing just one hit. Yankees #24 prospect Jack Neely pitched a clean frame in his Triple-A debut. For the Bisons, Sanchez (L, 2-4) tossed 1.2 innings surrendering seven runs on five hits.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**JEET HEAT** - Jeter Downs had his third homer and seventh hit in the past four games to up his season average to .276. The right hander has found his swing in June batting .419 in nine games with three homers and nine runs batted in. In the month he has walked (4) as many times as he has struck out (4) and has snagged seven bases.

**WILLING IT** - Yankees #7 prospect Will Warren pitched his fourth quality start, his first since April 31. The righty has made a farm system high 14 starts for 66.1 innings. Warren holds a team-high 72 strikeouts compared to 26 walks. He has had a successful June, working a 2.86 ERA in four starts garnering two wins with 24 strikeouts.

**AU-GUS-TEEN** - Yankees #20 prospect Agustín Ramírez had his first hit in Triple-A last night with a pop into shallow right field. Ramírez has had a spectacular start to the season hitting .289 in 58 games with Somerset. He has had 66 hits including 14 doubles and 16 home runs with 49 runs driven in. These are the second most hits and the most home runs and RBIs in the farm system. At the time of his promotion, Ramirez led the Eastern League in homers, RBIs, OPS, SLG, and XBH. The 22-year-old played 15 games at first and 31 as catcher.

**BULLPEN SUPPORT** - SWB received relievers Jesus Liranzo and Jack Neely for bullpen support and both made an impact in the game last night. The two combined for three shutout innings with three strikeouts. Both are coming up from Double-A Somerset and Neely will be making his Triple-A Debut. Liranzo has a 4.32 ERA with the Patriots in just 7 games after starting the season on the Injured List. Neely holds a 2.61 earned run average in 22 appearances. He has totaled 51 strikeouts.

**TULLY TIME** - Tanner Tully is back off the Temporary Inactive List after going on Paternity Leave for his baby boy Toby. Tanner and his wife Taylor already share baby Tucker. Tully's last start was on June 9 versus Norfolk when he went five innings of work. The southpaw allowed six runs, five earned, but retired the last ten batters he faced.

**RUMFIELD'S RAGE** - T.J. Ruffield has impressed in his first season in Triple-A. Ruffield has hit .295 in 49 games with 57 hits and 34 runs batted in. The lefty has been strong in June hitting .302 where half his knocks have been for extra bases. He holds a .984 fielding percentage at first base, making just five errors in 360 innings played.

**CROSS THE PLATE** - The RailRiders are 22-2 when they score seven or more runs in a single game. Last night their seven-run second inning was their second largest offensive output in a single frame this season. The team has scored the most this summer in the seventh inning with 57 runs. SWB has a +38 run differential, third highest in the International League.

**SPRING NUMBERS:** Pitched in three games, one start and one save, for six innings of work...1.50 ERA (4H, 1R, 1BB, 2SO)

**VS DIABLOS ROJOS:** Got the start in the Yankees first game against Mexico's Diablos Rojos as a part of a two-game series to end Spring Training, tossed 4.1 innings allowing just one run on four hits (a home run to 41-yr-old Robinson Cano, recorded one strikeout

**FUN FACT:** Recorded his first career MLB strikeout on 6/26 vs. Boston, striking out Xander Bogaerts (swinging) to end the seventh inning... Allowed a home run in MLB debut to who but Aaron Judge

**ON GROWING UP IN ELKHART, INDIANA :** "It's definitely a small town. I would say the closest big town is South Bend, the Notre Dame area. But it's a small town, not really much to do, just cornfields and beanfields"...Doesn't farm, but does fish and hunt

**THE OHIO STATE:** Began career as reliever, but transitioned to a starter.....just slowly grew in pitch count...won Big 10 Freshman of the Year... In three seasons (2014-16) at Ohio State, went 18-10 with a 2.93 ERA in 46 games

**CAREER:**

- **2023:** Spent the majority of the season with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 5-5 with a 5.64 ERA (91.0IP, 121H, 63R/57ER, 26BB, 77K, 14HR) in 19 starts... was released by the Yankees on 8/2... later signed with the NC Dinos in the Korea Baseball Organization, going 5-2 with a 2.92 ERA (64.2IP, 58H, 26R/21ER, 13BB, 47K, 6HR) in 11 starts
