RIDERS DOWNED BY CARDINALS DESPITE ZAVALA HOMER:
The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Springfield Cardinals 3-1 on Wednesday night from Riders Field. The Cardinals (29-24) struck first in the top of the first when Leonardo Bernal rolled an RBI single to take a 1-0 lead. The RoughRiders (31-21) answered in the bottom of the first when **Aaron Zavala** clobbered a lead-off homer to tie the game 1-1. In the top of the third inning, Joshua Baez mashed a two-run homer un to give Springfield a 3-1 lead. The Cardinals threatened again in the top of the sixth, but Frisco's defense held the lead. After Baez walked, reliever **Larson Kindreich** picked him off and caught him stealing. Jeremy Rivas then tripled but was picked off by catcher **Tucker Mitchell**. Springfield's Ramon Mendoza also tripled, but Kindreich induced an inning-ending flyout. Springfield closed the game retiring 16 of its last 18 batters faced. Cardinals starter Tekoah Roby (4-2) pitched 6.2 innings, allowing the Zavala homer while striking out eight. RoughRiders starter **Kohl Drake** (2-3) took the loss, fanning seven while allowing three runs across four innings. Kindreich, **Skylar Hales**, **Gerardo Carrillo** and **Avery Weems** pitched five combined scoreless innings.

The Riders have been strong out of their bullpen as of late. In this series, the Frisco bullpen has allowed just two runs over 11 innings (1.64 ERA). Dating back to Saturday, May 31st, the Riders bullpen has allowed just two earned runs in their last 15.1 innings (1.17 ERA). Overall this season, Riders bullpen arms own a 4.30 ERA, tied for fifth in the Texas League.

#### NO SWING AND A MIESES:

RoughRiders outfielder **Luis Mieses** has been fantastic at the plate. Mieses is third in the Texas League in slugging percentage (.527), fifth in OPS (.881) and tied for sixth with 19 extra-base hits. He won Texas League Player of the Week last week, hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.462/.955/1.417 with four doubles and three home runs. In his last 14 games, he is hitting .304 (14-for-46)/.396/.717/1.113 with seven doubles, four home runs and 10 RBIs. On a six-game hitting streak, he is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with a 1.217 OPS.

On Thursday night, Janser Lara became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher Robby Ahlstrom and Gavin Collyer are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and Skylar Hales has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the second-most in Minor League Baseball and tied for the third-most in franchise history through their first 50 games.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 18 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .247/.325/.562/.887 with five doubles, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored. On Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). His eight home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the fifth-most since 2005 through 53 team games, trailing Delmon Young (12), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (11), Oscar Taveras (10), and Tatis Jr. (10). This season, his walk rate of 11.7 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low.

#### ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 22 games, Ortiz is hitting .298 (25-for-84)/.404/.524/.928 with four doubles, five home runs and 18 RBIs. In that 22 game span, his .928 OPS is the seventh-best in the Texas League while his five home runs are tied for seventh.

#### MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders both hit and gave up their fair share of long balls last month. They hit 28 this month, which was second in the league and allowed 31, which is the second-most. Frisco's 4.60 ERA was seventh in the league during the month while they went 16-10 in May despite a -6 run differential.

#### **DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:**

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .304 (35-for-115). (426/.496/.922 over his last 33 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and is second in OBP (.415) while leading the league in walk rate (20.2 percent), a mark which also ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA). In May, he hit .305/.436/.463/.899, ranking 11th in average, second in OBP and 10th in OPS in the Texas League. It was his first career month finishing with a .300 or better batting average since August of 2022.

#### **BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:**

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first nine starts, his 1.89 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through nine starts in recorded franchise histroy by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 7.9 K/BB and 91.1 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 55 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 47.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.

#### **ABOUT JOSH**

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Alabama, and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate the new contract.

### 2025 SEASON

-Enters into 2025 in the 5th spot in the rotation.

-Last three starts: 2-0, 1.69 ERA (3ER/16.0IP)

#### **2024 SEASON**

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearace of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

### **2023 SEASON**

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

#### **2022 SEASON**

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.

#### **2021 SEASON**

-Pitched in the Fall Instructional League and participated in the Texas Tour against local universities in October, making a start against Dallas Baptist University.
