SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game with a 6-4 loss to the Bowie Baysox in the series finale. Bowie opened the scoring with a run in the first inning on a double-play groundout off the bat of Adley Rutschman. Cadyn Grenier extended the lead to 2-0 in the second with an RBI single. The Baysox scored four runs in the third to open a 6-0 lead. Rutschman hit an RBI single, Seth Mejias-Brean worked a bases-loaded walk, Johnny Rizer hit an RBI single and Grenier added another RBI walk to cap the scoring for the frame. Richmond began cutting into the Bowie lead with a solo home run by **Jacob Heyward** in the bottom of the sixth. **Will Wilson** added an RBI double in the inning. **Sandro Fabian** cut the deficit to 6-3 with a solo homer in the seventh. **Vince Fernandez** brought in Richmond's final run with a sac fly in the eighth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the only trip to Richmond this season for Reading. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium when the teams previous met from May 25-30.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10 of the last 11 games after winning 12 of the previous 16 to close within one game of first place in the division. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 10.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.94 ERA for the season.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS have lost four straight games and 15 of their last 19 games. Reading's offense is ranked 10th in the Double-A Northeast with a .229 batting average and are tied for third with 91 home runs. Reading's pitching staff is ranked 10th in the league with a 5.12 ERA. Reading's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including SS Bryson Stott (No. 2), RHP Francisco Morales (No. 3), RHP Hans Crouse (No. 4), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 21), LHP Kyle Dohy (No. 24) and RHP James McArthur (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his 15th start of the 2021 season and his second against Reading. Last time out, he tied a Double-A-high with 6.0 innings of work, allowing two runs in a no-decision against the Baysox on Wednesday afternoon. Hjelle faced the Fightin Phils in Reading on May 29 and picked up his second win of the season, allowing four runs (three earned) across 5.0 innings of work in a 6-4 Flying Squirrels victory. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He entered the 2021 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander Josh Hendrickson makes his 10th Double-A start and first against the Flying Squirrels. Hendrickson last pitched last Tuesday, working 4.2 innings and allowing four runs for the third consecutive start. Over his last three starts, he has gone 0-1 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP) after going 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA (9 ER/30.0 IP) through his first six Double-A starts. Hendrickson, a native of Perth, Australia, was drafted by the Kansas City Royals in the 20th round in 2018 out of a junior college in Kansas but did not sign. He attended the University of San Diego for one season and was drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 38th round in 2019. That year in his first professional season, he went 3-2 with a 1.95 ERA in 16 games (four starts) between the GCL Phillies and Low-A Lakewood. He opened the 2021 season with High-A Jersey Shore, going 0-1 with a 2.75 ERA in six outings (three starts). Prior to his professional career, Hendrickson played with the Australian National Team in the 2015 WBSC U18 World Cup Oceania Qualifiers in Auckland, New Zealand, the 2015 WBSC U18 World Cup in Osaka, Japan and the 2016 WBSC U23 World Cup in Monterrey, Mexico.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Minicuzzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 25 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 105 walks, which sits him tied for second in the team's history in career walks with **Jarrett Parker**. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for eighth in the circuit with 82 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 126 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .388 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history. Richmond's 80 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 23 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .321 (27-for-84) with six home runs, five doubles and 20 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 13 homers this season and second with 36 RBIs. He is hitting .200 (8-for-43) over his last 11 games since July 18 with 17 strikeouts.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .339 (19-for-56) over his last 15 games since July 15 with five doubles, one homer and five RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 13 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 30 steals in 33 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season. On Sunday, Whiteman played the center field for the first time in his professional career and made a diving catch.

TORRES ON A TEAR: **Bryan Torres** is currently riding a 11-game hitting streak dating back to July 3, which is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres is batting .390 (16-for-41) with two doubles, a triple and six RBIs. He has picked up two hits in four of his last six games played. Torres has also collected three RBIs in his last three games. He is batting .300 this season in 32 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.

VIRTUAL REALITY: **David Villar** is hitting .333 (9-for-27) over his last seven games since July 24, adding two doubles and one RBI. In 39 games dating back to June 16, Villar has hit .313 (46-for-147) with six homers, 12 doubles and 16 RBIs. Villar has hit 11 home runs this season, but has not homered in his last 17 games, which is his longest streak without going deep on the 2021 season.

LEFT ON BASE: Over the last 11 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .141 (14-for-99) with runners in scoring position and have left 100 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .136 (8-for-59) with the bases loaded, which is the second-lowest mark of the 120 full-season minor league teams this year.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for 10th with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for seventh with 48 RBIs. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 13 stolen bases. **Frank Rubio** (27/T-4th), **Joey Marciano** (27/T-4th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (26/T-7th) and **Raffi Vizcaino** (26/T-7th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **RJ Dabovich** is tied for sixth in the league with six saves. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for ninth in the circuit with five saves.

FREE FALLING: The Flying Squirrels have lost 10 of the last 11 games since July 21, dropping their record to .500 for the first time since May 5 (1-1). In that span, Richmond has been outscored 54-35, losing games by an average of 1.7 runs. Four of the losses have been by one run and three have been by two runs. Prior to this stretch, the Flying Squirrels were tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron. The team has fallen back to fifth and is now 10 games back.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL) and **Sean Hjelle** (14). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baseline" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Three players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
