NOTES AND NUGGETS

SEASON 56

Omaha beings the 56th season in franchise history tonight against the Iowa Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.

- Omaha is coming off a 2024 campaign in which they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League during the regular season, before going on to win the International League Championship Series.
- The 2024 Chasers set a franchise wins record for wins in a season, passing the 86-win 1990 Omaha Royals that won the Triple-A Classic (national championship).
- Omaha came one win shy of setting the franchise winning percentage record in 2024, needing 90 wins to set a new club best ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history is from the inaugural 1969 Omaha Royals at .607 (85-55).

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Omaha enters 2024 as the defending champions of the International League.

- Winners of the 1st half (49-24 record), Omaha hosted the 2nd-half Champion Columbus Clippers (Cleveland Triple-A affiliate) in the International League Championship Series ... after dropping Game 1 to Columbus 3-2, Omaha came back to win Game 2 in 11 innings, 5-4, before winning Game 3 by a score of 7-3.
- 2024 marked Omaha's 8th league championship as a Triple-A Club, having won 4 American Association titles (1969, 1970, 1978, 1990), 3 Pacific Coast League championships (2011, 2013, 2014) and now an International League title ... Omaha is the first club to win a league championship in 3 different Triple-A leagues.
- The Storm Chasers fell short of winning Omaha's 4th Triple-A National title (also: 1990, 2013, 2014), losing 13-6 to the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A) in the Triple-A National Championship Game on September 28, 2024.

OPENING DAY OPTICS

Dating back to 1985, the Triple-A Omaha franchise is 14-25 on Opening Day but has won its first game of the season the last four years, tying a franchise record streak ... this is the 7th time Omaha has opened against Iowa in 56 seasons.

- When opening the season on the road since 1985, Omaha is 5-17 ... Omaha has opened the in Des Moines three times: a 8-7 loss on April 6, 1971, a 6-1 loss on April 9, 1974 and a 5-3 loss on April 4, 1996.
- Additionally, Omaha won a 8-7 in 10 innings on April 6, 1995 vs. Iowa, lost 6-5 in 11 innings on April 3, 1997 vs. Iowa and won 5-4 in 11 innings last year, on March 29, 2024, as Cam Devanney scored on passed ball.

ROSTER RUNDOWN

The Storm Chasers and Kansas City Royals jointly announced Omaha's roster yesterday, ahead of today's Opening Day game in Iowa, with 20 returning players from the 2024 league championship season on the 28-man roster.

- Returning pitchers include **Luinder Avila**, **Jonathan Bowlan**, **Noah Cameron**, **Chandler Champlain**, **Austin Cox**, **Steven Cruz**, **Tyson Guerrero**, **Andrew Hoffmann**, **Anthony Simonelli**, **Evan Sisk** and **Jacob Wallace** ... returning hitters are catcher **Brian O'Keefe**, infielders **Cam Devanney**, **Nick Loftin**, **Nick Pratto** and **Tyler Tolbert**, plus outfielders **Tyler Gentry**, **John Rave**, **Nelson Velázquez** and **Drew Waters**.
- Pitcher **Cruz Noriega** and catcher **Luca Tresh** are both on their first Triple-A roster ... their first appearances with Omaha will mark their Triple-A debuts.
- New to the Royals organization this season are pitchers **Junior Fernandez** and **Thomas Hatch**, catcher **Luke Maile**, infielder **Harold Castro** and outfielder **Joey Wiemer** ... pitcher **Taylor Clarke** returns to Kansas City on a Minor League deal after working out of the Royals' bullpen from 2022-23.

BE LIKE MIKE

Manager **Mike Jirschele** returns in 2025 for his 17th season managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise, in the 3rd year of his 3rd stint with the club, with an all-time record of 1152-1154 in Omaha ... this is his 34th season in the Royals organization.

- In 2024, "Jirsch" was named the International League Manager of the Year, his first such award with Omaha, leading the IL Champs to a league-best 89-59 in the regular season, setting a franchise record with 89 wins.
- Jirschele previously led the Triple-A Omaha club from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 through 2013, winning the PCL league title in 2011 and a Triple-A National Championship in 2013 ... he was Kansas City's 3rd Base Coach from 2014 to 2019.

MARCH ON

Today, March 28, is the earliest Opening Day in Triple-A Omaha franchise history, the 3rd time the club has opened in the month of March.

- Omaha is 3-1 all-time in the month of March ... the Storm Chasers beat the Indianapolis Indians 8-6 on March 31, 2023 (Opening day), then took 2 out of 3 games from the Iowa Cubs to open the 2024 season, opening the year with 2 wins before a loss to the I-Cubs on March 31, 2024.

Guerrero pitched for three different Washington colleges in his home state, but it was a solid season for the Washington Huskies that caught the Royals' attention and led them to select the lefty in the 12th round of the 2021 Draft. He was limited early in his pro career because of injuries but jumped onto the radar with two consistent seasons. Guerrero returned to Double-A in 2024 and posted a 3.69 ERA across 102 1/3 innings and 22 games (all starts). He jumped to Triple-A at the end of August and didn't finish well, allowing 21 earned runs in 20 2/3 innings with 14 walks and 14 strikeouts in his final five starts.

Armed with a four-pitch mix, Guerrero sits 91-93 mph with a fastball that runs up to 96. He has two breaking balls, an 83-84 mph slider and a 77-78 mph curveball, the latter of which has downer action and flashes plus on some nights. The slider with sweeping action is probably his best secondary right now and tunnels off his fastball well. His changeup is fringe average and still developing after an inconsistent year. Guerrero is usually a strikethrower who keeps the ball in the ballpark.

Guerrero has more of a smaller build, but his stuff would probably tick up in the bullpen. There's likely more opportunity there for him as a multi-inning reliever as he gets closer to Kansas City. But he'll continue to start and be part of the Royals' Triple-A depth in 2025 while he works on that fourth pitch. The club passed on adding him to the 40-man roster over the offseason, but he didn't get picked up by a team in the Rule 5 Draft. Guerrero gets high marks for his composure on the mound.

Baseball America

A 12th-round pick in 2021, Guerrero spent most of his fourth pro season at Double-A Northwest Arkansas. He heads to the mound with four average-or-better pitches. His 91-94 mph fastball has natural sinking action. Both of his breaking balls are swing-and-miss offerings, especially his slider. Guerrero throws an average changeup but doesn't throw enough strikes to be more than a swingman or reliever.

- Today is the 1st Opening Day start of Tyson's Minor League career ... however, he threw 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in the 2023 season opener for the High-A Quad Cities River Bandits on April 7, 2023 vs. South Bend (CHC).
- Among 16 Royals Minor League pitchers with at least 150.0 innings pitched over the last two years, ranks 3rd in starts (45), 3rd in K% (26.4%), 3rd in opponents' average (.220).
- Ranked by **MLB Pipeline** as the **No. 24 Royals prospect**.

Started the final game of the 2024 regular season for Omaha, tagged for 5 runs on 5 hits and 2 walks over 3.0 innings ... was his only outing all season (at either Double-A or Triple-A) without a strikeout.

- As a non-roster invitee, made 2 Cactus League appearances for the Royals in Major League Spring Training ... allowed 2 earned runs over 3.0 innings (6.00 ERA), with 3 hits, 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.

- Opened the year with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and made 22 appearances (20 starts) with the Naturals, promoted to Triple-A on August 22, to end his season with Omaha ... between the two levels, combined to go 4-9 with a 4.54 ERA (62 ER in 123.0 IP).
 - A career-high 123 strikeouts finished as tied for the 2nd highest among Royals farmhands, behind only **Noah Cameron's** 149.
 - Opened the year with a 5.88 ERA (37 ER in 56.2 IP) over 14 Double-A outings ... across his last 8 starts with NWA, from July 6 to August 22, worked a 0.99 ERA (6 ER in 45.2 IP) with a .141 opponents' average (22-for-156).
 - Threw 6 quality starts with NW Arkansas, including 5 straight between July 27 and August 16, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts in that span, July 30 at Wichita (MIN) and August 16 vs. Corpus Christi (HOU).
 - Named the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week for his effort the week of August 3-10 ... threw 2 quality starts and 13.0 scoreless innings on the road against the Wichita Wind Surge ... only allowed 3 hits with 11 strikeouts.
 - Made 5 starts for Omaha to end the season, going 1-3 with a 8.71 ERA (20 ER in 20.2 IP) ... came an out shy of a quality start on September 17 @ Louisville (CIN) with 1 earned run allowed over 5.2 innings.

- Spent much of the season with Quad Cities (A+) but ended the year at Northwest Arkansas (AA), combining to pitch in 21 games (20 starts) and go 3-6 with a 3.97 ERA (42 ER in 95.1 IP) with 121 strikeouts (11.42 K/9).
 - Finished the year 7th in the Royals system in strikeouts (121) ... among Kansas City's Minor League pitchers with at least 70.0 innings pitched, ranked 2nd in K/9 (11.42), 3rd in K/BB (3.56) and 3rd in opponents' average (.215).
 - Led the River Bandits in strikeouts (106) and ranked 2nd on the team in starts (17) and innings pitched (84.1 IP), trailing only **Luiser Avila** in both categories.
 - Made 6 quality starts (all with the River Bandits), including a pair of 7.0-inning performances ... threw 7.0 frames of 1-run ball (unearned) on June 3 at Lake County (CLE) with just 2 hits and 7 strikeouts ... added another 7.0-inning game on July 26 vs. Lansing (OAK), with just 2 runs allowed and 8 strikeouts.
 - Named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 17-23, after throwing 6.0 no-hit innings on April 19 vs. Wisconsin (MIL) ... only issued 1 walk while striking out 8.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are 58 results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. 34 of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
