REGULAR SEASON BY THE NUMBERS

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves begin a six-game road series against the Blue Wahoos. This is the first of five series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 30 times. The M-Braves are on their longest road trip of the season, which includes 12 games (6 at BLX, 6 at PNS) from April 25 to May 7.

MILB GAME OF THE DAY: Tonight's series opener featuring Atlanta's No. 28 prospect Tanner Gordon and Marlins No. 1 prospect Eury Perez is the MiLB Free Game of the Day, meaning it will stream free on MiLB.com, MLB.com, the MLB.TV app, the MLB Pipeline homepage and on the Braves and Marlins sites.

LAST WEEK'S RECAP: The M-Braves settled for a series split with the Shuckers after dropping the series finale on Sunday 10-5. The club blasted 10 home runs and 10 doubles, slugging .447 over the six-game series

The series featured several close games, with four of six games being decided by two runs or less. The M-Braves won three of those four games, including a pair of one-run wins (Thursday, 2-1 & Saturday, 7-6)

The M-Braves have yet to win a series this season, with the split being their best result to this point.

"STARTIN' TO COME TOGETHER PEPPER": After starting the season 3-10, the M-Braves have won five of eight since the April 22 walk-off grand slam by Jacob Pearson. Over the last nine games, the club has hit 11 homers and 14 doubles

"KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are second in the Southern League with 23 homers - 19 coming on the road. Ten different players have at least one homer with Valdes leading the way with four.

VIVA LA VALDES: Javier Valdes notched his first career two-homer game on Saturday, and leads the team, and his second in the Southern League with four home runs. In his last three games, the Miami native is 7-for-12 with three doubles, three home runs, and three RBI.

Multi-homer game: His two-homer game was the first by an M-Braves player this season, and first since Drew Lugbauer hit two on 9/7/22 at Biloxi.

RETURN OF THE DEAN: OF **Justin Dean** returns to the M-Braves roster -- transferred from Triple-A Gwinnett, In 19 games, the Mauldin, SC native was batting .196 with a triple, home run, nine RBI, 14 walks, four stolen bases, and a .371 OBP. Dean has a .235 career batting average over 177 games played for the M-Braves, from 2021-2022. Dean has the longest-measured home run for Gwinnett this season, 427 feet, on April 2 vs. Jacksonville.

Cannon for an arm: Dean recorded two outfield assists in three games against Biloxi, throwing out a runner at the plate and a tagging runner at second base.

THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP Tanner Gordon has won two-straight starts and now ranks 7th in the Southern League with a 2.18 ERA over four starts. He also ranks among the league leaders in innings pitched (5th, 20.2 IP), WHIP (6th, 0.92), and opponents' average (9th, .190). He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever has quietly put together a solid start to the season. He has saves in back-to-back games, and across 11.0 innings, Barger has 13 strikeouts to four walks, in seven appearances, allowing no runs, and is T-3rd in the league in saves.

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

ROLLIN' ROBLES: LHP Domingo Robles is starting to find his groove, allowing two earned runs over 11.0 innings in his last two starts. On Saturday, the left-hander went six innings and allowed two runs, one earned off three hits and a walk with eight strikeouts. Robles is 2-1 with a 2.57 ERA and 18 strikeouts over 14.0 innings for the M-Braves.

Robles is in his first season with the Atlanta Braves organization. He pitched for Double-A Springfield in the Cardinals organization last season and started 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett.

GIVE ME MOOOO: Andrew Moritz is currently on a six-game hitting streak, batting .311 with one home run, two triples, and five RBI.

The outfielder started the season on the injuried list and returned to the club on April 13. After initially going 0-for-10 in his first three games, Moritz has hit in 10 of 11 games with four multi-hit games.

THE KING ADDS ANOTHER GEM TO HIS CROWN: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. The towering 426-foot blast landed on top of the parking deck past right field. The ball left Lugbauer's bat at 115 miles

Lugbauer has a club record 50 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 50th M-Braves home run on Sunday at Biloxi. He has four homers in 2023, tied for second in the Southern

"IT WAS WORTH THE WAIT": Jacob Pearson's grand slam ended an eight-game losing streak, tied for second longest in club history. The walkoff grand slam was the first hit of the season for Pearson, who entered the game in the inning before as a pinch runner.

The M-Braves lost nine games in a row twice in club history. The M-Braves lost eight games in a row from July 17-25 during the championship-winning season in 2021.

BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP Kyle Wilcox, RHP Beau Burrows, IF Luke Waddell, C Hendrik Clementina, and LHP Domingo Robles have all been promoted to Gwinnett this sesaon. OF Jacob Pearson and OF Justin Dean have spent time with Triple-A Gwinnett.

TODAY'S GAME

Tanner Gordon makes his 26th Double-A start and fifth start of the 2023 season. This will be Gordon's fifth career start against the Blue Wahoos.

LAST TIME OUT

Gordon went 5.2 shutout innings, allowing three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts. Gordon has allowed just one run over his last 11.2 innings with two walks to 14 strikeouts.

2023 NOTES

Currently ranks top 10 in the Southern League in ERA (2.18, 7th), innings pitched (20.2, 7th), opponent batting (.190, 10th), and WHIP (0.92, 5th).

2022 NOTES

- With the M-Braves: 21 starts, 9-6 record, 5.31 ERA, 98.1 IP, 97 SO, 37 BB
- Over his last six starts, went 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA (11 ER/33.0 IP), 34 SO to 11 BB over those starts
