YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their third straight game, falling to the Akron RubberDucks, 5-3, at Canal Park. Richmond scored the game's first run in the first inning with a sac fly by **Diego Rincones**, but Akron answered immediately with an RBI triple by Andruw Monasterio to tie the score, 1-1, in the bottom of the inning. Clark Scolamiero gave the "Ducks a 3-1 lead in the second with a two-run homer, his first with Akron. The score held until the top of the seventh, when **Frankie Tostado** evened the score, 3-3, with a two-run home run. Akron moved back in front in the bottom of the seventh with an RBI single by Daniel Schneemann and opened a 5-3 lead in the eighth with an RBI single by Steven Kwan. Juan Mota worked the final 1.2 innings to close his fifth save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The series is the first of the year between the two teams and the Flying Squirrels' only visit to Canal Park this year. The Flying Squirrels are 16-18 in games against the Southwest Division, including an 8-8 mark in road games. Richmond is 16-15 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost three straight games after winning 12 of the previous 16. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Division, 4.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked tied for third in the league with a 3.94 ERA for the season. Since July 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-6 in 22 games. The last two are the first back-to-back losses for Richmond in that stretch.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won nine of their last 12 games. They are currently in first place in the Southwest Division, 1.0 game ahead of Bowie. Akron's offense is ranked third in the league with a .258 batting average. The pitching staff has the league's second-best ERA at 3.77. The Akron roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland Indians prospects, including SS Tyler Freeman (No. 2), C Bo Naylor (No. 3), RHP Ethan Hankins (No. 9 - on IL), RHP Carlos Vargas (No. 17 - on IL), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 21 - on IL), LHP Logan Allen (No. 22) and 2B/OF Richie Palacios (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his Flying Squirrels debut and his first affiliated baseball appearance since April 11, 2018. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on Friday. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Logan Allen makes his third Double-A appearance and second start. He made his Double-A debut on July 13 at Harrisburg and worked 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. He followed with 4.1 innings against the Senators on July 17 and allowed one run. Allen was selected in the second round (56th overall) by Cleveland in 2020 out of Florida International University. He began his first professional season this year with High-A Lake County, going 5-0 with a 1.58 ERA in nine starts before being promoted to Double-A on July 2. Prior to his All-American career at FIU, Allen was the Florida Gatorade Player of the Year at University High in Orange City, Fla., in 2017.

POWER SURGE: Over the last 16 games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 home runs, which is tied for the second-most in the Double-A Northeast. **Vince Fernandez** has hit six homers during that stretch. **Heliot Ramos** hit four homers in that span. **Diego Rincones** and **Frankie Tostado** have hit three. **Sandro Fabian** has two homers. **Andres Angulo**, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andy Sugilio**, **David Villar**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** have each hit one homer in that span. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for seventh in the circuit with 75 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 129 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 108 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .391 slugging percentage, which would be the highest in the franchise's history.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCe: In his last 17 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .351 (20-for-57) with six home runs, three doubles and 17 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 12 homers this season and second with 33 RBIs. Last Wednesday against the Patriots, Fernandez went 4-for-5 with a homer, a double, a walk and five RBIs, capping his performance with a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning. It was the 18th five-RBI performance by a Flying Squirrels hitter in the franchise's history and the second this season. Last Friday, he hit a game-winning, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth inning to top Somerset, 6-4. He added a solo home run to center on Saturday night.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .375 (9-for-24) over his last eight games since July 15 with four doubles, one homer and five RBIs. He leads the team with 11 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 28 steals in 30 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

STRONG WILLED: Over his last six games, **Will Wilson** is batting .348 (8-for-23) with one homer, two doubles and four RBIs. He hit .143 (6-for-42) with one extra-base hit, a double, over his first 10 games at Double-A from July 6-16. Wilson hit his first Double-A home run last Saturday against Somerset and has combined to hit 11 home runs this season between Richmond and High-A Eugene.

BREAKING OUT: **David Villar** has hit .308 (37-for-120) with six homers and 15 RBIs over his last 32 games since June 16. He hit .318 (7-for-22) in six games during last week's series against Somerset, picking up four doubles. He is batting .177 (3-for-17) in the current series. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 31 RBIs.

GO, DIEGO, GO! **Diego Rincones** hit his first Double-A home run on Saturday against Somerset, a three-run shot in the second inning that tied the game, 3-3, in a 7-3 Flying Squirrels win. He followed with a two-run, go-ahead homer in the bottom of the eighth inning in the series finale against Somerset on Sunday night in an 8-7 win. On Tuesday, he belted a game-tying three-run homer at Akron. Rincones has picked up 11 RBIs in his last seven games dating back to last Wednesday. In his last six games since July 17, Rincones is batting .353 (6-for-17) with three homers and 10 RBIs.

LEFT ON BASE: In the current three-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .042 (1-for-24) with runners in scoring position and have left 31 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .135 (7-for-52) with the bases loaded, which is the lowest mark in all of minor league baseball this season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Vince Fernandez** is ranked tied for seventh with 13 home runs. **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for seventh with 44 hits. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 11 stolen bases. **Frank Rubio** is tied for fourth in the league with 25 games pitched and **Joey Marciano** is sixth with 24. **Joey Marciano** are tied for fourth with 24 games pitched. **RJ Dabovich**, **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second in ERA (2.14), 10th in innings pitched (59.0), third in BAA (.213), first in WHIP (0.90), first in compete games (2) and shutouts (1).

WINNING WAYS: The Flying Squirrels' 38-32 record is tied for the second-best record in team history through 70 games, even with the 2015 season. The only season with a better start was 2014, when the team went 40-30. Richmond is looking for its first winning season since 2015, when the team went 72-68.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Four players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
