FROM THE CROWS NEST

FROM START TO FINISH: Saturday's complete game thrown by RHP Khristian Curtis was the 25th in franchise history (since 2010) and the fourth time it has occurred against Fort Myers. He's also the first Marauder to throw a complete game since Santiago Florez threw two back in 2021 becoming the 20th different pitcher to throw one.

COLLECTING IN BUNCHES: Pirates' No. 15 prospect Shalin Polanco is finding his footing in the 2024 season after a slow start. Over his last five games, Polanco is hitting .357/.526/.643 with a double, three RBIs, four walks, a stolen base, and a run scored. In this week's series against Fort Myers, the Marauders outfielder has a pair of multi-hit games in four games started.

BEST OF MAY: The Bradenton Marauders' pitching staff finished May with the second-best ERA in Florida State League at 3.32, which was also the seventh-best in Single-A. The bullpen posted a 2.73 ERA and struck out 134 batters in 115.1 innings, which is good for the best ERA in Single-A and seventh-best in MiLB. The 16 wins were the fifth-most in Single-A.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with Dunedin leading the charge. This comes after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has a pair of home runs in two games.

HE JUST GETS ON BASE: C Omar Alfonzo's on-base streak came to an end at 16 games on Saturday night in game two of a doubleheader. During his streak, the Pirates' No. 28 prospect slashed .283/.458/.358 with four doubles, seven RBIs, 17 walks, two intentional walks, and six runs scored. It was the second-longest streak by a Marauder this season, only trailing Esmerlyn Valdez (19 games)

FLYING AROUND: Last Wednesday night, the Marauders stole a season-high five bases against the Dunedin Blue Jays. In the series against the Blue Jays, Bradenton finished a near perfect 14-for-15 in stolen base attempts, the 10th-most in MilB during this span. The Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, CLE) swiped 19 in 23 attempts to lead the way last week. The lone man caught was Keiner Delgado on Sunday on their only attempt of the game. Since last Tuesday, Bradenton is 19-for-20 in stolen base attempts.

CHECKMATE: OF Braylon Bishop's hitting streak ended on Saturday night in game two of a doubleheader at eight games, the longest by a Marauder this year. The Marauders outfielder was 11-for-32 with three doubles, a triple, two HRs, 10 RBIs, and eight runs scored. Bishop played in just four games before being placed on the injured list on April 12.

HELLO AGAIN: The Marauders continue their first road trip to Hammond Stadium of the season. Bradenton won five of six games against Fort Myers at the beginning of May as a part of their franchise-record 11-game winning streak that began on May 2. Last season, Bradenton recorded a 7-5 record in Fort Myers and won the last two games to end the year.
