### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell to the Somerset Patriots 6-2 on Thursday night. With the game tied at one entering the seventh, Somerset scored four runs on two hits and three errors to take the lead, highlighted by a three-run homer by Rafael Flores. Bowie scored its only runs of the game on a **Silas Ardoin** RBI single and a **TT Bowens** sacrifice fly. **Alex Pham** delivered five innings of one-run ball with two strikeouts in a no decision. The Baysox have now lost six of their last seven.

### ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the 8th-most hits in the Eastern League (87) and is 5th in total bases (141). The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 4th-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (13) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18.

### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is the Eastern League's active leader in home runs and is tied for fifth in all of Double-A after hitting his 16th of the season on Tuesday. The O's No. 8 prospect has 31 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** registered his first multi-homer game of his career last Wednesday in Akron with his 10th and 11th homers of the season, matching his season total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 68 of 84 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (45) and stolen bases (24), tied for 4th-most and tied for 3rd-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

### BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B/OF **TT Bowens** delivered arguably his best performance of his career on Wednesday. The 26-year-old recorded his first multi-homer game, his first grand slam and his first six RBI game of his career. His 52 RBI and 32 extra base hits this season are 9th-most and tied for 7th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

### BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A on Wednesday and reached base in four of five plate appearances on Thursday. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is on an eight-game hitting streak. During his hit streak, he's batting .433 (13-for-30) with four doubles, a homer and four RBI.

### SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .360 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .529 and OPS of .969. The 23-year-old has RBI in two of the three games in this series and has collected a hit in four straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 20 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

### PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are 0.5 game out of the Northeast Division lead with a second-half record of 16-11. The Patriots share the league lead for the most homers this season and own the third-best OPS. Five of the Yankees top 30 prospects are on the Patriots active roster - OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 19), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 20), IF Tyler Hardman (No. 25), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27)

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Chase Hampton makes his season debut for the Patriots. The Yankees No. 3 prospect suffered a shoulder injury that has kept him out for much of the season. Hampton has spent the last month in Florida rehabbing with two starts in the Florida Complex League and three starts with Single-A Tampa. Hampton debuted with Somerset last season and in 11 starts, struck out 68 batters over 59.2 innings to an ERA of 4.37. The Longview, TX native was drafted by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 Draft out of Texas Tech.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
