Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the first in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Nuts are 6-6 vs. the Loons, losing four of six at Dow Diamond in May before turning the tables at Jackson Field a few weeks ago. 12 games remain in the season series.

Starting Matchup: It's an all Constitution State matchup, with Seymour, Conn., native Jake Walkinshaw for the Lugnuts facing Norwalk, Conn. native Ben Casparius for the Loons. Walkinshaw makes his fifth start for the Nuts and his second start against the Loons; on July 10, he struck out nine Loons in four scoreless innings, allowing two hits and one walk. Casparius was roughed up for five runs in five innings in his first start against the Lugnuts on July 7; this is his eighth start overall with Great Lakes.

Last Series: Two outs away from a series split, the Lugnuts were stunned by a four-run Captains rally in the ninth against Kumar Nambiar, including a tie-breaking two-run double from Milan Tolentino, to beat the Nuts 6-3 in Lansing. Lake County won four of six in the series and won the season series, 10-8.

Today's Transactions: The Lugnuts added a pair of pitchers from Single-A Stockton in starter Kyle Virbitsky and reliever Calvin Coker, with right-hander Stevie Emanuels heading down to the California League in a corresponding move. 23 24. The duo will become the Lugnuts' 25th and 26th different pitchers this year (and 48th and 49th different players), with Virbitsky becoming the Nuts' 17th different starting pitcher when he takes the mound on Friday. Virbitsky, drafted in 2021 in the 17th round from Penn State made his professional debut with the Nuts last season. Coker, a 15th-round pick from Auburn in 2018, makes his MWL debut.

Roll Out the Red Carpet: 19-year-old SS Max Muncy, the 25th overall pick in the 2021 draft and the No. 4 prospect in the Athletics' organization, was promoted to the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton during the All-Star Break and debuted Friday with doubles in each of his first two at-bats, then delivered a go-ahead tworun triple in Sunday's finale. Muncy had 16 doubles, one triple and 16 homers for the Ports, posting a .230/.357/.447 slash line overall. His arrival means that Lansing has both the Athletics' 2020 (Tyler Soderstrom) and 2021 first-round selections in the daily starting lineup.

Hot in July: The Lugnuts' top hitters this month include Jack Winkler (.344/.417/.531, .948 OPS, six doubles, two HRs and 14 RBIs in 18 games); UT Joshwan Wright (.356/.406/.508, .914 OPS, two doubles, two triples, one HR in 17 games) and Tyler Soderstrom (.302/.377/.642, 1.019 OPS, four doubles, one triple, four homers, 16 RBIs in 15 games). Winkler has raised his batting average from .221 to .266 and his OPS from .606 to .730 and Wright has raised his average from .214 to .263 and his OPS from .530 to .663.

Among the MWL Leaders: 1B Tyler Soderstrom is 2nd in the league with 65 RBIs, 4th with 154 total bases, 3rd with 38 XBH and 5th with 17 HR (which is tied with Las Vegas's Shea Langeliers for the most home runs in the A's organization this year). Meanwhile, reliever Kumar Nambiar is tied for 1st with 32 games pitched and reliever Trayson Kubo is 5th with seven saves.

Mightier in the Pen: The season had been a struggle for right-hander Osvaldo Berrios, with the Lugnuts going 1-10 in his 11 starts. But a move to the bullpen has turned around his season. Consider: Berrios had a 7.52 ERA in 11 starts and now has a 3.54 ERA in seven relief appearances. More specifically, he has eight strikeouts in 4 2/3 scoreless innings since being moved into a role at the back end of the bullpen, where his fastball now sits in the mid-90s.

- · Lugnuts OF Denzel Clarke, the A's No. 13 prospect, walked and struck out in two plate appearances and made a highlight-reel catch while colliding with the right field wall in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, helping the American League defeat the National League, 6-4. Fellow A's prospect Shea Langeliers homered and caught a runner stealing and was named MVP.
- Former Lugnuts Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. started the game for the American League, with Kirk catching the ceremonial first pitch from Fernando Valenzuela. Jordan Romano was also named an All-Star but did not see action out of the bullpen.

# 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Facing the Clinton LumberKings on Summer Fun Day, Brad Glenn became the fifth Lugnut in team history, and the first since Travis Snider in 2007, to hit for the cycle, leading the way in a 9-5 victory. The Oklahoman singled in the 1st, homered in the 3rd, doubled (sun-aided) in the 5th, and snapped a 4-4 tie with a two-run triple in the 7th inning **2014:** In four hours, three minutes, host Burlington walked off the Lugnuts, 3-2, in 14 innings on an Angel Rosa two-out RBI single. The two teams then played 15 more innings the next day, lasting a total 8:41.

**Take Two:** Joined Lugnuts in initial flight from Spring Training and was scheduled to be part of the starting rotation, but was placed on Injured List on Opening Day and flew back to Arizona (elbow)... made two Arizona Complex League starts in rehab, totaling 4 2/3 IP... flew to Double-A Midland on June 24 to be ready in case of emergency, but was not needed... returned to Lugnuts on June 28, tossing three scoreless innings at Lake County... in last start, July 17 at FW, allowed only two base runners: Cole Cummings HR and BB.

**In the Classroom:** Attained Bachelor's degree in Sport Management in three years at SNHU, posting a 3.88 GPA, then attained his MBA, focusing on project management, with a 4.0 GPA... interned in the SNHU athletic department, filming sporting events... twice was named Northeast 10 (NE10) Academic All-Conference and was named Academic All-District as a grad student.

On the Field: In high school, played shortstop when not pitching, batting second in the lineup... turned in an outstanding college career at SNHU, finishing 23-5, 16 saves – 11 in 2016, 2nd most in a season in school history – 1.93 career ERA, 76 G, 22 GS, 233 IP, 168 H, 62 BB, 234 K... finished 2nd in career wins, 2nd in ERA, 4th in strikeouts and 5th in innings pitched in SNHU record books... other NE10 rivals included Lake County's Zach Hart (Franklin Pierce University) and former Lugnut and current Stockton Port Edward Baram (Adelphi)... in 2019, named D-II East All-Region First Team, ABCA East All-Region Second Team, NCBWA East All-Region Second Team, and NE10 All-Conference First Team... SNHU was ranked No. 17 in the nation, but lost in the NCAA East-Super Regional to NYIT, finishing one victory shy of punching its ticket to the D-II College World Series in Cary, N.C.

The Penmen? Yes, SNHU's nickname is the Penmen, created by the editorial cartoonist of the Union Leader, Bob Murphy. Into the Workforce: Currently serves as Special Project Coordinator at Advanced Theory & Performance (ATP)... first came to ATP while rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in 2017, leading to post-college work opportunity.

**Going Pro:** Signed with the Athletics for \$1,000... debuted in 2019 with A's Green in the Arizona League, making 18 relief appearances, holding lefties to .200 avg. while righties hit .302... moved up to Stockton in 2021, converting from relief pitcher to starter, and had similar success vs. lefties (.248) compared to righties (.320)... worked this past offseason to change the spin of his slider to get more horizontal and vertical movement, seeking increased swing and miss.
