## Jersey Shore BlueClaws (0-0/26-39) vs Greenville Drive (0-0/26-37)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001)

RHP Ramon Marquez (--) vs RHP Kyson Witherspoon (2-3, 5.28)

Game 4 of 6 (Jersey Shore leads season series 2-1)

**Last Game Recap...** Joel Drago and Luke Davis homered as the BlueClaws bested Greenville 8-5 on Thursday night with the help of a 7-run bottom of the fifth inning...Duante Stuart and Devin Saltiban each had two hits for the BlueClaws...Starter Luke Gabrysh gave up one run in five innings to earn his second straight win while Jose Pena got the last five outs for his first High-A save.

**Back in First Place...** Today starts the 66 game second half...The SAL Northern Division Second Half Champion will play Frederick in the first round of the post-season...Bowling Green won the Southern Division First Half title.

**State of the BlueClaws...** The BlueClaws have scored 19 runs in their last two games and have won back to back games for the first time since they won three in a row from May 28-30 against Frederick...This also marks the third time this year (May 29-30 the last) they scored 19 runs in back to back games, excluding Opening Night's 19 run output in Wilmington.

**Luke the Nuke...** Luke Davis homered on both Wednesday and Thursday nights, his third and fourth home runs of the season...Since the start of the series last week at Hudson Valley, Davis is 8-25 with two home runs, seven RBIs, and six walks...The 23 year old from Garden Grove, California drew 70 walks in 287 plate appearances last year across the FCL, Clearwater, and Jersey Shore, and this year has drawn 36 walks in 167 plate appearances...He signed as a non-drafted free agent in 2024.

**A Big Debut for Duante...** Duante Stuart, who had been playing for the New Jersey Jackals in the Frontier League, had two hits in his BlueClaws debut on Thursday, including an RBI triple in his first at bat...Stuart, born in the Bahamas, moved to Texas at age 14 and went to The Woodlands High School (same high school to produce former BlueClaws P Kyle Drabek, Paul Goldschmidt, Jameson Taillon, and NFL WR Danny Amendola), before going to Northwestern State and Memphis.

**A First...** Joel Drago, a 7<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2024 from Presbyterian (SC), hit his first professional home run on Thursday night, a three run shot...Dragoo's home run came in his 141<sup>st</sup> professional game and 445<sup>th</sup> career at bat...Dragoo is a native of Beckville, Texas (population 722).

**Welcome to the Claws (Hitting)...** The BlueClaws added three hitters to the roster on Thursday:

- IF Brandon Lewis – Was hitting .347 with York in the Atlantic League, adding 19 home runs and 59 RBIs in 44 games, leading the league in home runs, RBIs, slugging percentage (.776), runs (47), and total bases (132)...He was originally drafted by the Dodgers in the 4<sup>th</sup> round in 2019 from UC-Irvine and played as high as Double-A (2022-2024)...Also spent last year with York.
- IF/OF Tyler Miller – Was hitting .310 with Lancaster in the Atlantic League after playing last year in Double-A with the Red Sox in Portland, where he hit .201 with eight home runs...Was a 9<sup>th</sup> round pick of the Red Sox in 2021 from Auburn.
- IF Duante Stuart – Was hitting .363 in 31 games with the New Jersey Jackals in the Frontier League, adding six home runs...He played in 2025 in the American Association with Lake Country (Oconomowoc, WI) and in 2024 with the Oakland Ballers in the Pioneer League.

**Driving to ShoreTown...** Greenville comes north for the week, the lone meetings between the teams this year (Greenville took five of six from Jersey Shore last year)...As High-A affiliates, the BlueClaws are 6-9 against the Drive, and 44-36 overall since the Drive's inception in 2005 (plus 6-2 in the SAL Championship Series, with the BlueClaws winning three games to one in both 2009 and 2010)...Greenville split six games with Winston-Salem last week and went 2-3 against Rome the week prior, with one cancellation.

**Getting Biddy With It...** Nick Biddison hit his second home run of the season in the win on Wednesday, a three run show, and drove in four runs (the third time in his career he drove in four in a game, the other two coming in 2022 with Rancho Cucamonga in the Dodgers system)...He is 12-40 since June 5<sup>th</sup>...He went 2-3 with two doubles June 6<sup>th</sup> against Brooklyn...Biddison had two RBI games on both June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, his first multi-RBI games of the season...Biddison played 19 games with the BlueClaws last year after coming over from the Dodgers on June 27<sup>th</sup>...He had been with Double-A Tulsa at the time of the trade.

**Welcome to the Claws (Pitching)...** The BlueClaws have made several additions to the staff, adding four pitchers from Clearwater after the Freshers first-half championship (three will start this week while Craig will work out of the bullpen)...

- RHP Ramon Marquez (#9 prospect) – AFA signing in 2025 from Mexico, 47 Ks/10 BBs in 29 innings.
- RHP Cody Bowker (#14 prospect) – 3<sup>rd</sup> round pick last year from Vanderbilt, threw four scoreless innings with six strikeouts on Tuesday in BlueClaws debut.
- RHP Gabe Craig (#23 prospect) – 5<sup>th</sup> round pick last year from Baylor, 33 Ks/13 BBs in 22 innings...Threw 1.1 scoreless innings in the win on Wednesday.
- RHP Tanner Gresham – went to Army West Point and threw five no-hit innings two starts back in a Threshers no-hitter.

**The Buckeye BlueClaw...** 3B Tyler Pettorini (9-24 in his last six games) had three hits on Wednesday...He hit his first professional home run in the win on June 13<sup>th</sup> at Hudson Valley...This came the day after his first BlueClaws three hit game on June 12<sup>th</sup>...Pettorini joined the BlueClaws on May 26<sup>th</sup> from Clearwater, where he was hitting .179 in 35 games with 13 stolen bases...He was a four year player at Ohio State and signed with the Phillies after the draft last year.

**Carter Goes Boom...** Carter Mathison hit his third home run of the season on Tuesday, all of which have come at ShoreTown Ballpark...Mathison hit seven with Clearwater last year...He also has 15 stolen bases this year and is 32-34 in his career...Mathison was a 5<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2024 from Indiana University.

**Shojinaga on a Roll...** Kodey Shojinaga had two multi-hit games last week and had two more on Wednesday...He is now 20-58 since May 24<sup>th</sup>, with six multi-hit games in that stretch...Shojinaga drew four walks on May 29<sup>th</sup>, tying a BlueClaws single-game record with seven others (Keaton Anthony matched him on May 31<sup>st</sup>)...Luke Davis did it on 4/17/25 at Greensboro...Shojinaga has 30 walks in 192 plate appearances this year and had 49 in 341 last year...Shojinaga was a 6<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2024 from the University of Kansas.

**More Walks Thank Strikeouts...** Kodey Shojinaga has 30 walks compared to 26 strikeouts on the season...Since 2011, no player has had at least 150 plate appearances with more walks than strikeouts...In 2024, Hendry Mendez finished with 54 of each...Mendez was traded to the Twins at the deadline last year for Harrison Bader and is currently in AAA St. Paul...JP Crawford, now with the Mariners, had 37 of each in 2024.

**Going Deep...** BlueClaws starters have thrown six innings in a game nine times this year – once by Sam Hightlow on June 9<sup>th</sup> at Hudson Valley, five by Reese Dutton (including June 13<sup>th</sup> at Hudson Valley) and three by Ryan Dromboski (including May 26<sup>th</sup> vs Frederick)...The last BlueClaw to throw seven innings in a game was Braydon Tucker on September 7, 2024 at Aberdeen.

**Don't Even Think About It...** Kodey Shojinaga is 13-40 throwing out potential base-stealers this year...He threw out two Frederick runners on May 31<sup>st</sup> and three Hudson Valley runners on April 29<sup>th</sup> (he nailed 32% of runners last year, 25-79)...Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, he is the fourth catcher to throw out three base-stealers in a game (Kehden Hettiger in 2025, Jordan Dissin in 2024, Arturo De Freitas in 2023), though Shojinaga is the only one to go a perfect 3 for 3.

**Power Index...** The BlueClaws have 25 home runs so far this year (Luke Davis and Joel Drago both homered on Thursday) including four by Luis Caicuto (two since May 26<sup>th</sup>) and Brady Day (IL)...Devin Saltiban (17 in 2024 with Clearwater) hit his first home run of the year on May 8<sup>th</sup> at Frederick...Last year, the BlueClaws did not have a player hit 10 home runs, the second time in franchise history the BlueClaws did not have a player reach double-digits (Jordan Dissin in 2024 and Zach Arnold in 2025 led the team with nine).

**Mr. 900...**The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900<sup>th</sup> player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

**Extra, Extra...**The BlueClaws have played 32 home games, and six have gone to extra innings (3-3 at home, 3-4 overall in extra innings)...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

**Things in 10s...**The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game eight times this year (most recently on 6/17 vs GVL), and scored 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times and did not do it for a fourth time until June 8<sup>th</sup>...After their 13-2 win on April 18<sup>th</sup>, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

**Familiar Faces...**Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

**Walk-Off This Way...**The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year...They beat Brooklyn 5-4 in 10 innings on June 4<sup>th</sup> on an RBI single from Luis Caicuto...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11<sup>th</sup> inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10<sup>th</sup> inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9<sup>th</sup> inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch).

**The Big Five...**The BlueClaws have used two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

**College Teammates...**The BlueClaws have two pairs of college teammates in IF Trent Farquhar and 1B Brock Vradenburg, who played together at Michigan State, and C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

**Just Grand...**Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17<sup>th</sup>...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

**From The Shore to the Show...**133 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and six total this year...**Justin Crawford** (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26<sup>th</sup> season opener while **Andrew Painter** (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31<sup>st</sup> in the fifth game of the season...RHP **George Klassen** (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6<sup>th</sup> with the Angels...IF **Hao-Yu Lee** (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17<sup>th</sup> with the Tigers...UT **Felix Reyes** (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18<sup>th</sup> with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...C **Rodolfo Duran** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on May 7<sup>th</sup> with the Padres...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

**Mycal Jones Takes Over...**Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18<sup>th</sup> manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

**On the Staff...**Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wroblewski makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.
