ABOUT YESTERDAY: Brooklyn suffered its second-consecutive defeat to Winston-Salem, losing 8-0. With the loss and a Hudson Valley victory at Jersey Shore, the Cyclones dropped out of first place by a half-game. Brooklyn INF **Jose Peroza** provided the only two hits, while the rest of the lineup went 0-for-27 with 13 strikeouts and five walks. Dash C **Tyler Osik** hit for the cycle, while OF **Ben Norman** and DH **Keegan Fish** each hit home runs. Brooklyn RHP **Oscar Rojas** tossed three scoreless innings on just 33 pitchers to open the game before LHP **Cam Opp** allowed six runs in 1 2/3 innings and RHP **Justin Courtney** yielded two runs in 3 1/3 innings.

WOES AGAINST WINSTON-SALEM: The Cyclones have scored just two runs over the first 18 innings of the series, collecting 11 hits. Brooklyn has struck out 13 times, going 11-for-63 (.174).

PEROZA POP: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .792 over his past 18 games. The Mets No. 29 prospect has been on base in 16 of the past 18 games, hitting .279 with a .351 OBP.

THANKS FOR MEMORIES: With Tuesday's trade between the Mets and San Francisco Giants, Brooklyn LHP **Nick Zwack** and RHP **Carson Seymour** were sent west along with INF J.D. Davis and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** for Giants 1B/OF **Darin Ruf**.

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** took Hudson Valley by storm last week. After a quiet 0-4 Tuesday, Ramirez finished the series 7-19 with a double, three home runs, and seven RBIs. On Sunday, Ramirez cracked two long balls, collecting his second multi-homer game this year and first with Brooklyn.

NIC KNOWS: Since June 21, 2019 draftee C/INF Nic Gaddis has been on base in 27 of his past 31 games, posting a .418 OBP and a .830 OPS. For his career,

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: The Chicago White Sox affiliate comes to Maimonides Park for the first matchup in history. The Dash host White Sox No. 1 prospect SS Colson Montgomery, No. 8 INF Bryan Ramos, and No. 10 RHP Matthew Thompson. In total, the Dash is home to seven of Chicago's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Winston-Salem ranks seventh in OPS and eighth with a 4.76 ERA among the 12-team South Atlantic League.

Gaddis has a .360 OBP and a .738 OPS.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 54 home runs in the past 64 games (0.8 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).


PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offenisvely, OF Alex Ramirez ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF Jaylen Palmer, No. 19 prospect 1B JT Schwartz, and No. 29 prospect INF Jose Peroza. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP Dominic Hamel, No. 16 prospect RHP Junior Santos, and No. 21 prospect Mike Vasil.

MLB DRAFT: With Monday's deadline of signing 2022 MLB Draftees, the Mets announced the signing of 19 of their 22 picks, including their first four selections: C Kevin Parada (1st round - GA Tech), SS Jett Williams (1st round - Rockwall-Heath HS), RHP Blade Tidwell (2nd round - Tennessee), and OF Nick Morabito (2nd round comp - Gonzaga College HS).

REMEMBERING VIN: Legendary broadcast Vin Scully passed away Tuesday night at the age of 94. Scully spent 67 years as the voice of the Dodgers, beginning in Brooklyn and ending in 2016 in LA.

SHINE BRIGHT LIKE A DOMMOND: Dominic Hamel makes his fifth Brooklyn start, facing Winston-Salem for the first time in his career.

TREND PRIOR TO LAST WEEK'S START: Hamel's walks seem to come in bunches. In his July 9th start against Aberdeen, he walked back-toback hitters in the fourth inning (one scored). In the July 16 start against Greensboro, Hamel walked the second and third batters back-to-back (one scored). In his July 23 start at Jersey Shore, Hamel walked both batters to start the second inning (both scored). Of the six runs allowed, four have been runners who reached on a walk. Against Hudson Valley on Friday, Hamel scattered his two walks and went unharmed.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 9 pros- "Indicates relief appearance" appearance pect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets. Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
