YESTERDAY: The Captains took game one of their six-game series at Dayton, 7-4. Lake County scored four runs in the first inning against big league rehabber Michael Feliz. **Joe Naranjo** highlighted the explosive opening frame with a three-run home run. The Captains added a run in the seventh and two more in the ninth. Captains starter Kevin Coulter earned the win after allowing just one run over five innings. The only run against Coulter was a first-inning inside-the-park home run by Francisco Urbaez. Jerson Ramirez picked up the save, allowing one run over two innings.

DRAGON SLAYERS: Aaron Bracho, Joe Naranjo, Will Brennan and Brayan Rocchio have done the most damage of any Captains against Dayton pitching this year. Bracho is 5-for-15 (.333) with two homers and four walks. Naranjo has gone 6-for-16 (.375) with a home run and seven walks. Brennan has gone 8-for-23 (.348) with two homers, two doubles and 10 RBI. Rocchio has gone 7-for-25 (.292) with a homer and four doubles.

COORS FIELD EAST: The Captains and Loons combined for 28 home runs last week. Great Lakes hit 20, while the Captains hit eight. Great Lakes' Brandon Lewis (4 HR), Ryan Ward (4 HR) and Carson Taylor (3 HR) did the most damage. Brayan Rocchio and George Valera each homered twice for the Captains. The Loons outscored the Captains in the series, 49-20 (-29 run differential).

YOU GET NOTHING: Great Lakes pitched a no-hitter on Friday for the first no-no in Loons history (14th season). Clayton Beeter (2 IP), Bobby Miller (5 IP), Jake Cantleberry (1 IP) and Cameron Gibbens (1 IP) combined to no-hit the Captains with three walks and 13 strikeouts. The Loons won, 14-0. It was the first time the Captains were no-hit since July 8, 2011 against

VALERA GOES DEEP: George Valera has hit six home runs in his last 14 games

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .304/.403/.607 (1.010 OPS) in the month of July. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games. Nova, however, is currently in the midst of a home run drought. After hitting four homers in the first six games of July, Nova has not homered since July 10 at Fort

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Brennan is sixth in batting average (.290) and second in doubles (22). Tena is eighth in average (.286) and tied for sixth in doubles (16).

TAKE YOUR BASE: George Valera ranks sixth in the High-A Central League (minimum 150 PA) with a 16.6 BB%

CONTACT HITTERS: Will Brennan has the ninth-lowest SwStr% (8.3) and the 11th-lowest K% (16.0) in the High-A Central eague (minimum 150 PA). Bryan Lavastida has the 10th-lowest K% (15.8%).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-10 at home, compared to 19-24 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.80 ERA on the

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Curry suffered his first professional loss last Wednesday against Great Lakes. The right-hander allowed four runs, three earned, over 6.1 innings (tied career-high). He struck out eight and walked none. All three earned runs were solo homers. James Outman hit a leadoff homer in the fourth, Andy Pages led off the fifth with a home run and Joe Vranesh hit a solo shot with one out in the seventh to end Curry's night. The Captains lost, 5-0.

**LONG BALL:** Seven of Curry's nine home runs allowed this year have come in the month of July. He has also been more prone to surrender the long ball later in the game. Curry has not surrendered a home run in the first three innings of any start with the Captains. Here are his slugging percentages against, inning-by-inning: First (.045), second (.296), third (.167), fourth (.444), fifth (.720), sixth (.684), seventh (1.250).

**RED HOT START:** Curry made five starts for Low-A Lynchburg to begin the 2021 season. At the time of his promotion, Curry was leading the Low-A East League (LAE) in ERA (1.07), FIP (1.94), WHIP (0.63), K-BB% (36.2%), batting average against (.135) and BABIP (.220). He was second in K% (40.4%) and LOB% (83.3%).

**DURING 2020:** Spent part of quarantine living and training with 2018-19 Captains outfielder **Will Benson** in Atlanta. Curry and Benson have known each other since they were seven years old. The two were part of a group of Atlanta area professional and college ballplayers who trained and played pick-up games together after the Spring Training shutdown. The group included 2020 American League Rookie of the Year Kyle Lewis and his Mariners outfield teammate Taylor Trammell, as well as Atlanta's No. 14 prospect Trey Harris. The Atlanta training sessions began with a small group playing on a field behind a local church. As more players joined, they started playing full-fledged pick-up games and moved to LakePoint, where each player chipped in \$10 for field usage fees so the group could make use of the complex's eight major league-sized turf fields.

RAMBLIN' WRECK: Curry was Georgia Tech's Friday night starter each of his three seasons and became the first Yellow Jacket in the modern era (1973-present) to win three straight Opening Day starts. Since 2002, Curry ranks third at Georgia Tech in strikeouts looking (84) and fourth in total strikeouts (241). The right-hander was a Third-Team All-ACC selection as a junior in 2010.

SHOWING FLASHES: Curry recorded four double-digit strikeout performances in his junior season at Georgia Tech (2018). The right-hander struck out 11 at NC State, fanned 12 at home against Miami, struck out 12 again at home against Wake Forest and struck out 10 at home against Duke. His 12-K performance against Wake Forest was arguably the best start of his college career, in which Curry pitched a complete game, nine-inning, two-hit shutout. The following season, Curry had another marquee performance. Facing then-No. 4 Louisville on the road, Curry pitched eight innings and held the Cardinals to one run on one hit with nine strikeouts for the win. Curry retired 16 straight batters at one point.

**TWO WAY:** Curry registered six at-bats as a true freshman at Georgia Tech and went 3-for-6. He even started one game as a designated hitter. Prior to college, Curry was rated as the 27<sup>th</sup> ranked shortstop recruit in the country by **Perfect Game**.

HIGH SCHOOL: While at Mays High School in Atlanta, Curry was a 2016 *Perfect Game/Rawlings* Third-Team All-American and a 2016 *Perfect Game* Southeast All-Region First Team selection. Curry was also a 2015 *Perfect Game* underclass First-Team All-American and 2014 underclass high honorable mention All-American. Curry threw five no-hitters during his high school career and holds Mays school records for wins (32) and home runs (25). Mays was also the quarterback on the Mays High School football team for two years.
