TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open a six-game set with Bowie on Tuesday night. Altoona has won 11-of-18 against the Baysox this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Portland rallied for a 9-8 win over Altoona on Sunday afternoon at Hadlock.

PROVIDING RELIEF: Altoona's bullpen has had a revolving door of talent this year, though of late Cy Nielson and Emmanuel Chapman have performed the best. Nielson has struck out 14 batters in 7.1 innings since his call-up from Greensboro and Emmanuel Chapman has a 1.95 ERA (32.1 IP / 7 ER), 35 strikeouts and a .151 batting average against in his last 13 appearances (3 starts).

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Entering play on Tuesday, August 13, infielder Kervin Pichardo is hitting .339 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR and 13 RBI during a 15-game on-base streak. Pichardo's streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Eastern League and recorded his third career 5-RBI game on Sunday, August 11 at Portland.

SOME KNOCKS: Altoona has collectively built a solid stretch of offense entering the August Dog Days. The Curve's 128 hits and .301 batting average in their last 12 games are 2nd among all Double-A teams. <u>Altoona has recorded at least 8 hits in 9-of-12 games</u> since July 30 during which they've recorded a 5-7 record.

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 32 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .434 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 3rd in BA (.314), 2nd in OBP (.421), T-4th in 3B (3) and T-5th in SB (17).

THIS IS NOT A CIMULATION: First baseman Nick Cimillo has reached base safely in 13 straight games (July 30 - Present) during which he's batting: .348/.455/.478/.933 with 3 2B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 9 BB and 1-1 SB. Cimillo ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers in HR (19), RBI (57) and 1st in OPS (.994) among players who have taken 150 MiLB PA's this year.

SLAMMIN' SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani earned a hit in 8 straight games including 7 straight two-hit games from July 31 - August 9. During the streak, he batted: .455/.486/.636/1.122 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 RBI, 3-3 SB.

GENERATION Z: Since July 23 (16 games) Tsung-Che Cheng has recorded a .412 on-base percentage. 10 times in his last 16 games, Cheng has reached base safely in a game twice. <u>Cheng swatted Altoona's third Grand Slam of the season on</u> Wednesday, August 7 at Portland.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as of late. Chen has allowed one run or fewer 7 times in his last 13 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.88 ERA (25 ER / 78.0 IP) with 65 strikeouts. Chen ranks 8th in the Eastern League in ERA (2.92), 4th in strikeouts (63), 7th in batting average against (.227) and first in innings pitched (74.0) since the beginning of June.

THE MEN OF THE BAY: Roberto Mercado leads the Baysox after two seasons managing the Orioles High-A affiliate in Aberdeen. Mercado led the Ironbirds to a playoff appearance in 2022 and took home the organization's Cal Ripken Sr. Award given to the minor league instructor with the most dramatic impact during the season. The typically loaded Baysox are a bit light in the prospect department this year, but OF Dylan Beavers, C/DH Samuel Basallo and OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. highlight the position player group.

THE FIRST TO PULL ON THEIR SOX: Alex Pham, takes the ball on Tuesday night. Pham, miraculously, earned Pitcher of the Week honors after tossing 6.0 innings of shutout baseball in the same week that Thomas Harrington struck out 11 in 7.0 innings against Bowie. Pham was Baltimore's 19th round pick in 2021 out of the University of San Francisco where he played four seasons and ranks 7th in program history with 213 strikeouts. He's 0-1 with a 5.27 ÉRA in 3 starts against the Curvé this season after he started twice against the Curve last year.
